Lehigh Valley IronPigs RHP Tyler Phillips (3-1, 3.94) vs. Worcester Red Sox RHP Jason Alexander (1-2, 4.76)

***A Tribute to the Deaf and Hard of Hearing*** – The Worcester Red Sox will wear special caps and jerseys with the word “WooSox” spelled out in sign language tonight in honor of their annual Deaf and Hard of Hearing Awareness Night at Polar Park when they take on the Lehigh Valley IronPigs (AAA-Philadelphia) in game four of their 6-game series at 6:05 pm (live on NESN+ along with NASH 98.9 FM and the rest of the WooSox Radio Network). The game will be followed by the traditional Friday night UniBank Fireworks display which this evening will be set to the music of Hollywood’s Greatest Hits.

***This Series*** – Worcester has a 2 games to 1 lead in this 6-game set vs. the IronPigs. Lehigh Valley got on the board in the series with a 7-1 victory last night. The WooSox won each of the first two games by 12-5 and 5-2 scores on Tuesday night and Wednesday afternoon respectively. The clubs play tonight at 6:05 pm, tomorrow at 4:05 pm, and Sunday at 1:05 pm in the series finale. After that, the teams won’t meet again until after the All-Star break for a 3-game series in Allentown, PA from July 19-21. The IronPigs will return to Polar Park for a 6-game set from August 13-18. And for the second straight year, the WooSox and IronPigs will conclude the regular season against each other for 6-games in Allentown from September 17-22.

***Leading Lehigh*** – The WooSox – who lead the season-series over Lehigh Valley by a 4 games to 2 margin thus far this year - have beaten the IronPigs 32 times in their last 51 meetings dating back to September 11, 2021. Worcester and Lehigh Valley began the 2024 season with a 3-game weekend series in Allentown, PA back from March 29-31 with the WooSox taking the series, 2 games to 1. The WooSox won the rubber game on March 31, 6-2 after evening the series at a victory apiece on March 30 with a 5-2 win thanks to a 3-run top of the 9<sup>th</sup>-inning. It was an impressive bounce back for the Sox after suffering a tough 7-4 loss on Opening Night on March 29 when the IronPigs rallied for 7 runs in the bottom of the 9<sup>th</sup>-inning to erase a 4-0 WooSox lead. The WooSox are 2-1 here vs. the Pigs at Polar Park this week with 12-5 and 5-2 victories on Tuesday & Wednesday before Lehigh Valley rolled last night, 7-1.

***Pigs Feat*** – The WooSox captured the 2023 season-series over Lehigh Valley by a 12 games to 10 count (with the final two scheduled games canceled due to rain last September 23 & 24 in Allentown). The Sox were 8-4 vs. the IronPigs at Polar Park last season while going 4-6 at Coca-Cola Park in PA. All-time, Worcester is 48-32 vs. Lehigh Valley including a 23-10 mark at Polar Park and a 25-22 record in Allentown. The WooSox won both the 2022 season-series over Lehigh Valley (10 games to 7) and the inaugural 2021 season-series (by a 22-13 count) - the 22 wins against Lehigh Valley during the 2021 season their most against any rival ever.

***Home Getting Sweeter*** - Worcester has won 6 of their last 9 home games dating back to their last series at Polar Park vs. Durham that began on April 16. As a result, the WooSox are 7-7 at home. They went over the .500 mark at Polar Park (at 7-6) for the first time this season before their loss on Thursday. Worcester went 43-33 at home last year.

***Comeback Kids*** – Until the Sox scored 4 runs in the 4<sup>th</sup>-inning to take a 4-0 lead and cruise to a 5-2 victory Wednesday afternoon, the previous seven Worcester wins since April 16 had been of the come-from-behind variety. Worcester has 8 CFB victories this season including two wins in their last at-bat of the game (the 9<sup>th</sup>-inning comeback on April 25 at Toledo, 7-5 and a 5-2 win on March 30 at Lehigh Valley when the Sox broke a tie with 3 runs in the top of the 9<sup>th</sup>-inning).

