TODAY'S GAMES: With the series level at 1-1, the Space Cowboys continue their six-game tilt with the Oklahoma Clty Dodgers... Sugar Land has just 10 home games remaining in the 2023 season including Thursday.

ABOUT TUESDAY NIGHT: Corey Julks hit a three-run homer in the third to give the Space Cowboys an early 3-0 lead... OKC scored two in the fourth and one in the sixth to tie it, but a Shay Whitcomb solo homer in the bottom of the sixth once again gave Sugar Land a lead... The Dodgers struck for three in the top of the eighth, however three straight walks, a Whitcomb single and a Rylan Bannon sac fly knotted the game at 6-6... Steven Duggar hit a two-run homer in the ninth to give OKC an 8-6 victory over the Space Cowboys.

ROSTER MOVES: 9/5 - RHP Matt Ruppenthal reinstated from the Dev. List... RHP Brandon Bielak placed on the Temporary Inactive List... INF Rylan Bannon clears waivers, outrighted to Sugar Land... LHP Parker Mushinski recalled by Houston... 9/3 - LHP Bennett Sousa claimed off waivers and optioned to Sugar Land... INF Rylan Bannon designated for assignment... 9/1 - RHP Joel Kuhnel recalled by Houston... RHP Jake Cousins clears waivers, outrighted to Sugar Land... 8/31 - OF Justin Dirden placed on the IL, retro to 8/30...

HOME GROWN TALENT: Sugar Land's active roster has 10 players drafted by the Astros, 1 player signed as non-drafted free agents in 2020 and 7 international signings

PROSPECTING: With the re-ranking of MLB Pipeline's Prospects, Sugar Land now has seven of the Astros' Top 30 prospects on their roster, including RHP Spencer Arrighetti (#3), OF Joey Loperfido (#6), LHP Colton Gordon (#7), RHP Rhett Kouba (#9), OF Pedro Leon (#13), INF Shay Whitcomb (#25) & RHP Misael Tamarez (#30).

SERIES-OUSLY SPEAKING: Sugar Land is 5-13-2 in sixgame series this year, 0-1 in seven-game series and 1-1 in three-game series... The Space Cowboys have gone 3-7-1 overall at Constellation Field in 2023.

WHIT-BOMB: With his solo shot in the sixth inning on Wednesday night, Shay Whitcomb is now tied with Luke Baker for the second most home runs in Minor League Baseball, launching 33 total homers between Corpus Christi (12) and Sugar Land (21).... Whitcomb trails only Hunter Goodwin (34) in home runs on the Minor League leaderboard, and Goodwin is now with the Coloardo Rockies in the National League.

The Space Cowboys infielder is also leading the way in the Astros' organization in home runs (33), RBI (93), Total Bases (238) & Hits (121), T-1st in Extra-Base Hits (51) & 4th in Runs Scored (73).... Additionally, Whitcomb's 93 total RBI this season are 10th in Minor League Baseball

Over his last four games, Whitcomb is 7-for-18 (.389) with a double, 3 home runs, 5 RBI and 3 runs scored ... The infielder has homered in three of his last four games and has put together multi-hit efforts in three of the last four games as well.

MACHO-MACHO-MACHADO: Dixon Machado extended his on-base streak to 12 games on Tuesday night, going 2-for-3 with a runs scored and a walk... During Machado's 12-game on-base streak, he's slashing .361/.500/.611/1.111 (13-for-36) with 3 home runs, 12 RBI, 7 runs scored and 11 walks... The infielder has hit safely in eight of his last 10 games including five multihit efforts... The San Cristobal, VZ native has registered multi-RBI games in four of his last six starts, plating 11 total batters in that span, and has also homered in three of his last six games.

LOWDOWN ON LOPERFIDO: OF Joey Loperfido was promoted to Sugar Land on 8/15 and made his Triple-A debut that night, going 1-for-4 with a single and a run scored... At the time of his promotion, Loperfido was tied for the Texas League lead in OPS (.940), 2nd in SIg % (.548), T-5th in Home Runs (19), 6th in Avg (.296) & OBP (.392), 8th in extra-base hits (40) & total bases (172).

Loperfido has reached safely in 10 of his last 12 games with 3 doubles, a home run, 3 RBI, 8 walks and a pair of hit by pitches.... The 24-year-old is T-1st in the Astros' organization in Doubles (26) & Extra-Base Hits (51), 2nd in SLG (.523), Total Bases (21) & Hits (116), T-2nd in Home Runs (22), 3rd in Avg (.284), Walks (62) & OPS (.905), 4th in RBI (68) & OBP (.382), 5th in Runs Scored (71) & Stolen Bases (25)

RECORD KEEPING: On Wednesday night, RHP Joe Record had his eight outing scoreless streak snapped in his appearance versus the Dodgers... His eight straight scoreless outings streak was the second longest streak for a Space Cowboys reliever this season behind Record's own 13 straight scoreless outings that he made from May 10 through June 11 earlier this season.

Since returning from the IL on 8/1, Record has made 14 appearances, including 11 scoreless outings.. The righty is now T-2nd most appearances in the PCL, pitching in 45 games despite missing nearly the entire month of July.

