TODAY'S GAME: The Fayetteville Woodpeckers (Low-A Astros) continue a six-game road trip today against the Down East Wood Ducks (Low-A, Rangers). This is the first time Fayetteville has played a series at Grainger Stadium in 2022, along with being the fifth contest of the 24-game season series.. The Woodpeckers trail the series 3-1 after a 4-3 loss on Friday night. Today, RHP Bryant Salgado will get the start for Fayetteville while Down East will start LHP Mitch Bratt.

THE OPPONENTS: The Down East Wood Ducks are in their fifth season in the Carolina League. In 2021, the Down East Wood Ducks made it to the Carolina League Championship Series, falling to the Charleston RiverDogs in five games. The franchise won its lone Carolina League title in 2017. The Wood Ducks are owned by the Texas Rangers and play their games at Grainger Stadium, which opened in 1949 and holds 4,100 people. The Wood Ducks have an all-time record of 25-18 against the Woodpeckers in the regular season.

Q ON THE MOVE: On Tuesday, OF Quincy Hamilton was promoted to the High-A Asheville Tourists, becoming the sixth player and first position player to earn a promotion for High-A. At the time of his promotion, Hamilton led the Woodpeckers in hits (39), HR (6), RBI (19), R (22) TB (65) and slashed .291/.400/.485 over 36 games. He batted .348 in May and held the sixth highest OPS in the Carolina League during the month at 1.024.

THE PROSPECTS: The Woodpeckers are currently carrying three of the Astros Top-30 Prospects on their active roster. RHP Alex Santos is the highest rated of the bunch, starting the year at #10. 2021 third-round draft pick outfielder Tyler Whitaker sits right behind Santos at #11. Logan Cerny, who was acquired by the Astros in a trade in November with the Phillies, rounds out the trio at #26 in the system.

RUNNING WILD: Fayetteville has stolen 72 bags in 2022, the third most in the Carolina League behind the Charleston RiverDogs (95) and the Down East Wood Ducks (77). It continues a trend from 2021, a season where Fayetteville stole 205 bases (2nd in Carolina League) over 120 games.

SLUGGERS OF THE CAROLINAS: Over the first 43 games of the regular season, the Woodpeckers lead the Carolina League with 42 long-balls. Last week in their road series with Kannapolis, the Woodpeckers homered in all six games and combined to hit 13 home-runs, the most in a single series this year. Two players specifically enjoyed a power surge at the plate; Kenedy Corona belted homers in three straight games and Tyler Whitaker homered in back-to-back games.

CORONA, FIND YOUR SWING: Outfielder Kenedy Corona has been on an offensive tear over the last two weeks on the road. Corona homered in three straight games in Kannapolis from 5/20-5/22 and hit a game-winning two-run HR in the top of the tenth inning at Down East on 5/26. Corona is now leads the Woodpeckers in RBI (21) and his tied for the team lead with 6 HR. During the last nine road games played, Corona is slashing .405/.450/.811 with 4 HR, 3 2B, 11 RBI, 8 R, 3 BB, 5 K.

GOOD WITH THE BAD: The Woodpeckers pitching staff has issued a Carolina League-high 251 walks so far in 2022. However, they have made up for it by missing bats as Fayetteville has struck out the most batters in the league with 491. Additionally, in the month of May, the Woodpeckers have allowed the second fewest hits (152) in the league and own the fourth-lowest earned run average of the month at 3.64, compared to a 4.99 ERA in April.

WHIT WITH THE HITS: Tyler Whitaker broke out of a hitting slump last week in Kannapolis, going 7-for-20 at the plate with 2 HR, 2B, and 7 RBI. Prior to the breakout series, Whitaker had just four hits over 12 games in May. He hit home-runs in consecutive games on 5/21 and 5/22 after going without a HR in his first 35 Low-A games. Whitaker still leads the Carolina League in strikeouts with 69.

