LAST NIGHT: The Fisher Cats took a 3-1 lead to the bottom of the seventh inning thanks to three RBI doubles, one by Hugo Cardona in the second, by Ryan Gold in the fourth, and by Nick Podkul in the sixth. In the bottom of the seventh (Harrisburg played as home team), the Senators loaded the bases on three walks, scored on sacrifice fly by Jacob Rhinesmith, and won on a double by Gilbert Lara. The current five-game losing streak matches a season-high.

PREVIEW OF NEXT SEASON: Seven new players join the Fisher Cats for this final series. The roster includes pitcher Andrew Bash, catchers Jose Ferrer and Anthony Morales, outfielder Steward Berroa, and infielders Hugo Cardona, Spencer Horwitz, and Rafael Lantigua. Horwitz recently had a 28-game hit streak snapped for Vancouver. Hit .290 with the Canadians. Lantigua was second on Vancouver with 11 homers and 26 stolen bases.

2022 SCHEDULE RELEASE: The Fisher Cats have released a 2022 schedule, featuring home matchups on Father's Day, Fourth of July, and Labor Day Weekend. New Hampshire opens up the year on the road at Portland before their home opener on April 12th against Hartford. New Hampshire will also host Richmond, Erie, and Altoona for inter-divisional play. They will also finish the regular season again next year in Manchester against these Harrisburg Senators (Nationals).

BOB LIPMAN'S THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS HISTORY: September 17, 2011—The Fisher Cats beat the Richmond Flying Squirrels 4-3 at the Diamond to win the Eastern League Championship for the second time. The game was tied 3-3 heading to the ninth when Anthony Gose singled. Moises Sierra singled and Gose came around to score when the ball was misplayed in right field. Bobby Korecky came on to record a perfect ninth to give the Fisher Cats a 3-1 series win.

MANCHESTER BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: The Blue Jays host the Wins, the Yankees host the Indians, and the Red Sox are at Fenway to play the Orioles this weekend. Toronto and Boston are tied for the wildcard lead, a half game up on the Yankees...Rochester beat Buffalo yesterday afternoon 5-3. Forrest Wall had a two-hit game and Kirby Sneed and Kyle Johnston each worked a scoreless inning in relief...Hillsboro won 7-3 over Vancouver...Clearwater won 2-1 at Dunedin.

PLAYOFF PICTURE DOUBLE-A NORTHEAST: (Two best overall records meet for the title): Akron and Somerset are 71-45 after the Patriots won 10-4 last night at Canal Park. The teams will meet three more times. Bowie saw it's 10-game win streak snapped by Altoona 3-2. The Baysox, at 71-46, are a half game back and one back in the loss column. Portland has been eliminated.

HARRISBURG STARTER: 25-year old RHP Jackson Tetreault makes his tenth start for the Senators. His five wins are second most on the team. Allowed three runs in six innings in a quality start against the Fisher Cats on August 12 (three runs in six innings), but ended up as the losing pitcher in a game New Hampshire won 3-2. Tetreault allowed three runs in six innings last Friday against Bowie and has five quality starts among his nine outings, going at least five in every start.
