RIDERS WIN THIRD STRAIGHT BEHIND NINE-RUN FIRST INNING:

All nine Frisco RoughRiders starters scored in a nine-run first inning as the Riders put away the Wichita Wind Surge 10-4 on Tuesday at Riverfront Stadium. With nine runs, nine hits and three Wichita (9-13, 37-53) errors, Frisco (12-10, 43-47) scored its most runs in an inning this season. **Aidan Anderson** struck out a career-high six batters in his start of three innings, allowing one run. **Nick Starr** held off the Wind Surge for two innings out of the bullpen, allowing no runs in his longest appearance in four years. **Triston Polley** (2-0) took the win in his two innings with three runs allowed. **Evan Carter** and **Luisangel Acuña** led off the game with infield singles and **Trevor Hauver** started the scoring with a ground rule double. The next three hitters singled on the first pitch: Josh Hatcher for two RBIs, **Liam Hicks** on an infield single and **Kellen Strahm**'s base hit to right field. **David Garcia** then doubled off the wall for an RBI, **Jax Biggers** added an infield single — the fourth of the inning for Frisco — and Acuña recorded his second hit of the frame with a single through the right side. That hit chased Chad Donato (1-6) from the game, who was charged with eight earned runs in his start of 0.2 innings. Since Acuña was put out at second on a fielder's choice earlier in the inning, he was the only starter to not score yet in the inning. After his second hit of the frame, he stole second, advanced to third on a wild pitch, and scored on a wild pickoff throw. The Riders reached double digits in the fourth inning thanks to Hauver's triple off the right-center wall. Hicks' single over third base brought Hauver home to make it 10-1. Hauver doubled again in the eighth for his third extra-base hit of the day. Acuña extended his on-base streak to 22 games. He went 3-for-5 with two infield singles and two stolen bases. Hicks also collected three hits and extended his hitting streak to seven games.

GENTLEMEN, START YOUR ENGINES:

The RoughRiders have struggled on the starting pitching side of things this season. This year, Frisco has a 6.18 starting pitcher ERA which is the highest in recorded franchise history (dating back to 2005) and last in the Texas League. Including Anderson, they have used 17 different starting pitchers, more than the 14 they used all season in 2022 and just under the 19 they used the whole year in 2021. Frisco has not had a start of more than 5.1 innings since June 10th, when **Ryan Garcia** went seven innings. Over those 35 games since June 11th, the Riders' starters' ERA is 7.62 (103ER/121.2IP) while the bullpen has a 4.43 ERA (90ER/182.2IP). Over the 35 games, the Riders have the fourth-best offense in the league by OPS (.764) and have hit 31 home runs (7th in the Texas League).

HATCH IS THE RIGHT MATCH:

Since coming to Frisco in June from High-A Hickory, **Josh Hatcher** has been a run-producing machine. In his 20 games, he has driven in 22 runs and in July, Hatcher is hitting .288/.333/.462/.795 with three homers and 18 RBIs in 14 games.

WELCOME BACK, CARTER:

Evan Carter has been fantastic since returning from the Injured List on June 21st against Springfield. Over his last 27 games since his return, he has nine multi-hit games, batting .327 (34-for-104)/.423/.567/.990 with three doubles, two triples, six home runs, 20 RBIs and 21 runs scored.

THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE:

Thomas Saggese has been incredible for the RoughRiders on offense. Over his last 39 games, he is hitting .342/.424/.618/1.042 with 10 home runs and 36 RBIs. The California native is currently fifth in the league in batting average (.307), tied for second in RBIs (71), first in hits (108), fourth in doubles (21) and first in total bases (177).

AMBUSH EARLY AND OFTEN:

Thomas Saggese has been fantastic on first pitches this season, first in the Texas League (min. 11 at-bats) with a .548 average (17-for-31) when he puts the first pitch of an at-bat in play. He has a 1.447 OPS on the first pitch, which is first in the league as well. **Luisangel Acuña** has also been great, hitting .459 (28-for-61) on the initial offering while his 28 hits on the first pitch lead the league and are fourth in the minors.

SPEED KILLS:

Luisangel Acuña leads the league in steals with 39 and is on pace for a career-best 59 swipes. Acuña is on pace to set a single-season record for the Riders, as **Elvis Andrus** has the record with 54 swipes in 2008. The RoughRiders are fifth in Texas League steals with 114 bases in 136 attempts (84 percent).

ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Thomas Saggese** hitting Frisco's eighth grand slam of the season. They are one of three teams with at least eight grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Six different players have accounted for the grand slams (Hicks, **Luisangel Acuña**, **Jax Biggers**, **Dustin Harris**, **Trevor Hauver**, **Thomas Saggese** (3)). On July 5th, the Riders allowed their first grand slam this year, becoming the final Texas League team to do so.

ACUÑA MATATA:

RoughRiders infielder **Luisangel Acuña** has been on fire at the plate. The Rangers No. 3 prospect has reached safely in a Riders' season-high 22 games in a row, batting .348/.412/.435/.847. He is fourth in the Texas League in batting average (.308), second in hits (107), third in doubles (22), second in runs (63) and first in steals (39).

ABOUT RYAN

-Went to La Salle High School in Pasadena, California. There, his senior year, he owned a 1.16 ERA while striking out 48 in 42.1 innings, but played primarily infield.

-Went to UCLA camp as an infielder and asked one of the coaches if he could pitch the last inning of one of the games. He ended up throwing well enough that UCLA invited him out for a visit as a pitcher. He came back two weeks later and committed on the spot.

-At UCLA, he was named Pac-12 Pitcher of the Year and a consensus First Team All-American in 2019 as a junior. Over 16 games (13 starts), Garcia went 10-1 with a 1.44 ERA. In 94.0 innings, he whiffed 117 batters while walking just 26 and holding opponents to a .160 batting average. In his career with the Bruins, he went 20-2 with a 2.11 ERA. His 2.11 career ERA is seventh in UCLA history.

-His best start during his junior year came against Utah on April 26th, 2019. Over a 9.0-inning complete-game, shutout he struck out 14 batters while allowing just three base runners (two hits and one walk). The 14 strikeouts were the most by a UCLA starter since Trevor Bauer in 2011.

-Led the Wareham Gatemen of the Cape Cod League to a championship in 2018, going 2-0 with a 1.28 ERA over 10 outings.

-Now lives in Surprise, Arizona, about two blocks away from the Rangers Spring Training Complex.

2023 SEASON

-In his Double-A debut on April 11th at San Antonio, Garcia allowed just two solo home runs while tying a career-best five innings.

-Allowed career-high eight runs over 2.2 innings against Wichita on 5/10 during a day game.

-Went a career-high seven innings at Corpus Christi, finishing with just 83 pitches.

2022 SEASON

-Was activated in late May while continuing his rehabilitation from injuries.

-His thought for the 2022 season was "I have built a house this season, coming back from injury, and next season, I will be able to fortify the house."

-Averaged 11.8 K/9 over his 14 games (13 starts).

2021 SEASON

-Missed the entire 2021 season with a right lat strain. That required two months of rest and then trying to build back up, but he strained his lat three different times and was unable to get back on the mound.

2019 SEASON

-Three starts into his professional career, he went on the Injured List with a right elbow strain and underwent "Tommy John" surgery on March 16th, 2020.

-During his TJ rehab, he built a computer from scratch and is very interested in technology.
