LAST TIME IN ZEBBY: After winning the fourth of July week series with Delmarva four games to two, the FredNats hit the road for the final week before the All-Star break to Five County Stadium in Zebulon, NC to play the Milwaukee Brewer-affiliated Mudcats. This is the last series Fredericksburg will play at Five County before it closes at the end of the season and the Mudcats move to Wilson, NC to become the Wilson Warbirds. These two teams currently hold the top two spots in the North Division in the second half through the first 15 games of the half. RHP Xander Meckley makes the first of two scheduled starts this week. Meckley has struggled against the Mudcats this year, allowing six earned runs in 8.1 innings across two starts against Carolina. Torres allowed three runs in four innings in his only start against the FredNats back in May.

**SEASON SERIES REVIEW**: Fredericksburg was swept by the Mudcats on Opening Weekend at Five County, losing three close games. Then, the two teams split a six-game series in May in Fredericksburg. Carolina has outscored the FredNats 46-32 despite the teams having nearly the exact same hitting stats against each other except for walks. The Mudcats have drawn 65 walks against FredNat pitching, and Fredericksburg hitters have only walked 39 times against Carolina.

ICE IN HIS VEINS: Cristhian Vaquero picked up his third walk-off hit of the season on Saturday night against Delmarva. Vaquero hit a walk-off home run against Carolina at the end of May, and has two walk-off singles against Delmarva. He also ended a game in Lynchburg by throwing out the potential tying run at home plate to secure a victory. In the second half, Vaquero has been the most consistent FredNat hitter. His .315 batting average in the second half is ninth in the Carolina League, and his .880 OPS is also ninth. His 28 total bases in the second half is tied for the fourth-most in the league as well.

**THIS BULLPEN IS INSANE**: The FredNat bullpen has been central to the team's efforts all season, but the group has taken it to a new level since June 1. Since then, FBG's bullpen ERA is 2.24, which is second in all of affiliated professional baseball (150 total teams) behind Pittsburgh's Double-A affiliate Altoona. Fredericksburg is 28-1 when leading after seven innings this season, and 24-1 when leading after eight innings.

**DON'T EVEN TRY IT:** The FredNat catching duo of Kevin Bazzell and Nate Rombach has been prolific at throwing out potential base stealers this season. As a team, Fredericksburg's 63 caught stealings is number one in MiLB. Among the top five teams in that stat category, Fredericksburg has allowed 36 fewer total stolen bases than the next team. Bazzell has retaken the MiLB lead with 39 caught stealings and owns the best CS% of all MiLB catchers who have played at least 350 innings this year, throwing out 39% of would-be base stealers. Rombach has 24 caught stealings himself, a top-13 mark in Single-A baseball, and is throwing out 34% of potential base stealers.

**DAVIAN'S DOMINANCE**: After Wednesday night's win, Davian Garcia has now thrown 11 scoreless innings in a row across his last two starts, and in his last three starts combined, he's allowed a total of one run. Since June 1, Garica's ERA is 0.82 (T-fourth in the league), his BAA against is .114 (first in the league), and his WHIP is 0.68 (fourth). Since his last start at Delmarva on May 18, Garcia is tied for the fewest hits allowed (15) among all Minor League Baseball pitchers with at least 36 innings pitched in that time frame, and his .122 BAA is also first in MiLB. Garcia's 1.17 ERA in that time frame is third-best in MiLB among the qualified pitchers too.

**THE STAFF:** After Jake Lowery's third season as Manager of the FredNats ended in a Carolina League championship in 2024, the FredNats welcome Billy McMillon as the third Manager in Fredericksburg franchise history. McMillon, 53, has spent the last three seasons in the Nationals organization as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. He also played parts of six seasons in the Major Leagues with Oakland, Detroit, Philadelphia and Florida. He's joined on the staff by returning Pitching Coach Justin Lord, returning Hitting Coach Mike Habas, Development Coach Luis Ordaz, returning Athletic Trainer Jacob Meyer, Strength & Conditioning Coach Mike Reiskind, and Performance Analyst Samantha Unger.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won six Carolina League championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014. The franchise won its first league title as the Fredericksburg Nationals in 2024, defeating the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers two games to one to win the title at Virginia Credit Union Stadium.

**ALEXANDER THE GREAT:** Meckley, the Nationals' 12th round pick (350th overall) in the 2024 MLB Draft, was flawless after being called up to Fredericksburg last year. He made five appearances for the FredNats between the regular season and postseason and did not give up a run. In total, he allowed just four hits in 9.1 IP and got a save in his lone opportunity with two shutout innings against LYN on 9/4.

