### INDY BITS

**ABOUT SUNDAY, GAME 1:** The Toledo Mud Hens scored nine unanswered runs with at least one scored in each of the final five innings to defeat the Indianapolis Indians in Game 1 of Sunday's doubleheader, 10-1. Four of the runs came via three home runs, the Mud Hens' most in a game this series.

**ABOUT SUNDAY, GAME 2:** Llover Peguero lined a bases-loaded single into right field to plate the go-ahead run as the Indianapolis Indians defeated Toledo in their final offensive half inning of Game 2 in Sunday afternoon's doubleheader at Victory Field, 5-4. The teams traded second-inning homers, with a two-run shot off the bat of Matt Gorski – his third homer of the series – besting a solo homer by former Indian Bligh Madris. Ryan Vilade, another former Indians outfielder, then launched a two-run homer in the third to put Toledo on top. Indianapolis tied the game in the fourth when Grant Koch came around to score following a leadoff walk. Peguero's single followed a one-out double by Gilberto Celestino, walk to Ji Hwan Bae and a rocket single off the bat of Malcom Nuñez in the sixth inning. Following the go-ahead base knock, Gorski drove in Bae with a sacrifice fly to plate an insurance run for the Indians.

**GONE FOR GORSKI (x3):** After launching the longest homer by an Indians batter since Statcast data began being tracked in 2022 and the longest homer in the International League this season with a 478-foot shot on Saturday night, Matt Gorski extended his home run streak to two games with a two-run, go-ahead homer in the bottom of the second inning in the nightcap on Sunday. He has now homered three times in his past five games with 11 RBI vs. Toledo. The outfielder homered three times in six games with Indianapolis from Sept 12-17, 2023, at Omaha. He has homered in consecutive games seven times in his career, with a career-long four-game home run streak coming from May 15-19, 2022, with High-A Greensboro (6 HR).

**GERONIMO000:** Making his second start with Indianapolis in Game 2 on Sunday, Geronimo Franzua struck out seven of 13 total batters faced across 3.0 innings. His seven strikeouts were his most since fanning a career-high eight batters on June 18, 2013, with DSL Astros. In his two starts with Indy, he has surrendered three earned runs with 11 strikeouts in 6.2 innings.

**FEARING FEIGL:** Brady Feigl earned his International League-leading sixth win of the season in Game 2 of Sunday afternoon's doubleheader, tossing 2.0 one-run innings as the Indians took the lead in the bottom of the sixth inning. In 12 appearances (one start) this season, he is 6-1 with a 3.18 ERA (8er/22.2ip), 24 strikeouts and 0.97 WHIP and has earned the win in six of his last eight appearances (one start).

**HITTING HANK (x8):** Henry Davis was hit by a pitch in Sunday's opener, his eighth hit-by-pitch in just 11 games with Indianapolis this season. Since May 7, his eight hit-by-pitches ranks first in all of Minor League Baseball and is more than 89 minor league teams since that date. He also ranks first in hit-by-pitches in the International League for the entire season, despite spending just two weeks in Triple-A. Davis has reached base safely in 10 of 11 games with Indianapolis, hitting .263 (10-for-38) with seven runs, two doubles, three home runs, eight RBI, .440 on-base percentage and .993 OPS.

**CELESTINO STAYS HOT:** Gilberto Celestino went 2-for-4 with a run and double in Game 2 on Sunday afternoon, marking his fourth multi-hit game in 11 games since May 3. In that time, he owns a .361 batting average (13-for-36) with seven runs, two doubles, two RBI and three stolen bases. He has reached base safely in 11 of 12 games in May this season and is now hitting .277 (33-for-119) in 35 games with Indianapolis this season.

