- Tampa evened the series at a game a piece with a dramatic 5-4 win on Wednesday night.

- The Tarpons snagged an early lead in the top of the third, as Enmanuel Tejeda belted a 3-run homer to left against Dunedin starter Juaron Watts-Brown.

- Dunedin got a run back in the fourth, as Manuel Beltre ripped an RBI double to score Yhoangel Aponte to make it 3-1.

- Tampa chased Watts-Brown in the fifth after a single, double, and wild pitch that allowed Tejeda to score from third.

- The Jays trimmed the lead to 4-2 with Tucker Toman's RBI ground out in the bottom half.

- Dunedin still trailed 4-2 until the bottom of the eighth. Victor Arias opened the frame with a walk, bringing Toman to the plate representing the tying run. Toman sent a frozen rope off the wall in center. After tripping around third base, Arias beat the throw home to score. Toman hustled to third, drawing a throw that catcher Manuel Palencia sailed into left field, allowing Toman to score standing to tie the game.

- However, Tampa had the last laugh, as Tejeda delivered a two-out RBI single - his fourth hit of the day - in the top of the ninth, which stood as the game-winning hit.

### **SLIMMEST OF MARGINS**

With last night's one-run defeat, each of the Blue Jays' last 12 games have been decided by fewer than four runs. Seven of those games have been decided by two or fewer tallies. Eight of the team's first 11 games were decided by four or more runs.

### HARD HIT HARD LUCK

Dunedin racked up nine hard-hit balls last night (batted balls with an exit velocity measured 95 MPH or higher). Five were outs including two in the bottom of the ninth inning. Enmanuel Tejeda's game winning single was hit at just 60 MPH. Yhoangel Aponte's second inning single was the hardest hit ball in the Florida State League last night at 110 MPH.

### **OFFENSIVE OUTAGE**

Dunedin's offense has slowed in its last 11 games, scoring just 25 runs (2.2 per game) while batting .187 with an OPS of .534. In the first 12 games of the season, the Blue Jays averaged 6.5 runs per game.

### BULLISH ON THE 'PEN

Blue Jays relievers have been strong in the last eight games, posting a 1.97 ERA (7 ER) in 32 innings of work. Dunedin's 3.23 bullpen ERA ranks second in the league behind Daytona's 3.08.

### WALKIN' ON SUNSHINE

This week's series pit the Florida State League's leaders in walks drawn and walks issued against each other. Tampa's 120 walks at the plate lead the league, ahead of Dunedin's 112 (4th). On the mound, the Blue Jays and Tarpons are tied for third in free passes with 116.

### LOOKING FOR SAVINGS

Tuesday night's save from Yondrei Rojas marked just the third save by the Blue Jays this season - tied for the second fewest in the Florida State League.

### WON'T YOU BE MY STARTER?

Today's starter, Grant Rogers, owns the best ERA by a Dunedin starter through three starts, at 2.57.

### YOUNG GUN

Dunedin shortstop Arjun Nimmala is the second-youngest player in the Florida State league to open the season, at 18.5 years old (behind Daytona's Alfredo Duno at 18.2). Maykel Minoso joins Nimmala as the second 18 year old on the Blue Jays' roster.

### DURAN DURAN

Edward Duran's 13-game on base streak is the second-longest active on base streak in the Florida State League, and longest by a Jay this season. Across his last 10 games, the backstop is hitting .314 with a .415 on base percentage.
