RANCHO CUCAMONGA QUAKES (20-8) Visalia Rawhide (13-15)





RHP Christian Zazueta (2-1, 2.49 ERA) vs. RHP Connor Foley (0-2, 9.90 ERA)

TODAY'S GAME: The Quakes continue a six-game road trip tonight, with game two of a six-game series against the Visalia Rawhide (AZ). The Quakes will return to LoanMart Field on Tuesday, May 13th, taking on the Inland Empire 66ers in a six-game series. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE RAWHIDE: Today's game is the second of 24 head-to-head meetings and the second of 15 here at Valley Strong Ballpark. Last season, the Quakes went 14-16 against the Rawhide, 7-8 here in Visalia.

LAST GAME: The Quakes won their third straight game, taking Tuesday's series-opener at Valley Strong Ballpark by a final of 3-0 over the Visalia Rawhide. Four Quakes combined on a four-hit shutout, with Sean Paul Linan, Felix Cabrera (1-2), Michael Vilchez and Marco Corcho helping the Quakes to their 11th win over their last 12 games. Corcho got the final two outs of a shaky eighth inning, before working a 1-2-3 ninth for his first save of the year. Visalia starter Denny Larrondo (0-3) took the loss, giving up two runs over five innings, including a two-run homer to Eduardo Quintero (4). Rancho's offense finished with just five hits, with Jaron Elkins recording the only multi-hit game. WIN BABY WIN: Friday's loss ended Rancho's best run of the season, at eight straight wins overall and five straight

at home. While both those streaks ended on Friday, two straight wins to finish the Stockton series and a win over Visalia last night, gives Rancho 11 wins in their last 12 overall and the best record in the entire league at 20-8. They're now 12-3 at LoanMart Field, having gone 3-0 against Lake Elsinore, 4-2 against San Jose and 5-1 against the Ports. Their longest winning streak since moving from High-A to Low-A is 10 straight (2023). Their longest winning streak in franchise history was in their third and most recent championship season of 2018, when they won 15 straight.

ZEROS ARE A GOOD THING: Last night's shutout gives Rancho three on the year, but two over their last three games. The Quakes' team ERA is 3.38, second only to San Jose's 3.22. Rancho's staff also leads the league in strikeouts with 329, 40 more than the next closest team (Fresno with 289).

ROSTER MOVES: The Quakes officially placed INF Nico Perez on the IL for the second time this year with a hamstring injury. Taking his place on the roster is INF Mairo Martinus, who joins the club down from Great Lakes. **WEEKLY AWARDS SWEEP:** The Quakes had a great home stand and the Cal League's weekly awards reflect that. Quakes' starting pitcher Sterling Patick (five perfect innings against Stockton) was named the Pitcher of the Week, while Mike Sirota (7-for-20, 2 HR, 5 RBI, 7 R, 4 BB, .458 OBP, 1.208 OPS) was named Hitter of the week.

CHRISTIAN ZAZUETA: Right-hander Christian Zazueta makes his sixth start of the year and his first against the Rawhide. In his last start overall, he allowed one run on four hits over 4.1 innings in a no-decision against Stockton on May 1st. Zazueta made 14 appearances (11 starts) for the Quakes in 2024, going 1-5 with a 6.36 ERA, allowing 37 earned runs over 52.1 innings pitched. Against Visalia in 2024, he went 0-2 with a 9.00 ERA across four games (three starts) and 14 innings. Zazueta signed with the Yankees in 2022 out of Mexico and then was traded to the Dodgers in February of 2024 as part of the trade that saw former Quake Caleb Ferguson go to the Yankees.

CONNOR FOLEY: Right-hander Connor Foley makes his fifth start of the year and his first against the Quakes. In his last outing, he allowed four runs on six hits over just two innings in a no-decision versus Fresno on April 30th. Foley entered the 2025 season as the 23rd-ranked Arizona prospect by MLB Pipeline. Foley was drafted in the fifth round of the 2024 draft out of Indiana University and did not pitch professionally in 2024, after being drafted.
