YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels snapped a three-game losing streak with a 4-3 win over the Senators. In the first, **Tyler Fitzger-**ald scored on an error after a single by **Patrick Bailey**. In the third, Fitzgerald hit an RBI triple to open a 2-0 lead. Will Frizzell hit an RBI single in the fourth to close the score to 2-1. Bailey brought in two runs with a single in the fifth to extend the lead to 4-1. The Senators scored two runs in the fifth to bring the score to 4-3. **Mason Black** started and allowed one run over four innings. **Raymond Burgos** picked up first Double-A win with two scoreless innings. **Chris Wright** threw the final two innings for his first save of the year and struck out four.

TODAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the finale of a six-game series against the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals. The only other season the Senators have played their first home series against the Flying Squirrels was 2021, with each team winning three games. Richmond won the first three, including a no-hitter by **Matt Frisbee** and three relievers on May 13, 2021. This year, the Flying Squirrels visit Harrisburg for two series. The will also play a three-game set at FNB Field from July 13-16 out of the All-Star Break. The Senators come to Richmond twice for two six-game series from June 20-25 and August 15-20.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS continue the a new season this weekend after qualifying for the postseason in 2022 for the first time in eight years, winning the Eastern League Southwest Division first-half title before being eliminated in the Division Series by Erie. Richmond went 66-71 overall, posting a 40-29 mark in the first half and a 26-42 record in the second half. Last year's team also set a franchise record with 169 homers, passing the previous mark of 127 set in 2021.

THE SENATORS opened the season dropping two-of-three at Somerset last Friday and Saturday. Harrisburg's season-opener was Inc JerkAluna opened the season dropping two-or-three at Somerset last Friday and Saturday. Harrisoting's season-opener was rained out last Thursday. They lost, 6-5, on Friday before alternating shutouts in a doubleheader split on Saturday. In 2022, the Senators went 52-85, the worst record in the Eastern League. They went 30-39 in the first half and 22-46 in the second half. Harrisburg's roster includes six of Baseball America's Top-30 Nationals prospects, including Jackson Rutledge (No. 9), Mitchell Parker (No. 14), Evan Lee (No. 23), Drew Millas (No. 25), Gerardo Carrillo (No. 26) and Tim Cate (No. 28). The Senators' roster also features four of MLB.com's Top-30 Nationals prospects, including Jackson Rutledge (No. 11), Mitchell Parker (No. 24), Gerardo Carrillo (No. 28) and Drew Millas (No. 30).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Kai-Wei Teng** makes his second start of the season and the series. On Tuesday, he worked four scoreless innings and struck out 10 batters. Last year, he led the Eastern League and set a Richmond franchise record with 169 strikeouts. Over the last 2021 and 2022 seasons, Teng combined for 311 strikeouts, which was the fourth-most in the minor leagues during that span. For 2022 in his first Double-A season, Teng went 6-12 with a 5.22 ERA. He tied the Flying Squirrels' franchise record for the most starts in a season with 28. A native of Taiwan, Teng was originally signed by the Minnesota Twins before being traded to the Giants at the deadline in 2019 along with RHP Prelander Berroa for RHP Sam Dyson. Prior to the 2023 season, Teng pitched for Chinese Taipei in the World Baseball Classic at Taichung Intercontinental Stadium in his hometown. *For more on Teng, see page two.*

FOR HARRISBURG: Left-hander Alex Troop makes his second start of the season. He pitched the series-opener on Tuesday against the Flying Squirrels and was hit with a loss after allowing five runs (four earned) in 3.1 innings. He spent most of last season with the Senators, going 7-5 with a 4.81 ERA in 29 outings (17 starts) and also worked one relief appearance for Triple-A Rochester. He made four appearances, including two starts, against Richmond in 2022. He made a start against the Flying Squirrels at FNB Field on June 15 and allowed one run over 4.2 innings. In his lone start at The Diamond, Troop set a season high with 10 strikeouts over five innings on September 1, allowing four runs on five hits. Troop was selected by the Nationals in the ninth round of the 2017 MLB Draft out of Michigan State. He first reached Double-A with Harrisburg near the end of the 2021 season. For his Double-A career, Troop is 7-6 with a 4.56 ERA in 33 appearances (18 starts).

