### LAST TIME OUT

The Baysox reversed the results from the day before to shut out the Hartford Yard Goats 3-0 on Saturday night. **Alex Pham**, **Cameron Weston** and **Keagan Gillies** combined for a four-hit shutout with eight strikeouts and zero walks. **Samuel Basallo** kicked off the scoring with an RBI groundout to the shortstop. **Donta' Williams** scored from third in the fifth inning on a wild pitch before **Silas Ardoin** singled in a third run in the eighth. The victory snapped a three-game losing streak for the Baysox.

### ALL-STAR SAMUEL

Last Saturday, C/1B **Samuel Basallo** represented the Orioles in the 2024 All-Star Futures Game. In the game, Basallo went 0-for-1 with a four-pitch walk. The No. 2 O's/No. 12 MLB prospect is tied for ninth in the Eastern League in home runs (12), is ninth in hits (79) and is the first teenager to hit double-digit home runs in an Eastern League season since Vladimir Guerrero Jr. in 2018 (NH).

### THE FANTASTIC FABIAN

OF **Jud Fabian** is tied for second among active Eastern League players with 13 home runs on the season - tied for 10th-most in Double-A. After hitting 11 homers between May and June, the O's No. 11 prospect is still looking for his first homer in July.

### FEAR THE BEARD

Between Double-A Bowie and High-A Aberdeen, OF/1B **Matthew Etzel**'s 40 stolen bags this season are tied for ninth-most in all of MiLB. The first member of the O's '23 draft class to reach Double-A, Etzel has hits in 21 of his first 27 starts at the level. His six-game hit streak came to an end on Saturday.

### LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS

OF/1B **Dylan Beavers** has reached base in 62 of 76 games played in his second season with the Baysox. The Orioles No. 6 prospect leads the team in walks (41), sixth-most in the Eastern League.

### TIME FOR TRACE

RHP **Trace Bright** makes his 18th start of the season for the Baysox. The Orioles No. 15 prospect has thrown the 4th-most innings in the Orioles system (73.2) and has struck out the 4th-most batters (87). The 23-year-old makes his first start at home in over a month.

### ARMS RACE

The Baysox pitching staff has the fourth-best ERA in Double-A since June 1 (3.36) and has recorded the 2nd-most strikeouts this season (871)...The Baysox bullpen has thrown the most innings (428.2) at Double-A with the 3rd-best WHIP (1.20)...The Bowie rotation has also done its part with the 2nd-lowest ERA (2.07) in Double-A in July.

### A DRY JULY

The Baysox offense has struggled mightily this month through the first 14 games, batting just .202 which is 2nd-lowest in the league. They have scored 33 runs, which is tied for the fewest in Double-A. Bowie has managed to score just 11 runs in its last eight games.

### THE GOATS ARE GRAZING

The Hartford Yard Goats visit Bowie for the first and only time this season. The Double-A affiliate of the Colorado Rockies won the Northeast Division in the first half of the season. Nine of the Rockies' Top 30 prospects are on the active roster- IF Adael Amador (No. 2), OF Yanquiel Fernandez (No. 4), OF Zac Veen (No. 5), 1B Sterlin Thompson (No. 6), SS Ryan Ritter (No. 12), LHP Carson Palmquist (No. 14), 3B Warming Bernabel (No. 16), RHP Jaden Hill (No. 26) and RHP Connor Van Scoyoc (No. 28).

### TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

LHP Carson Palmquist gets the starting nod for Hartford this afternoon in the rubber match. The Rockies No. 14 prospect is one of the best strikeout throwers in the league. His 98 strikeouts on the season is tied for fourth-most in the circuit. Palmquist faced Bowie back on April 13 in the second game of a doubleheader and punched out seven batters over five scoreless innings to pick up the win. The 23-year-old southpaw was drafted in the 3rd round of the 2022 Draft out of Miami.

**2024:** Has thrown 4th-most innings (73.2) and has struck out 4th-most batters (87) in O's system this season. 10th most strikeouts in Eastern League (87). Makes first home start since 6/19 vs ALT. Looking to pitch five innings for first time since 4/26 @ RIC and still looking for first win of season. Owns a 3.89 ERA in eight home starts. Baysox are 5-12 when Bright starts. Finished month of May with a 3.68 ERA over 22 IP. Finished month of April with a 2.41 ERA (9th lowest in EL) over 18.2 innings pitched with 23 strikeouts. Went five innings each in three straight starts from 4/14 - 4/26. Named to Bowie Opening Day roster.

**2023:** Began first full season in minors in High-A Aberdeen and struck out 127 batters in 82.2 IP. Led IronBirds in strikeouts. Finished 4th in South Atlantic League in strikeouts. Punched out a career-high 10 batters in just 3.1 innings in 2023 season debut against Wilmington. Posted a 5.04 ERA in the first half but pitched better in second half of season, posting a 3.55 ERA with 62 strikeouts over 38 innings. Earned promotion to Double-A Bowie on August 22. Went at least four innings and struck out at least four batters in each of his first four Double-A appearances. Completed first Double-A stint with a 2.12 ERA in 17 innings over 20 strikeouts.

**2022:** Debuted professionally with FCL Orioles. Assigned to Single-A Delmarva on August 27. Struck out three over three shutout innings in Delmarva debut against Lynchburg. Finished first professional season with a 1.86 ERA in 9.2 innings.

**College:** Pitched three seasons at Auburn. Best season was his junior year in 2022 where he struck out a career-high 94 batters in 80.2 innings over 18 appearances (17 starts). Led team in starts, innings and strikeouts. Was only Auburn pitcher to start all 17 weekends of the season. His 94 strikeouts were fourth most by an Auburn pitcher since 2000. Helped Auburn reach Men's College World Series and earned the win in Tigers first CWS win since 1997.

**Personal:** Drafted in the 5th round of the 2022 MLB Draft by the Baltimore Orioles out of Auburn. Highest drafted pitcher signed by Baltimore that year after not coming to terms with third round pick Nolan McLean. Full name is Bob Ike Bright. Grew up an Orioles fan because he has family that lives in Havre de Grace.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.



### CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the "Chesapeake Baysox." This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George's Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.



### BOWIE PIT BEEF

The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s



## COACHING STAFF

### ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization's Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

### AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado in the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

### JOSH BUNSELMEYER

Hitting Coach
