"FUN IS GOOD" FACTOIDS

LAST TIME OUT: The St. Paul Saints fell behind 3-0 after one in both legs of a doubleheader and were swept in Thursday evening's twin-bill in Indianapolis, a 6-2 defeat in game one and a 5-0 shutout in game two. The Saints fell to two games below .500 for the first time since April 27. In game one, the Indians teed off St. Paul starter Andrew Morris with a leadoff double from Ronny Simon. Three batters later, Jack Suwinski cracked one over the right-field wall for his eighth of the year, a three-run shot. The Saints briefly cut the lead down to one courtesy of a Tanner Schobel RBI double in the top of the fifth, but Indy erased the marker with Joey Bart's RBI single in the bottom of the inning and added two more for good measure on a pair of bases-loaded walks in the sixth. The Saints played as the home team in game two for a makeup of a rainout on April 24 at CHS Field, but the result was the same. Indianapolis jumped on Randy Dobnak with three hits in the opening frame, including an RBI knock from Billy Cook and a two-run round-tripper from Liover Peguero. The Saints were shut down on a bullpen day by led by Drake Fellows, who faced just one over the minimum in 4.0 scoreless innings as an opener. The Saints didn't collect their first hit until the fifth, marking the third time in the last four games they were held without a hit through the first four innings at Victory Field. DaShawn Keirse, Jr. broke up the no-no bid with a leadoff double, but was left stranded in scoring position.

WAIT FOR IT, WAIT FOR IT: The Saints have been held without a hit through the first four innings in three of their previous four games in Indianapolis. In the first two games of the series, St. Paul were kept out of the hit column through five innings in each game, including going into the seventh until collecting their first hit on Tuesday night. It marked the first time in franchise history the Saints have been held hitless through five innings in back-to-back games. Opposing teams have now take a no-hitter through five innings against the Saints 21 times the past five seasons (includes two no-hitters), the most among all teams in Triple-A by far in that span (the next closest team has been held hitless thru five just 13 times). The Saints have hit just .162 (18-111) with a .518 team OPS on their road trip to Indy so far, ranking 2nd-worst in the International League to Rochester (.154 / .513) and bottom-10 in MiLB this week in each.

LIVE BY THE LONGBALL, DIE BY THE LONGBALL: The Saints have not left the ballpark in four straight games in Indianapolis, marking their longest team drought without a homer since a five-game stretch without a homer from April 2-8, the 3rd-7th games of the season. The Saints went just 2-3 in their previous five-game homerless drought and 1-3 so far in their current 4-game stretch w/o a dinger. St. Paul are 23-18 this year when they hit a homer and just 8-20 without going yard.

HOW COME THEY CALL IT VICTORY FIELD?: The Saints snapped out of an eight-game losing streak at Victory Field with a win on Wednesday afternoon, but have still dropped 10 of their last 11 and 14 of the past 16 games played at Victory Field. The Saints have historically struggled in Indy, and have the second-lowest winning percentage at Victory Field of any of their visiting ballparks since going Triple-A, with only a worse mark in Columbus (see below). The Saints went just 1-11 in two visits to Indianapolis last year, including being swept in a six-game series from August 13-18. The Saints have been outscored 220-189 all-time at Victory Field.

I'M LOVIN IT: Left-hander Richard Lovelady has retired the last 16 hitters he's faced out of the bullpen dating back to June 1 after recording his sixth save in as many chances on Wednesday. His current streak of six straight saves is the 3rd-longest active streak in Triple-A. Lovelady is currently one of three Triple-A relievers with an active streak of 16+ batters retired in-a-row, trailing only Gwinnett's Jesse Chavez (17) and tied with Las Vegas's Grant Holman (16). His streak is tied with Kody Funderburk for the most consecutive batters retired by a St. Paul pitcher this year, with Funderburk retiring 16 straight Triple-A batters from a stretch spanning April 4-27, interrupted by a stint with the Twins.

MCCRUSHER KEEPS MCCRUSHIN': Saints outfielder Carson McCusker currently ranks t-4th in Triple-A in average exit velocity (93.5 mph, min 120 PA). Despite an 0-for-20 slump since homering last Friday, McCusker's longest hitless slump this season, the Sparks, Nevada native still ranks t-5th in the league in homers (12) and is top-5 among qualifiers in OPS & SLG%. Last Thursday vs Scranton, he demolished a 463 foot homer that jumped off the bat at 115.2 mph, marking the third-hardest batted ball in Saints franchise history (Matt Walner-115.6 mph & Trevor Larnach-115.5 mph). It was the 7th-longest tracked homer in the history of CHS Field, the fourth furthest hit by a Saints batter. McCusker has the four hardest hit balls by a St. Paul hitter this season and five of the top-10, including three batted balls that rank among the top-10 in exit velocity in Saints history.

