### RHP RHETT KOUBA (1-1, 3.68) VS. LHP TY BLACH (0-0, 2.08)

TODAY'S GAME: The Isotopes lost last night's contest, 5-2, and need to win the final three games of the series to avoid losing their third-straight series to begin 2024—a franchise first ... The club has dropped a season-high six-straight and nine of 10. The Isotopes haven't lost five in-a-row since losing eight-straight from Aug. 3-13, 2023 (season high) ... Ty Blach is expected to make his third start of the season while the Space Cowboys are slated to send Rhett Kouba to the hill.

**OUT THE GATE**: Overall, the Isotopes are 2-10 on the year—tied for the worst start to a season through 12 games in franchise history (2021).

SPACE COWBOYS: Since Sugar Land joined the PCL in 2021, the Skeeters/Space Cowboys have outscored Albuquerque 367-274 across 42 meetings at Isotopes Park ...Albuquerque has lost 12 of its last 14 meetings against the Space Cowboys, including an all-time series record eight-straight at home (last win at Isotopes park: June 6, 2023.

ERROR 404: The Isotopes did not commit an error last night, just their fifth game of the season without a miscue and first since April 7 at Oklahoma City. Their 15 miscues for the season are the second-most in Triple-A (most: Norfolk Tides, 16).

BY WAY OF THE K: The Isotopes offensive struck out 11 times, the club's ninth contest this season with double-digit punchouts. Their 134 strikeouts are third-most in Triple-A (most: Omaha, 139)

TALKIN' BOUT LAST NIGHT: Albuquerque tallied just one extrabase hit (homer), their third game in 2024 with just one ... The eight total bases tied for the second-fewest on the year (also: April 6 at Oklahoma City) ... Held to two runs or fewer for the second time in 2024 (also: April 5 at Oklahoma City, one run).

BASES JUICED: Riley Pint walked in a run with the bases loaded in the sixth inning last night, the fourth bases-loaded walk by the Isotopes this year (last: Evan Justice, April 9 vs. Sugar Land) and third of the series.

**XBH**: Jordan Beck connected on the Isotopes Triple-A-leading 10th triple of the year Wednesday. They have a three-bagger in six of the 12 games played this year ... Additionally, the club's 31 doubles are tied for the third-most in Triple-A (leaders: Round Rock and Omaha).

**TURN IT:** The Isotopes defense turned a season-high three doubleplays, most in a contest since Sept. 21, 2023, vs. Oklahoma City.

**NEW GUY:** Greg Jones connected on his first home run as a member of the Rockies organization Wednesday, a solo blast to center in the seventh inning ... His seven swipes (one caught stealing) are tied for third-most in Triple-A. ... Of 21 batted balls, eight have a 100-plus MPH exit velocity.

**BOUCHIE THE BRUIN**: Sean Bouchard drew two walks last night and has reached base in 10 of 11 games in 2024 ... His four triples on the year are tied for the most in Triple-A while his nine extra-base hits are tied for sixth-most.

FAN FAVORITE: Coco Montes recorded his team-leading fifth multi-hit contest of the year yesterday and second-straight. He has a hit in three-straight games (5x12).

MR. VOLUNTEER: Jordan Beck's six-game hit streak came to an end last night after going 0-for-3 with a walk. However, he extended his on-base streak to 32 games (since Aug. 18, 2023, with Double-A Hartford).

**BECK EXIT VELO**: Out of the 27 batted balls in play, 11 have been over 100-MPH.

IT'S ALL GOOD, MAN: Hunter Goodman went 0-for-4 last night with a season-high three punchouts, his fourth contest without a hit in 2024; He struck out three-plus times in just eight of 129 games in 2023 between Double-A, Triple-A and MLB .... Reached base in 20 of the 25 Triple-A games he's played while tallying a hit in 18 ... Of Goodman's 27 batted balls hit into play this year, 11 have an exit velocity over 100-MPH.

**GRANNY**: Grant Lavigne belted his first Triple-A homer in the sixth inning last night, his 28th at-bat with the Isotopes (407 ft.).

**TRIPLE-A LEADER**: Goodman's seven doubles on the year are tied for the most in Triple-A.

**REAL SLIM SCHUNKY**: Aaron Schunk is 3-for-7 since starting the season 3-for-35..

TONY: Drew Romo connected on a bunt single as a pinch hitter vesterday to extend hit streak to four games (5x14).