KINSTON HEARTBREAK: Abi Ortiz hit a walk-off two-run HR in the bottom of the 9th inning on Friday night marking the fourth time within the last calender year that Fayetteville has lost at Grainger Stadium in walk-off fashion. The Wood Ducks walked off both games of a double-header on 7/29/21 on an Alejandro Osuna HR and a Angel Aponte RBI single, and walked off this week on Tuesday and Friday.

15 Joe Thon Manager Vincent Blue

Thon makes his return to Fayetteville and begins his first season as Woodpeckers manager after serving as a development coach in 2021.

As the development coach, Thon helped coach Woodpeckers hitters and fielders, as well as assist with lineup planning and creating reports on individual athletes on the team.

Prior to joining the Astros as a full-time coach, Thon served as a summer intern with the organization during the 2019 summer. He helped analyze and balance revenue summaries, verified accounts for reconciling payments and processed and organized invoices for the Astros and Astros Foundation.

Following his intership, Thon broke into the coaching ranks by joining the University of Houston Baseball program in August 2019 as a student assistant coach before becoming the volunteer assistant prior to the 2020 season. After one season with UofH, Thon returned to the Astros in a full-time coaching role.

The former Minor League infielder enjoyed a seven-year minor league playing career. Thon was drafted in the 5th round (pick 156) by the Toronto Blue Jays in 2010 out of Academia Perpetuo Socorro in San Juan, Puerto Rico. He played in the Blue Jays organizationuntil 2016 when he signed to join the St. Louis Cardinals. Thon played in the Cardinals farm system through 2017, reaching as Double-A with the Springfield Cardinals. His playing career concluded in 2017 in the Independent Atlanta League with the Sugar Land Skeeters, now the Triple-A Affiliate of the Astros. In total, Thon appeared in over 500 games across his MiLB career, posting a .243/.356/.318 slash line with 79 doubles, 17 triples, 27 home-runs and 178 RBI. Thon also played for Liga de Beisbol Professional Roberto Clemente in Puerto Rico from 2010 through December 2016.

Thon comes from a deep baseball background. He is the son of former Astros shortstop Dickie Thon, a 1983 All-Star with Houston who enjoyed a 15-year MLB career with the California Angels, Astros, Padres, Phillies, Rangers and Brewers.

Joe and his fiance Erika spend their offseason living in Houston with their dogs.

23 Jose Puentes Hitting Coach

Joining the Woodpeckers for his first season with the franchise and third season in the Astros organization is hitting coach Jose Puentes.

Puentes started his career with the Astros as a hitting coach in the Dominican Summer League and most recently served as hitting coach with the Florida Complex League Astros in 2021.

He has coached at the high school level at MacArthur High School, Johnson High School, Steele High School and Wagner High School. From 2006-2007, he was the head baseball coach at St. Anthony Catholic High School. Puentes has owned and operated two hitting academies, Gap to Gap Academy and Cardinals Select Baseball Academy.

He earned his bachelor's degree in Spanish and Master's degree in teaching from University of Incarnate Word along with a Master's degree in education from the University of Texas at San Antonio.

16 John Kovalik Pitching Coach

John Kovalik takes over as the third pitching coach in Woodpeckers history, bringing three years of coaching experience to the Woodpeckers staff. The 30-year-old enters his fourth season in the Astros organization after serving as the pitching coach for the Tri-City Valley Cats in 2019, along with the pitching coach for the Florida Complex League Astros in 2021. While with the Valley Cats, Kovalik coached Astros farmhands and future big leaguers Luis Garcia, Jose Urquidy and Shawn Dubin along with other high-level pitching prospects.

Prior to his time with the Astros, Kovalik spent three seasons as pitching coach (2016-2018) at Slippery Rock University, where he oversaw all aspects of the team's pitching program.

Kovalik earned his bachelor's degree from Slippery Rock, where he also pitched for the baseball team. Following his college career he played four seasons in the Independent leagues for the Frontier Greys and the Gary-Southshore Railcats. Kovalik trained at Driveline Baseball during the 2016 and 2017 offseasons.