***One Has Been a Lonely Number*** – Worcester is 0-6 in 1-run games this season. Last year the WooSox went 21-24 in 1-run games. The Sox are 2-3 in 2-run games this season. Last year they were 13-10 in that category.

***Streaks*** – Worcester is 5-5 in their last 10 games. They had a season-high 4-game winning streak (from Game 2 on April 14 – April 19) that came immediately on the heels of a 4-game losing skid (April 10 – Game 1 on April 14).

***Series Math*** – Worcester is 2-3-0 in their first five series of 2024. They finished 13-8-5 in their 26 series last season...13 winners, 8 losers, and 5 splits. The WooSox went 8-3-2 in their 13 series at Polar Park and 5-5-3 in 13 sets on the road.

***Hit Me With Your Best Shot*** – Sox batters are 1<sup>st</sup> in the 20-team International League by being hit by pitch 27 times this season.

***Ground Beef*** – The WooSox have hit into only 10 double plays this season – the fewest GIDP in the league.

***Rankings*** – Worcester is 15<sup>th</sup> in the IL in team batting with a .239 average while Lehigh Valley is 11<sup>th</sup> at .247. On the pitching side, the Sox are 15<sup>th</sup> in team ERA (5.27) while the IronPigs are 16<sup>th</sup> with a 5.36 ERA.

***April Recap*** - The WooSox finished 10-14 in April (after going 2-1 in March) while batting .244 (180-for-737) with 22 HR. Sox pitchers were 10-14 with a 5.55 ERA (119 ER in 193 IP) with 25 HRA. Worcester out-scored their opponents, 129-123 in April. The month also featured five postponements, four doubleheaders, 29 player transactions, 10 players promoted to Boston (not including any rehabbers), and a total of 41 players used already (19 position players & 22 pitchers). Worcester went 11-14 last April and by the end of April, 2023 they were tied for 5<sup>th</sup>-place and 7 games back. They were in 8<sup>th</sup>-place and 6 GB at the end of this April.

***A Winning Tradition*** – The 2023 Worcester Red Sox went 79-68 to post a winning season for the third time in as many years of existence. Worcester finished with a 43-33 home record compared to 36-35 on the road last year. The 2021 WooSox went 74-54 during their abbreviated inaugural season while the 2022 WooSox finished 75-73.

***Finish Line*** – In the overall International League Standings for the 2023 season, out of 20 IL teams, Worcester finished in 7<sup>th</sup>-place with a 79-68 overall record. In the 1<sup>st</sup> half standings last year, the WooSox went 39-36 while they improved to 40-32 in the 2<sup>nd</sup> half. This season, for the second time ever, the IL will again invoke a split season with the first half starting tonight and ending on June 23 while the second half will run from June 25 – September 22.

***Month to Month*** – Worcester went 12-14 last March/April, 13-14 in May, then had three straight winning months going 16-9 in June, 13-10 in July, and 16-11 in August, before finishing 9-10 in September.

***Seven Days a Week*** – The WooSox were 0-1 on Monday last season, went 9-12 on Tuesdays, 11-11 on Wednesdays, 12-13 on Thursdays, 14-12 on Fridays, 20-6 on Saturdays, and 14-13 on Sundays in 2023.

***We Interrupt This Program*** – Worcester had a total of 14 games either postponed (11) or canceled (3) last year due to weather. They have had five postponements thus far this season (three at home and two on the road).

***You Need a Scorecard*** – The 2023 WooSox built on a pair of all-time Red Sox Triple-A records as they made **271 player transactions** during the 2023 campaign and set a new all-time Red Sox Triple-A record for players appearing in a single season. The WooSox used **79 different players** in 2023 (33 position players and 46 pitchers) to better the mark of 75 different players in 2022 (31 position players and 44 pitchers). Ironically, the 2021 WooSox set the previous mark of 72 different players (31 position players and 41 pitchers).

