SHRIMP TAKE RUBBER MATCH FROM SOUNDS

The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp bullpen worked 7.0 scoreless inning to win Sunday's rubber match from the Nashville Sounds 2-1 in 10 innings. Nashville scored in their first at-bats on a Jared Oliva single coupled with a three-base error. The score remained 1-0 until the seventh, when Jack Winkler's RBI single plated Albert Almora Jr. Finally, the Jumbo Shrimp broke the 1-1 deadlock in the 10th with Jacob Berry's sacrifice fly. Christian Roa worked a 1-2-3 ninth and then a scoreless 10th to earn the win in his Jumbo Shrimp debut.

'PEN PALS

Jumbo Shrimp starter **Freddy Tarnok** pitched well in his 3.0 innings on Sunday, and then the club's bullpen took over in a game that wound up being 10 innings in a 2-1 victory. Five Jacksonville relievers combined for 7.0 shutout innings, ceding only two hits and four walks with seven strikeouts. Thus far in 2025, the Jumbo Shrimp bullpen has combined to yield only six runs, three earned, on nine hits in 15.0 innings. The club's 1.80 bullpen ERA ranks fourth in Triple-A, with the club's .167 batting average against and 17 strikeouts placing third at the level.

SOUNDS BITES

Jacksonville rebounded from a 7-1 loss on Opening Day in Nashville to blast the Sounds 11-3 on Saturday and then squeak by Sunday with a 2-1 triumph in 10 innings. Thus, the Jumbo Shrimp earned their first road series victory at the Sounds since rejoining Triple-A in 2021. Jacksonville had previously been 0-3-1 in sets at Nashville. Prior to Sunday, the Jumbo Shrimp had also not recorded a series win against the Sounds since taking three of five from Nashville from April 18-23, 2023.

The 2024 season saw unprecedented player movement in Northeast Florida. Jacksonville set franchise records in their combined Triple-A/Double-A era (1962-present) with 90 players used, including a club record 51 pitchers. The Jumbo Shrimp also smashed another franchise record with 28 different starting pitchers used during the 2024 campaign. All told, Jacksonville had 267 transactions throughout the 2024 season.

CARP-E DIEM

The 2025 season will be **David Carpenter's** first piloting a team in MiLB. The 39-year-old spent the last two seasons at the helm of the West Virginia Black Bears in the MLB Draft League while also serving as the pitching coach at Division II Fairmont State University from 2021-24. With the Black Bears, he posted an 81-66 (.551) record, steering West Virginia to a league championship in 2023. Carpenter pitched in 222 MLB games over six seasons from 2011-15 and 2019 with the Astros, Blue Jays, Braves, Yankees, Nationals and Rangers. He registered a career 3.69 ERA in the big leagues. Carpenter's ties to the IL include a stint of eight games pitched with Gwinnett from 2013-14 and 39 games with Nashville, then a PCL club, in 2019.

I DON'T KNOW WHY YOU SAY GOODBYE, I SAY HELLO

Of Jacksonville's 28-man Opening Day roster to begin the 2025 season, a whopping 15 players have previously played for the Jumbo Shrimp. The 2025 Jumbo Shrimp also feature six members of the Miami Marlins' Top 30 prospects. That list is headed by catcher **Agustin Ramírez**, who *Baseball Prospectus* ranks as the No. 55 prospect in the entirety of baseball.

DE LOS SANTOS CLAUS

Jumbo Shrimp infielder **Deyvison De Los Santos** is coming off a monster 2024 season while playing for Jacksonville, Triple-A Reno and Double-A Amarillo. The 21-year-old native of Santo Domingo in the Dominican Republic led all of Minor League Baseball in home runs (40), RBIs (120) and total bases (307). He also ranked in the top 20 in the minor leagues in hits (2nd, 158), extra-base hits (T-2nd, 67), slugging percentage (5th, .571), OPS (10th, .914) and runs scored (18th, 89). Of the 250 hardest-hit balls in Triple-A during the 2024 season, De Los Santos smacked 11 of them, including a 116.0 mile per hour (10th overall in Triple-A) single while playing for Reno on June 12, 2024.

SHRIMP BITES

The Jumbo Shrimp are 1-8 (.111) all-time against the Worcester Red Sox... Jacksonville is 12-7 (.632) in their home openers since 2005. The club is 2-2 (.500) in home openers since returning to Triple-A in 2021... The Jumbo Shrimp rank second in the IL with seven stolen bases.

ABOUT EDWARD

- -Cabrera made his major league debut for the Marlins on August 25, 2021 against the Washington Nationals from loanDepot park. He yielded three runs on four hits in 6.1 innings.
- -Cabrera was a consensus Top-100 prospect in 2022, ranked 33rd by *The Athletic*, 34th by *MLB Pipeline* and No. 69 by both *Baseball Prospectus* and *Baseball America*.
- -The Marlins were fairly aggressive with Cabrera in the minor leagues, starting his professional career in the Gulf Coast League. After just 82.2 innings in 24 games, including 13 starts, with the GCL Marlins and Short Season Class A Batavia, Cabrera found himself in full season ball with Low-A Greensboro in 2018 at the age of 19.

2024 SEASON

-Cabrera held right-handed hitters to a .216/.302/.347/.649 batting line in 251 plate appearances. However, lefties slashes .235/.352/.403/.755 against him in 264 plate appearances.

2023 SEASON

- -Posted a 2.91 ERA in seven home MLB starts, going 5-0 while going 0-6 in 10 road starts with a 6.28 ERA
- -Named the IL Pitcher of the Week for the week of August 7-13 after tossing 6.0 shutout innings of one-hit ball with 10 strikeouts on August 12 against Norfolk.

2022 SEASON

-In 14 starts with Miami, posted a 1.49 ERA in seven road starts versus a 4.58 ERA in seven starts at home.

2021 SEASON

-Cabrera made two rehab starts with Low-A Jupiter on June 6 and June 12, throwing 6.0 scoreless innings with 11 strikeouts and no walks. His rehab assignment ended on June 15, when he was assigned to Double-A Pensacola. After five starts with the Blue Wahoos, he was promoted to Jacksonville on July 15.

2020 SEASON

-Cabrera was a member of the Marlins' Alternate Training Site.

2019 SEASON

-The Santiago, Dominican Republic native surrendered four runs to the first five batters he faced on the season on April 5 at Palm Beach. However, he did not cede another tally until the sixth inning of his start on May 23, a span of 28 consecutive scoreless innings.
