LAST NIGHT: The Fisher Cats took a 3-1 lead to the bottom of the seventh inning thanks to three RBI doubles, one by Hugo Cardona in the second, by Ryan Gold in the fourth, and by Nick Podkul in the sixth. In the bottom of the seventh (Harrisburg played as home team), the Senators loaded the bases on three walks, scored on sacrifice fly by Jacob Rhinesmith, and won on a double by Gilbert Lara. The current five-game losing streak matches a season-high.

PREVIEW OF NEXT SEASON: Seven new players join the Fisher Cats for this final series. The roster includes pitcher Andrew Bash, catchers Jose Ferrer and Anthony Morales, outfielder Steward Berroa, and infielders Hugo Cardona, Spencer Horwitz, and Rafael Lantigua. Bobby Korecky came on to record a perfect ninth to give the Fisher Cats a 3-1 series win.