**JAKE ON BASE:** Jake Lamb extended his current on-base streak to 21 games since April 18 with an RBI double in Sunday's doubleheader opener. During that streak – which is tied with Nick Gonzales for the longest active streak on the team this season and the sixth-longest streak in the International League. During that streak, he is hitting .347 (25-for-72) with 12 runs, nine doubles, one home run, 17 RBI, .433 on-base percentage and .947 OPS. He has now reached base safely in 31 of 32 games this season with a .342 batting average (38-for-111), 6 runs, 10 doubles, three homers, 23 RBI and 20 walks.

**TONIGHT:** The Indians begin a six-game series against the I-Cubs – their first of three this season – tonight a 7:38 PM ET at Principal Park in Des Moines, Iowa. The Indians went 10-14 against Iowa last season, logging a 3-9 record in two series on the road. Beginning the series for Indianapolis tonight is RHP Quinn Priester (1-1, 3.95) in his first start with Indy since April 13 (1) at Toledo. Countering for Iowa will be RHP Thomas Pannone (3-3, 3.13). Pannone tossed 4.0 shutout innings with eight strikeouts against the Indians on June 19, 2019, with Buffalo, his lone career start against the Indians.

**QUINN VS. THE I-CUBS:** Quinn Priester is set to make his fourth start with Indianapolis tonight in the series opener at Iowa. He has made five career appearances (four starts) against Iowa – all coming in 2023 – with a 4-0 record, 2.79 ERA (9er/29.0ip) and 28 strikeouts. His last outing against the Cubs came on Aug. 25 at Victory Field, when he tossed 5.0 one-run innings with nine strikeouts to earn the win in relief. In three games with Indy this season, he is 1-1 with a 3.95 ERA (6er/13.2ip) and 30 strikeouts. After making his last start with the Indians on April 13 (1) at Toledo, he made five big-league starts with Pittsburgh. From April 19-May 14, he went 0-4 with a 4.33 ERA (13er/27.0ip) and 17 strikeouts.

**THIS DATE IN 1987:** Dennis Martinez fired a one-hit shutout in a 5-0 win for the Indians against Buffalo at Bush Stadium. Martinez finished with five strikeouts in the 9.0-inning complete game. Left fielder Tom Romano and third baseman Jeff Reynolds both hit home runs for Indy while second baseman Johnny Paredes and first baseman Razor Shines notched two hits apiece.

## TONIGHT'S PITCHER

**Quinn Priester:** Right-hander Quinn Priester is set to make his third start of the year in today's doubleheader opener at Toledo.

**Last Outing:** Priester surrendered four runs in 6.0 innings on May 14 at Milwaukee in his last start with Pittsburgh.

**Against the I-Cubs:** Priester made five appearances (four starts) against Iowa last year with a 4-0 record, 2.79 ERA (9er/29.0ip) and 28 strikeouts.

**Quinning:** Priester won a career-high seven consecutive decisions in Triple-A from 5/4-8/25/23, going 7-0 with a 3.04 ERA (26er/77.0ip) and 74 strikeouts over 15 games (14 starts). During that stretch, he ranked among league qualifiers in ERA (2nd), batting average against (3rd, .233), wins (T-4th) and WHIP (6th, 1.25).

**IL Postseason All-Star:** Priester was named to the International League postseason All-Star team following his 2023 Triple-A campaign. He went 9-4 with a 4.00 ERA (48er/108.0ip) in 22 games (22 starts) and ranked among league leaders in wins (T-3rd) and strikeouts (5th, 116). He was the sixth Indians starting pitcher to be named to the IL postseason All-Star team, joining Fritz Ackley (1963), Ben Hendrickson (2004), Zach Duke (2005), Steven Brault (2017) and Mitch Keller (2019).

**Miscellaneous:** Selected by PIT as the 18th overall pick of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft ... selected to the 2021 Sirius XM All-Star Futures Game and struck out White Sox prospect Yoelqui Cespedes ... Was named the 2021 High-A East Pitcher of the Year. ... Had his contract selected by PIT on 7/17 and made his MLB debut that night vs. CLE.
