AVILAS POWERS HOOKS OVER RIDERS IN FINALE:

Luis Avilas Jr. stole the show on Sunday afternoon for the Corpus Christi Hooks, hitting a two-run home run to tie the game in the ninth before blasting a two-run, 11th-inning walk-off homer to win it 7-5 over the Frisco RoughRiders from Whataburger Field. Avilas crushed two homers in a game for the second time in the series for the Hooks (28-29) and he totaled five long balls in the last three games of the set, getting the last one against Aidan Anderson (0-1). The Riders (25-30) struck first early in the first inning with a solo homer run from Aaron Zavala, his second of the year, to make it 1-0. After another Frisco run scored on an error in the second, **Thomas Saggese** made it 3-0 with a solo shot of his own in the third. It was Saggese's third of the series and his seventh of the year to tie **Nick Tanielu** for the team high. Corpus then tied it with a two-run home run and a solo homer in the third and fourth innings, respectively against Frisco starter **Jack Leiter**. Leiter went five innings in his start, allowing three runs on four hits while striking out seven and walking two. The RoughRiders took the lead 5-3 in the top of the ninth when two runs scored on a throwing error by Avilas, adding to his heroics. Cesar Gomez (1-1) came in and pitched a scoreless 11th to earn the victory for Corpus.

OWEN THEM NOTHING, GIVING THEM EVERYTHING:

Pitcher **Owen White** was named Texas League Pitcher of the Week for the week of June 5-11. White took the hill for the RoughRiders on June 7 in Corpus Christi and tossed seven shutout innings to earn the win. White gave up just one hit to the 23 batters he faced, walking two and striking out six. Frisco won the game, 9-0. White now has three starts in which he has not allowed a run, earned or unearned. In seven of his 11 starts, he has allowed two runs or fewer. His ERA this season is 3.54 over 53.1 innings. White also won Texas League Pitcher of the Week honors last year after a start against Corpus Christi on July 1, 2022, when he logged 5.1 scoreless innings. This is the second season in a row White was the first RoughRiders pitcher to earn Texas League Pitcher of the Week. Last year, White won the award in just his second start at the Double-A level. The former second-round selection in 2018 has a 3.24 ERA over 75 innings in Double-A.

Thomas Saggese returns to Northwest Arkansas for the first time since his first week in Double-A in 2022, in which he won Texas League Player of the Week by batting .381 (8-for-21)/.409/.857/1.266 with three doubles, two triples, a home run, nine RBIs, five runs scored with a steal and a

Reliever **Alex Speas** now has an ERA under 1.00 at 0.82 over 19 appearances. In 22.0 innings, he has struck out 36 to 11 walks. Opponents are hitting just .143 against him and he has not allowed an earned run over his last 10 outings. During that span, he has struck out 21 to four walks over 11.2 innings. On the season, righties are just hitting .123 (7-for-57) against him on the season with a .383 OPS.

POWER SURGE

After only hitting two home runs over a two-week span, the RoughRiders hit eight long balls in Corpus Christi through the six games of the series. In the six games, Frisco hit .236/.336/.415/.751 with 14 doubles, eight home runs and 6.0 runs per game. Luisangel Acuña has led the way, hitting .318/.375/.455/.830 in the set while both Thomas Saggese hit three home runs.

AMBUSH EARLY AND OFTEN:

Thomas Saggese has been fantastic on first pitches this season, tied for first in the Texas League with a .600 average (12-for-20) when he puts the first pitch of an at-bat in play. He has a 1.619 OPS on the first pitch after homering on the first pitch on Saturday. Luisangel Acuña has also been great, hitting .472 (17-for-36) on the initial offering while his 17 hits on the first pitch lead the league.

DUSTIN' THEM AND LEAVING THEM BEHIND:

Dustin Harris has been running wild for the RoughRiders this season. After stealing 19 bases in 85 games in 2022, Harris has already swiped 23 bags in 54 games this season to lead the Texas League and the entire Rangers organization. If Harris plays 110 games this season, he is on pace for 48 steals, which would by far be a career high. **Luisangel Acuña** leads the league in steals with 25. The RoughRiders are second in Texas League swipes with 83 bases in 97 attempts (86 percent).

ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE, AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Thomas Saggese** hitting Frisco's seventh grand slam of the season on last Friday. They are one of two teams with seven grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Six different players have accounted for the grand slams (Hicks, Luisangel Acuña, Jax Biggers, Dustin Harris, Trevor Hauver, Thomas Saggese (2)). Frisco also has a 1.184 OPS with the bags full, which is third in the minors (Low-A Myrtle Beach, 1.262 and Triple-A Saint Paul, 1.226)

RoughRiders infielder **Luisangel Acuña** has been on fire to start his 2023 season. The Rangers No. 3 prospect is hitting .298 (61-for-205)/.367/.420/.787 through the first 48 games. Over his last 44 games, he is batting .310/.384/.444/.828. When the 21-year-old arrived in Frisco in 2022, he had a wRC+ of 68 while it has nearly doubled this season (112).

WALK THIS WAY:

On the season, Frisco's 279 walks are tied for first among Texas League teams while their .350 team OBP is fourth in the Texas League. Dustin Harris is first in the league with 41 walks.

-Matthews lettered four years in basketball and baseball at Punxsutawney Area High School. He finished his career on the mound 20-0 with 172 career strikeouts. He was named District MVP and Central Penn Player of the Year as a senior.

-Matthews began time at Kent State as a two-way player, hitting .221 with eight doubles in 2017 as a freshman while making five appearances on the mound with a $5.40\,\mathrm{ERA}$. Made the full-time move to the bullpen for sophomore season, owning a 2.51 ERA over 28.2 innings with a 38 strikeouts. For his junior year, Matthews was a made 11 starts out of his 16 outings, going 7-6 with a 5.45 ERA.
