JACKSONVILLE SPLITS TWIN BILL WITH NASHVILLE
Emanuel De Jesus twirled 7.0 innings of one-run ball and Austin Allen homered Friday to lead the Jumbo Shrimp to a 4-1 victory over the Sounds. A Jordan Groshans RBI ground out opened up the scoring in the second, but Nashville tied things in the third. The score remained 1-1 until the fifth, when C.J. Hinojosa laced a two-run single. Allen's solo shot came in the seventh to cap the scoring at 4-1. Archie Bradley and Anthony Maldonado each struck out the side in an inning of relief of De Jesus, who fanned six in his strong outing.

AUSTIN POWERS

Austin Allen entered play on April 28 just 2-for-his-first-47 (.043) on the season. In the 25 games, since, however, the St. Louis native is 26-for-82 (.317/.404/.646/1.050) at the plate with six doubles, seven home runs, 14 RBIs, 11 walks and 16 runs scored. After striking out in 25.1% of his plate appearances during the 2022 campaign, Allen has whiffed just 19.6% of the time this season. His .209 BABIP is the eighth-lowest of the 220 IL players with at least 100 plate appearances in 2023.

THE BRIAN KING

Heading into play on May 12, Brian Miller had posted just a .217/.318/.315/.633 line for the season. However, over the last 20 games, the Durham, N.C., native is 26-for-70 (.371/.438/.514/.952) with six doubles, two triples, eight RBIs and 10 runs scored. After posting an 8.2 percent walk rate in 2022, Miller is walking in 11.1 percent of his plate appearances this season. He has chopped his ground ball rate from 46.3 percent to 36.5 percent.

CHICKS ARE DIGGING IT

In the 11 games from May 14-26, the Jumbo Shrimp launched just nine home runs, tied for the fifth-fewest in Triple-A. However, over the last 13 contests, Jacksonville has blasted 18 long balls, including a season-high six on May 27 against Charlotte, their most at notoriously pitcher-friendly 121 Financial Ballpark since hitting seven against the Carolina Mudcats on June 4, 2010. Those 18 home runs are tied for the seventh-most in Triple-A over the last 13 games. On the season, the Jumbo Shrimp's 63 homers rank in a tie for 17th in Triple-A.

THROUGH THE GOOD TIMES AND THE BAD

Jacksonville salvaged their seven-game series on Sunday with Durham, but the six losses the Jumbo Shrimp suffered to the Bulls were their most in any set since Montgomery swept a six-game series from June 28-July 3, 2018 at 121 Financial Ballpark. Nonetheless, Jacksonville has lost 20 of its last 29 games. During this span, the club has dropped 10.0 games in the standings (6.5 to 16.5 games back). The Jumbo Shrimp's 114 runs scored (3.9 per game) are the second-fewest in Triple-A during this span, and the club owns a collective batting line of .229/.315/.377/.692, all figures that rank in the bottom three in Triple-A. Jacksonville's 170 runs allowed (5.9 per game) is the 12th-most at the level during this run.

IT'S *STARTING* TO TURN AROUND

Over the 27 games from May 5-June 4, Jacksonville starting pitchers combined to surrender 103 runs, 100 earned, on 142 hits (12.4 H/9) in 103.1 innings for an 8.71 ERA. During this stretch, Jacksonville starters walked 64 (5.8 BB/9) against only 75 strikeouts (6.5 K/9). However, over the last six contests, the club's starting pitching has improved considerably. Over this six-game stretch, Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifters have totaled 11 runs, 11 earned, on 18 hits (5.9 H/9) in 27.1 innings for a 3.62 ERA with 18 strikeouts (5.9 K/9) against nine walks (3.0 BB/9). Jacksonville starters have yielded one run or fewer in three of these six games.

JACOB ARTIST

Jacksonville infielder Jacob Amaya came into play on May 1 with just one hit in his previous four games. His season batting line sat at .211/.284/.311/.595 with five extra-base hits. In the 29 games, since, the El Monte, Calif., native has taken his offensive game to a new level. Amaya is 35-for-104 during this stretch, slashing .337/.403/.577/.980 with five doubles, one triple, six home runs, 20 RBIs, 12 walks and 18 runs scored. After posting a .122 ISO with Triple-A Oklahoma City in 2022, Amaya's ISO is .175 this year.

SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville has scored exactly four runs in four consecutive games. They had plated at least four runs in just one of the previous seven contests... Trevor Rogers will make his third rehab start (second with JAX) on Saturday.

ABOUT TREVOR

-A native of Carlsbad, N.M., Rogers is a cousin of former major league outfielder Cody Ross, who spent 12 seasons in The Show with the Florida Marlins, Arizona Diamondbacks, San Francisco Giants, Los Angeles Dodgers, Boston Red Sox, Oakland Athletics, Cincinnati Reds and Detroit Tigers.

-Rogers had committed to pitching at Texas Tech University before signing with Miami out of high school. However, it took 344 days from draft day for Rogers to make his professional debut. Hurricane Irma wiped away an appearance in instructional league in the fall of 2017, and a variety of injuries kept Rogers out until his May 22 pro debut with Greensboro.

2023 SEASON

-1-2 with a 4.00 ERA in four starts with Miami before being placed on the Injured List on April 21 (retroactive to April 20) with a left bicep strain.

2022 SEASON

-Placed on the Injured List Friday July 29 (retroactive to July 26) with lower back spasms. He began his rehab assignment with Double-A Pensacola on August 9.

2021 SEASON

-After making seven starts with Miami during the 2020 season, Rogers came back in 2021 and established himself as a premier pitcher, allowing just 39 earned runs in 133.0 innings for a 2.64 ERA, which was good enough to earn him his first MLB All-Star selection and he finished second in Rookie of the Year voting, behind Reds INF Jonathan India.

-Rogers ranked in the 74th percentile in Average Exit Velocity (87.7), 70th percentile in Expected Batting Average (.223), 81st percentile in Expected Slugging Percentage (.343) and Strikeout Percentage (28.5%), 79th Percentile Expected ERA (3.37) and 89th Percentile in Barrel Percentage (5.0%).

2020 SEASON

-Made major league debut in game two on August 5, 2020 against the New York Mets. In that game, Rogers struck out six and yielded only one hit in four shutout innings.

-Of his seven starts, he surrendered three runs or fewer in five of them.

2019 SEASON