ED(WALK) JULIEN: Entering play Friday, Saints second baseman Edouard Julien is tied for the most walks in all of baseball (majors & minors) with 28 free passes since May 11. In that stretch, Julien has drawn at least one free pass in 16 of 28 games while touting a .453 OBP.

HEY MICKEY YOU'RE SO FINE: Since being optioned to Triple-A St. Paul on May 5, Saints utility man Mickey Gasper has hit .349 (37-106) with 10 doubles, 7 HR, and 18 RBI in 28 games. Gasper is 2nd in the IL in extra-base hits (17) since that date and his OPS ranks 3rd in the International League (min 80 AB) in that stretch. Gasper has quite simply been one of the best hitters in the minors the last two years. Since the start of 2024 with the Boston org, he ranks as the 2nd best hitter in the minors by wRC+ (weight runs created plus, where 100 is league average), a ballpark and league adjusted measure).

TWINS REPORT: The Twins (36-32) were blown out 16-3 by the Rangers at Target Field yesterday afternoon. Bailey Ober gave up a leadoff homer to Josh Smith on the second pitch of the game and allowed four longballs across the first five innings, with the Rangers leading 7-1 at that point. It ended as a six-homer showing for Texas, who entered as the league's worst offense, but left Target Field with 34 runs scored in three days, tied for the third-most in a 3-game series in club history. Down on the farm, Double-A Wichita (31-29) notched a 5-1 win at home vs Corpus Christi (HOU). High-A Cedar Rapids (35-25) split a doubleheader with Peoria (STL). Twins No. 7 prospect Brandon Winokur ripped his 7th HR this season and is having his best month of the season, hitting .333 (12-42) with a .952 OPS in June. Low-A Fort Myers (27-31) were suspended in the 1st inning of game one of a doubleheader in Dunedin (TOR).

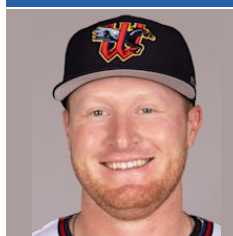

KNOWING THE GAME FROM BOTH SIDES: Baker was primarily a catcher until his Georgetown High School coaches recognized his strong arm belonged on the mound. He attracted little attention from college scouts, but his high school coach, Adam Foster, took an assistant coaching job at Angelo State and recruited Baker to join him there. Angelo State head coach Kevin Brooks recalled Baker arriving on campus with a mid-80's fastball and no breaking ball, but he was tall and could throw strikes.

TRIPLE-CROWN WINNER: In his first full professional season in 2022, Baker spent the entire season with the Palm Beach Cardinals and captured the Florida State League's Pitching Triple-Crown (led the league in Wins, ERA, and Strikeouts). While he was the only pitcher in the league that year to throw enough innings to "qualify" for the ERA lead (a pitcher must log at least 0.8 innings pitched per the team's game played that season), Baker logged 24.1 more innings than the next closest pitcher that season and his ERA was the 2nd-lowest among anyone that threw at least 80 innings in the FSL that season. He had one more win and 18 more strikeouts than his next closest pursuer in the other two categories.

EXCUSE ME, WHERE?: Trent Baker made his way to pro ball by the way of Angelo State University, an NCAA Division II program located in San Angelo, Texas, where Baker became the program's career wins (31) and strikeouts (293) leader. The Rams resurrected their baseball program in 2005 after a long hiatus, and have since turned themselves into a perennial power in the Lone Star Conference. They have won six of the past 10 regular season conference championships in the league and as of the end of the 2024 season, are the only current Lone Star Conference team to ever make the College World Series. The Rams have advanced to the College World Series six times in 15 years since bringing the program back, including in 2021 in Baker's RS Junior season and for each of the past four seasons (2021-24). The old iteration of the Angelo State program has produced three Major League players in program history: most notably 5-time All-Star Norm Cash, a first baseman for the Tigers & White Sox for 17 seasons from 1958-1974, as well as Tommy Gramly (RHP, 3g with Cleveland in 1968), and Jim Morris (LHP, TB, 21g, 1999-00), the 35-year-old rookie for the Devil Rays in 1999 who's story was dramatized for the 2002 film "The Rookie" starring Dennis Quaid.