CLOSE CALLS: The Flying Squirrels have played six one-run games this season, the most in the Eastern League. In those games, the team is 3-3. Richmond won back-to-back one-run games in a doubleheader on Saturday against Reading to open the season. After back-to-back four-run wins, the Flying Squirrels have lost each of their last three games by one run. After leading, 5-1, on Wednesday, Richmond fell at Harrisburg, 7-6, on a walk-off passed ball. They lost, 4-3, to the Senators on Thursday, leaving the bases loaded in the ninth inning. On Friday, the Flying Squirrels opened an early 5-0 lead before losing, 6-5, on a walk-off single in the 10th inning. They held off the Senators for a 4-3 win on Saturday night.

ALRIGHT, ALDRETE: In four games on the road trip, **Carter Aldrete** is batting .462 (6-for-13) with two homers, four RBIs, four walks and a .588 on-base percentage. He clubbed his first homer of the year on Tuesday in the series-opener, a two-run shot to left. He hit a solo home run to right on Friday. After homering 13 times in his first two professional seasons, Aldrete clubbed 21 homers in 2022, including 15 with High-A Eugene and six with the Flying Squirrels.

MATOS MANIA: Through his first eight Double-A games, Luis Matos leads the team with five RBIs and is tied for second on the club with eight hits. He went 3-for-4 with a two-run homer in his Double-A debut in Game 1 of last Saturday's doubleheader against Reading. In the first two games of the current series in Harrisburg, Matos drove in three runs. In 33 plate appearances, Matos has struck out just twice, both coming last Sunday against Reading.

PATTY BARRELS: Patrick Bailey has reached base in each of his first six Double-A games. He picked up an RBI double in Game 1 of last Saturday's doubleheader against Reading for his first Double-A hit. He reached base three times last Sunday, picking up another double and adding a walk. He went hitless but walked in Tuesday's win. On Wednesday, he had two opposite-field singles while batting left-handed. He went 2-for-4 with two RBIs on Saturday night. Bailey is batting .350 (7-for-20, 2 2B, 4 RBI) left-handed and .200 (If for S) right bandedo and .200 (1-for-5) right-handed.

TAKE A WALK: Andy Thomas is tied for the Eastern League lead with eight walks. Last season, Thomas led the Northwest Lea in on-base percentage (.373) and ranked third in walks (58). On Thursday afternoon, he collected a first-inning RBI double for first Double-A hit.

SIMON SAYS: In his four games this series, Simon Whiteman has reached base nine times, posting a .600 on-base percentage. He has picked up three hits and six walks since Tuesday. He reached base four times on Wednesday, including his first home run of the year and three walks.

FITZ ON FIRE: 2022 Flying Squirrels MVP Tyler Fitzgerald has hit safely in seven-of-his-first-eight games of the season. He went 0-for-5 on Friday, his only hitless game of the year so far. On Saturday night, he went 2-for-3 with a double, a triple, a walk and an RBI. He is currently tied for fifth in the Eastern League with nine hits and tied for first with two triples.

HOW THEY GOT HERE: Eighteen players were originally signed or drafted by the San Francisco Giants. Eleven players were selected in the MLB Draft, four were signed as international free agents and three were signed as non-drafted free agents. Two players were signed as minor league free agents after starting their careers in other organizations. **Riley Mahan**, previously with the Miami Marlins organization, was signed last May. **Raymond Burgos** signed in December after reaching free agency following seven years as a member of the Cleveland Guardians organization. Seven players were acquired via trade. **Kai-Wei Teng** came in a deal with the Minnesota Twins in 2019. **Hayden Cantrelle** was swapped from the Marlins in 2022. **Carson Seymour** and **Nick Zwack** came to the Giants in a trade with the New York Mets at the trade deadline last year, the same day **Andy Thomas** and **Michael Stryffeler** were traded from the Seattle Mariners. **Erik Miller** was traded from the Philadelphia Phillies in January.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, Simon Whiteman is eighth in OBP (.455). Carter Aldrete is 10th in OBP (.444), seventh in SLG (.636) and sixth in OPS (1.080). Tyler Fitzgerald is tied for fifth in hits (5) and tied for first in triples (2). Andy Thomas is tied for first in walks (8). Nick Zwack is tied for sixth in strikeouts (12), fourth in BAA (.148) and third in WHIP (0.84). Carson Seymour is third in BAA (.143). Mason Black is fifth in WHIP (0.88).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have eight players ranked in *Baseball America*'s Top-30 Giants prospects, Luis Matos (No. 5), Mason Black (No. 9), Carson Seymour (No. 12), Erik Miller (No. 15), Ryan Murphy (No. 20), Nick Swiney (No. 24), Patrick Bailey (No. 27) and Randy Rodriguez (No. 30). MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Matos (No. 7), Black (No. 10), Bailey (No. 11), Seymour (No. 17), Rodriguez (No. 26) and Murphy (No. 27).