**Two Dozen to Go** - 24 different WooSox players were promoted to Boston during the 2023 season (not counting Red Sox rehabbing players) including Jarren Duran, Chris Murphy, Brandon Walter, David Hamilton, Wilyer Abreu, Ceddanne Rafaela, and many others.

**PORTLAND SEA DOGS UPDATE** – The Portland Sea Dogs (13-8) were rained out at home vs. Reading last night. The Sea Dogs and Fightin’ Phils play a single game tonight and a make-up doubleheader on Saturday.

**WOOSOX PLAYER MOVES** – The Worcester Red Sox today added left-handed pitcher **Joely Rodriguez** to their roster following his designation for assignment by Boston on April 28 when the Red Sox recalled RHP Naoyuki Uwasawa from Worcester. To make room, the Red Sox today transferred RHP **Cody Scroggins** to Double-A Portland.

Also today, the Red Sox transferred INF **Karson Simas** back to Single-A Greenville to create a roster spot for INF/OF **Bobby Dalbec** who has been optioned from Boston.

**Dalbec**, 28, began this season with Boston, was optioned to Worcester on April 8, recalled again on April 12, and optioned again today. Overall in 22 games with Boston, Bobby hit .132 (7-for-53) with 4 RBI and in 2 games with Worcester he was 1-for-7 with a solo HR. Dalbec was the WooSox MVP in 2023 batting .269 in 114 games while leading the team in HR (33), runs (82), RBI (79), hits (111), XBH (50), OBP (.381), SLG (.557), and OPS (.938). Among all Triple-A players, Dalbec ranked tied for 1<sup>st</sup> in HR, 6<sup>th</sup> in SLG, and 8<sup>th</sup> in OPS. He was one of only four minor leaguers with 30+ homers and 10+ stolen bases (he had 18 SB in 20 attempts). For the WooSox, Bobby made 36 starts at 3B, 36 in RF, 27 at 1B, 6 at SS, and 8 as the DH. He was recalled to Boston four different times in 2023 and appeared in 21 games with the Red Sox. Dalbec had been a mainstay in the Boston lineup each of the prior two years appearing in 117 games for the Red Sox in 2022 and 133 games in 2021 while belting a combined total of 37 HR. Boston’s 4<sup>th</sup> round choice in the 2016 June draft, he was a two-way standout at the University of Arizona smacking 24 HR in 172 games and posting a 2.65 ERA in 72 appearances on the mound.

**Rodriguez**, 32, had a 6.55 ERA (8 ER/11.0 IP) in 11 relief appearances for the Red Sox this season. Originally signed by the Pittsburgh Pirates in May 2009, the Dominican Republic native has recorded a 4.82 ERA in 179 career Major League games with the Philadelphia Phillies (2016-17), Texas Rangers (2020-21), New York Yankees (2021), New York Mets (2022), and Red Sox (2023-24). From 2018-19, the left-hander pitched for the Chunichi Dragons of Japan’s Nippon Professional Baseball. Originally signed by the Pittsburgh Pirates as an international free agent in 2009, Joely is in his 16<sup>th</sup> professional season. He pitched in 11 games for the Red Sox last season and 7 with the WooSox, but spent most of the year on the injured list with three different injuries to his oblique, shoulder, and hip.

The WooSox have already sent 10 players to Boston in the five weeks since the season started...INF David Hamilton, INF Romy Gonzalez, LHP Brennan Bernardino, INF/OF Bobby Dalbec, RHP Cooper Criswell, LHP Joe Jacques, LHP Cam Booser, C Tyler Heineman, RHP Zack Kelly, and RHP Naoyuki Uwasawa. Those ten do not include OF Rob Refsnyder and INF Vaughn Grissom who were injury rehab recalls from Worcester to Boston. Dalbec is back with the WooSox, Gonzalez & Heineman are currently on Boston’s injured list, and Jacques was claimed off waivers by Arizona, but the rest of those players are still with the Red Sox.
