MARATHON MEN: The Omaha Storm Chasers tied the game in the ninth inning and took the lead in the 12th, outlasting Indianapolis, 6-5, in 12 innings. It was Omaha's longest game of the season in both innings (12) and time of game (4:01). Down to the team's final strike, **INF Lucius Fox** bounced a single through the right side to bring in **OF Rudy Martin** to tie the game, 3-3, in the ninth. Neither team scored in extra innings until the 12th, when **INF Ryan McBroom** drove Fox, the placed runner, in from third with an RBI single for the first of three runs in the inning. **RHP Brandon Barker** turned in the longest start for an Omaha pitcher this season, tossing 6.1 innings of one-run ball. **INF Jimmy Govern** went 3-for-5 with a home run and two RBIs in his 2021 Triple-A debut.

OUTSTANDING OLIVARES: **OF Edward Olivares** currently leads Triple-A East in average (.352) while ranking third in on-base percentage (.423) and fifth in slugging percentage (.580). He recorded his 20th multi-hit game on Tuesday, giving him 20 multi-hit games in 40 games played with Omaha this season. After batting leadoff in his first 33 games, Olivares has hit third in the lineup since 7/6 vs. TOL. Since the move to third in the order (seven games), Olivares is 8-for-28 (.286) with two home runs. Olivares has been recalled by Kansas City and optioned four times since 5/30, initially being recalled on 5/30 before being optioned on 6/3, recalled again on 6/6, optioned on 6/9, recalled on 6/14, optioned on 6/17, recalled on 6/30, and optioned on 7/4. Across four stints with the Royals, Olivares is 8-for-33 (.242) with one home run in 11 games.

BULLPEN BRILLIANCE: With the addition of 9.0 innings and two runs allowed this week, the Chasers' bullpen has a 2.24 ERA (13 ER / 52.1 IP) in the month of July (11 games) with 52 strikeouts and 17 walks. **RHP Jace Vines** (8.1 IP), **RHP Grant Gavin** (7.2 IP), and **RHP Tyler Zuber** (6.1 IP) are each in the midst of season-best scoreless streaks. **LHP Gabe Speier** leads the relief corps in appearances (24) and has a 2.67 ERA in 27.0 IP while Gavin leads the unit in innings (40.0 IP) and strikeouts (46). **RHP Eddie Butler** has the lowest ERA (1.74) in relief appearances among Omaha pitchers with a minimum of 10 relief appearances.

CHECKMATE: **RHP Grant Gavin** currently leads all Triple-A East pitchers without a start in innings (40.0) and strikeouts (46). Among Triple-A East pitchers with a minimum of 40.0 innings, Gavin ranks fourth in ERA (2.93), fifth in batting average against (.200), and third in K%-BB% (22.0%). 13 of his 21 appearances this season have been at least 2.0 innings, while he's thrown 3.0+ innings five times, including a season-long 3.1 innings on 5/13 @ COL. Gavin has not allowed a run across four appearances in July, a stretch that spans 7.2 innings.

ROCKY ROAD: The Omaha Storm Chasers are 22-7 (.759) at Werner Park but 16-15 (.516) in road games this season. In 29 home games, the Chasers are batting .279/.347/.502 with 56 home runs and a 3.88 ERA. In 31 road games, Omaha is batting .257/.337/.465 with 53 home runs and a league-worst 5.60 road ERA. The Chasers are 6-8 in their last 14 road games, including 5-7 on a 12-game road trip from 6/23-7/4.

HISTORIC HOMER PACE: Omaha's 109 home runs in 60 games are the most in Minor League Baseball and more than 14 Major League teams. The Chasers are currently on pace to hit 236 home runs in the 130-game season, which would break the franchise record of 231 set in 1999 (141 games). The 1999 Omaha Golden Spikes' 231 home runs in a season was a modern Pacific Coast League record until 2019, when El Paso hit 258 home runs in 140 games. The Sacramento Solons hit 305 home runs in 1974 while playing home games in a converted football stadium with a left-field fence located 233 feet from home plate. The Chasers have at least one home run in 48 of 60 games this season, notching a 35-13 record when hitting at least one home run. Omaha has recorded 26 multi-homer games, including four four-homer games, five five-homer games, and one seven-homer game.

FOR OMAHA: **LHP Daniel Lynch** makes his 10 start with Omaha (11th appearance). He allowed a career-high eight runs on eight hits in 2.1 innings in his most recent outing on 7/8 vs. TOL, marking his second consecutive start of 7+ runs allowed. Lynch has allowed 15 runs on 18 hits—including four home runs—in 7.2 innings across two July starts. The left-hander has faced Indianapolis twice this season, tossing 5.2 innings of one-run ball on 5/25 and 5.0 innings of shutout ball on 5/30, combining for 13 strikeouts and three walks across the two starts. According to *Baseball America*, Lynch is the No. 22 prospect in baseball and top left-handed pitching prospect.

FOR INDIANAPOLIS: **RHP Max Kranick** makes his sixth start this season for Indianapolis, returning to the Indians following his second career Major League appearance on Saturday, 7/10 @ NYM when he allowed three runs on four hits in 3.0 innings. Kranick, an 11th Round pick by Pittsburgh in 2016, made his Major League debut on 6/27 @ STL, throwing 5.0 perfect innings with three strikeouts. His last start for Indianapolis came on 7/3 vs. IOW, when he allowed five runs on six hits in 3.0 innings.

DOPPLER RADAR: **C Cam Gallagher** is 3-for-17 (.176) with a walk-off home run (7/11 vs. TOL) in four games with Omaha as part of rehab assignment (right shoulder impingement - on IL since 6/17) that began on 7/8... **INF Jimmy Govern** has homered in three consecutive Triple-A games from 9/1/19-7/14/21, a stretch that spans 682 days... This week marks Omaha's first trip to Indianapolis since 1997, the final year of the affiliated American Association.

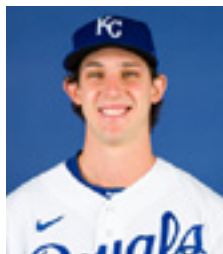