**START IT UP:** Meckley's five appearances for the FredNats last year during his first year at the professional level were all out of the bullpen, making this his first year as a starter in his professional career.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Meckley's run of dominance slowed down in Salisbury in his last start against the Shorebirds. The righty gave up six earned runs in 3.2 IP, including a first-inning grand slam. In total, he gave up his first two home runs since April 24.

**JUNE SWOON:** Meckley's month of June was fabulous. Across four starts, he allowed just five earned runs in 21.1 IP, for an ERA of 2.11.

**BACK IN SCHOOL:** Meckley made 21 appearances at Coastal Carolina in 2024 with nine starts for the Chanticleers, posting a 7.52 ERA in 52.2 IP with 57 K's. He previously pitched two seasons at WVU Potomac State (NJCAA)...made 20 appearances (17 starts) and led the Catamounts with 73 K's and a 2.96 ERA in 2023.

## **BILLY MCMILLON - MANAGER**

1st Season | Previously: Development Coach, Triple-A Rochester

McMillon, 53, joined Washington in 2022 and has spent the last three seasons as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. McMillon played parts of six Major League seasons with four different organizations, including the Oakland Athletics (2001-04), Detroit Tigers (2000-01), Philadelphia Phillies (1997), and Florida Marlins (1996-97). The former Clemson Tiger was a three-time International League All-Star and the 1996 IL Rookie of the Year with Charlotte, earning him induction into the IL Hall of Fame in 2019 and Charlotte's Round Table of Honor in 2022. McMillon was initially selected in the eighth round of the 1993 MLB Draft by Florida. He replaces Jake Lowery, who managed the FredNats the last three seasons, culminating in a championship last year. Lowery will manage High-A Wilmington in 2025.

Prior to joining Washington, McMillon coached in the Boston Red Sox organization for over a decade. He managed the Worcester Red Sox (Triple-A) in their inaugural season in 2021 after managing Boston's former Triple-A affiliate Pawtucket in 2019. He was set to lead the PawSox again in 2020 before the cancellation of the MiLB season. Prior to managing at the Triple-A level, McMillon was the Minor League Outfield and Baserunning Coordinator for Boston from 2016-18 after managing for six seasons in the organization with Double-A Portland (2014-15), High-A Salem (2012-13), and Single-A Greenville (2010-11). His coaching career began in 2008 when he was Greenville's Hitting Coach.



### JUSTIN LORD - PITCHING COACH

3rd Season | Previously: Pitching Coach, Double-A Harrisburg

Lord, 45, returns to Fredericksburg for a third season in 2025 after leading the FredNats' championship pitching staff last season, including the 2024 Carolina League Pitcher of the Year Travis Sykora.

This is Lord's fifth total season coaching in the Washington organization after a six-year professional playing career and several seasons coaching in the Baltimore system. The Alabama native and Florida State alum was scheduled to be the Fredericksburg Pitching Coach in the canceled 2020 season, and was the Pitching Coach for one season in Double-A Harrisburg prior to joining the FredNats in 2023.



### MIKE HABAS - HITTING COACH

2nd Season | Previously: Hitting Coach, ACL Brewers

Habas, 34, returns to Fredericksburg from the 2024 championship staff for his second season with Washington after leading the FredNat offense to a highly successful season, finishing in the top third of the league in virtually every meaningful offensive category.

Prior to joining the Nationals, he spent spending the previous four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization, most recently as the Hitting Coach for the ACL Brewers in 2022 and 2023. Prior to joining Milwaukee, he was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats. While coaching with Gary, he was also the Head Coach at Prairie State College, a Junior College in the Chicago area.



### LUIS ORDAZ - DEVELOPMENT COACH

1st Season | Previously: Manager, FCL Nationals

Ordaz, 49, joins the FredNat coaching staff in the Development Coach role after managing the Florida Complex League Nationals in 2024.

He played parts of seven seasons in the Major Leagues, appearing in 206 career games with the St. Louis Cardinals, Kansas City Royals and Tampa Bay Devil Rays. Ordaz has coached in the Washington organization for over a decade, and was the Hitting Coach for the Potomac Nationals for four seasons from 2016-19. He replaces Carmelo Jaime, who will manage the FCL Nationals in 2025 after three seasons in Fredericksburg.