**EXIT VELO:** Of the 11 batted balls registered at 100 MPH-plus, the Isotopes recorded three of them. Grant Lavigne's homer was the third-hardest hit ball of the night: 103.9 MPH.

**FIRST FRAME**: Josh Rogers held the Space Cowboys scoreless in the first frame last night, the first time in four games the staff has held their opponent without a tally in the opening inning.

#### **NUCLEI NOTES**

**SKIPPER**: Pedro Lopez enters his 20th year as a minor league manager and second guiding the Isotopes, the eighth manager in club history ... Spent 2021 as Albuquerque's hitting coach and 2022 as its bench coach ... Notched his 1,000th career managerial victory June 4, 2023 at Salt Lake, 7-1. Managed in the Texas Rangers (2001-05, 2007) and New York Mets (2011-19) organizations while claiming the 2014 Eastern League Championship with Double-A Binghamton. Lopez was drafted in the 21st round by the San Diego Padres in the 1988 MLB Draft and spent 13 years in the minor leagues, reaching Triple-A on four occasions.

**HOMETOWN KID**: Jordan Pacheco begins his third season as the Isotopes hitting coach ... An Albuquerque native and 2004 graduate of La Cueva High School, Pacheco then attended the University of New Mexico (2005-07), where he was one of the most prolific offensive players in school history (.384, 59 2B, 25 HR, 145 RBI) ... Drafted by Rockies in the 9th round in 2007 and made his MLB debut with Colorado in 2011.

CHRIS MICHALAK: Begins his second season as Isotopes pitching coach ... Pitched for the Albuquerque Dukes in 2000, followed by stints with the Isotopes in 2004 and 2008 ... Started second-to-last game in Dukes history, giving up two runs in 6.0 innings during Game 4 of a PCL First Round playoff series at Memphis Sept. 9, 2000 ... Appeared in 61 Major League games (24 starts) over five season with the Arizona Diamondbacks (1998), Toronto Blue Jays (2001) Texas Rangers (2001-02) and Cincinnati Reds (2006) ... 12th round selection by the Athletics in 1993 ... Has been in the coaching ranks since 2009, including stops as the pitching coach for the Hagerstown Suns (2010-11), Potomac Nationals (2012-13) and Harrisburg Senators (2014-17). He was also the Minor League pitching coordinator for the Miami Marlins form 2018-20 and coached in the Washington Nationals organization from 2021-22.

MICHAEL RYAN: Enters his first year with the Rockies organization as the Isotopes bench coach ... It's his second stop in Albuquerque after the former outfielder played in 33 games for the club and hit nine homers during the 2008 campaign. He and Michalak were teammates on that squad for four days in late July ... Entered the coaching ranks in 2012 as a coach for the Double-A Altoona Curve (Pirates). He then managed in the Pirates organization at three levels for seven seasons with stops at Single-A West Virginia (2013-14), High-A Bradenton (2015-16) and Double-A Altoona (2017-19), while winning the Florida State League in 2016 and Eastern League in 2017. Ryan compiled a 221-197 managerial record with Altoona—the most wins for a manager in Curve history ... He also managed in the Cubs organization (High-A South Bend, 2021 and Double-A Tennessee, 2022-June 2023) ... A 5th round draft pick by the Minnesota Twins in 1996, played in 149 MLB games over parts of five seasons with the Twins (2002-05) and Angels (2010) ... Last Angels player to wear 27 prior to Mike Trout's call-up in 2011.

**SPLIT-SEASON PLAYOFF FORMAT**: For the second-straight year, the Pacific Coast League will use a split-season format to determine playoff participants. With one 10 team division, the first half winner (concluding June 23) will host the second half winner (beginning June 25) in a three-game set. The winner will then face the International League champion for the Triple-A Championship in Las Vegas, NV, Sept. 28.

**BALLS AND STRIKES**: The Automated Ball-Strike System (ABS), now in its third year in the Pacific Coast League, will be used for all Monday-Thursday games while the Challenge System, second year in the PCL, will be used for all Friday-Sunday contests. Each team has three challenges per game, retaining one for each successful challenge.
