## DRILLERS HOMER TWICE, ROUGHRIDERS FALL SHORT 6-1:

The Frisco RoughRiders were clipped by the Tulsa Drillers 6-1 on Saturday night from Riders Field. Tulsa (3-2, 29-45) drilled a pair of home runs in the first two innings. Kendall Simmons lifted a three-run blast in the top of the first and John Rhodes added a solo shot in the top of the second, propelling the Drillers in front 4-0. Frisco (2-3, 40-33) then responded in the bottom of the fifth when **Ian Moller** floated an RBI single, trimming Tulsa's lead to 4-1. In the top of the sixth, Kole Myers lined an RBI single to expand the Drillers lead to 6-1. Frisco then put two runners on in the bottom of he seventh but were held scoreless the rest of the game. Tulsa starter Chris Campos (5-3) earned a quality start, allowing one unearned run over six innings. Frisco starter **Mitch Bratt** (4-2) compiled the loss, yielding five runs despite striking out eight.

#### **DEFENSE WINS CHAMPIONSHIPS**:

After the RoughRiders committed 20 errors in 23 April games, which was sixth in the league, they have the fewest in the league, committing just 32 errors in their last 50 games. Their 49 double plays turned since May 1st also paces the league. Their 47 stolen bases allowed are the fewest in Double-A and are the third-fewest in Minor League Baseball.

#### **NO SWING AND A MIESES:**

Riders outfielder Luis Mieses has showed off the power this year. He is on pace to set a career-best in home runs as he has 11 so far. His career-best is 15 (in both 2022 and 2021). He is tied for third in the Texas League with his 11 home runs while his .450 slugging percentage is eighth in the Texas League.

#### DRIVERS, START YOUR ENGINES:

Despite allowing 15 combined earned over their last three starts, RoughRiders starting pitchers are still third in the Texas League over the last 17 games with a 3.59 ERA. In addition to pitching well, they are also pitching deep into ballgames. They are averaging 5.0 innings per start, the third-most in Double-A and first in the Texas League. **Josh Stephan** threw back-to-back 7.0-inning starts for the first time in his career over the last two weeks while he and **Kohl Drake** threw back-to-back 7.0-inning starts for the first time since 2018 last week.

#### **OFFENSIVE WOES:**

Frisco struggled on offense in their last 17 games, batting just .211/.296/.294/.590 with 3.0 runs per game, which are the second-fewest in the Texas League during that stretch. Their seven home runs are tied for the fewest in the league while their 171 strikeouts are the most as well. Frisco was shutout for the third time this season overall on Friday.

#### SAVE TONIGHT

The RoughRiders have had 11 different pitchers record a save in 2025. Frisco was the first team in Minor League Baseball to accomplish the feat this season. **Gavin Collyer** are leads the team saves (six) for the Riders, a mark that is tied for fourth in the Texas League. Their 24 saves are tied for the third-most in all of Minor League Baseball, just trailing Triple-A Jacksonville's 25 and Double-A Montgomery's 25. Their 4.10 bullpen ERA is sixth in the league. In June, their 3.16 reliever ERA is third in the Texas League.

#### OVER THE WALL-COTT:

Rangers top prospect **Sebastian Walcott** has been displaying the power as of late. In his last 39 games, he has blasted six home runs while slashing .255/.351/.430/.781 with eight doubles, 20 RBIs, 20 runs scored and 22 walks to 34 strikeouts. This season, his walk rate of 12.8 percent is a career high while he is striking out at just 21.7 percent, a career low. His 16 doubles lead the league and his 24 extra-base hits are second in the league. In his last 20 games, he is hitting .274 (20-for-73)/.372/.315/.687 with three doubles, six RBIs, 12 walks, 18 strikeouts and seven stolen bases. This season, he is on pace for 31 steals over 131 games, which would best his prior career high of 27 last year. The only teenagers since 2005 to steal 30 or more in Double-A are **Elvis Andrus** (51, 2008), Jackson Chourio (43, 2023), Nelson Rada (35, 2024) and Mike Trout (31, 2011). Chourio was the only one on that list with 30+ stolen bases and double-digit home runs (22).

#### DOUBLE-A DOUBL-A RON:

**Aaron Zavala** has been on fire at the plate for the Riders. After a dreadful start, batting just .077 (2-for-26) through 10 games, he is hitting .277 (52-for-188)/.386/.441/.827 over his last 51 games. He is second in the Texas League in walks (45) and is fifth in OBP (.385). In his last 24 games, he is hitting .268 (26-for-97)/.343/.433/.776 with two doubles, four home runs and 10 RBIs. In his Frisco career, he has earned 201 walks over four seasons (302 games), which is second in franchise history. He is just six walks away from tying the franchise record for walks, held by **Guilder Rodriguez** with 206 from 2009-2015 (527 games). His seven home runs this season are his most since his career-best of 16 in 2022.