PALMS SWEATY, SPENCER ARRIGHETTI: In 4 home starts in August, RHP Spencer Arrighetti surrendered just two earned run across 21.0 innings... In 7 overall starts at Constellation Field, the righty is 1-1 with a 2.10 ERA, allowing 8 earned runs in 34.1 innings while striking out 30.

SEEING 20-20: Both Pedro Leon (22 2B, 21 HR) and Joey Loperfido (26 2B, 22 HR) have posted seasons in which they have at least 20 doubles and 20 home runs while stealing at least 15 bases (Leon -16; Loperfido -25)... They are two of just 17 players in Minor League Baseball with at least 20 doubles, 20 homers and 15 stolen bases, and Loperfido is one of just 11 players in Minor League Baseball to have at least 20 doubles, 20 homers and 20 stolen bases.

RIDE THE BIKEN: On 6/24, Pedro León hit for the cycle in reverse order, homering in the 3rd, tripling in the 5th, doubling in the 7th and singling in the 8th... It is the first cycle in Space Cowboys history and the first for León at any level in his career... The La Habana native also reached on a walk and a hit by pitch and scored all six times he reached, setting a new single-game record for runs scored in Space Cowboys history.

WHAT A WEEK: The Space Cowboys had the most prolific week for any team in MiLB this season during their trip to Albuquerque from 5/2-5/7, hitting .395 with 100 hits and 76 runs scored. RECORD SETTING DAY IN ABQ: On 5/7 @ ABQ, the Space Cowboys topped several franchise records in a 24-8 win over the Albuquerque Isotopes. They included:

- Most Hits in a Game: 30
- Most Extra-Base Hits: 14
- Total Bases: 60
- Most Individual Hits in a game: Korey Lee 6

Sugar Land also tied the franchise record for runs scored in a game (24) and individual at bats, with three different players recording 7 trips to the plate.... This came just three days after Sugar Land had set new single-game records for doubles in a game (9), extra-base hits (13) & at bats (50) in a game on Thursday, 5/4.

GRAND DAY FOR DIRDEN: Outfielder Justin Dirden had a career day on 5/4 against ABQ, going 4-for-5 with 3 doubles, a grand slam, 6 RBI and 2 runs scored... The six RBI are a new career high for Dirden... The former SEMO Redhawk also tied two single-game Space Cowboys franchise records with three doubles and four extra-base hits. Dirden then hit a go-ahead grand slam on Friday night in a 9-8 Space Cowboys win.

SEVENTH HEAVEN: In the seventh inning on 5/5 @ ABQ, the Space Cowboys rallied for seven runs, charging back from an 8-2 deficit for a 9-8 win. Justin Dirden delivered the go-ahead hit with a grand slam, his second consecutive day with a grand slam. It's the first time the Space Cowboys have hit grand slams on back-to-back days. The closest grand slams were the first and second slams hit in Sugar Land's affiliated history on 5/13 & 5/17 (G2) @ RR in 2021, both hit by Jose Siri.

MATIJEVIC'S CAREER NIGHT: On 5/2 @ Albuquerque, INF JJ Matijevic re-wrote the Sugar Land Space Cowboys record books, going 5-for-6 with a double, 2 triples, 8 RBI and 2 runs scored. Since the Sugar Land franchise joined the affiliated ranks, Matijevic is the first player to record five hits in a game, surpassing the 17 times a player had registered four hits in a game, most recently done by... Matijevic on 4/5/23 vs. RR. His 8 RBI also establish a new single-game franchise record for Sugar Land, overtaking the 7 RBI recorded by Lewis Brinson on 8/3/22 @ LV. Matijevic also recorded two triples, the first player to record two three-baggers in single game. In the series finale on 5/7, Korey Lee surpassed Matijevic with six hits in a game.

UNA NUEVA Y DULCE IDENTIDAD: As part of MiLB's 'Copa de la Diversión,' the Space Cowboys will rebrand on multiple occasions in 2023 as "Los Dulces de Sugar Land.' The name is to honor the Latino community's contribution to the foundation and growth of the City of Sugar Land, which are as real as the sugar that gives our hometown its name. The primary logo of 'Los Dulces de Sugar Land,' is vibrant and features a watermelon candy capped in a flame of chamoy and chili powder.

NOW HERE'S A STOREY: Mickey Storey returns for his fourth season as the manager of the Astros' Triple-A affiliate and his third with Sugar Land. Storey joined the Astros organization as a coach in 2016 and has managed with Single-A Quad Cities (2018) and Triple-A Round Rock (2019), along with two seasons in Sugar Land. Storey appeared in nine seasons at the professional level as a right-handed pitcher, including stints at the Major League level with the Astros (2012) and Blue Jay (2013). He appeared in four collegiate seasons at Florida Atlantic and was selected by the Oakland Athletics in the 31st round of the 2008 MLB Draft.

A LITTLE ABOUT US: Through its first nine seasons, Sugar Land played in the independent Atlantic League of Professional Baseball. They won the Atlantic League Championship in '16 and '18 and appeared in the postseason in five of nine seasons. Sugar Land still holds Atlantic League single-season records for wins (95) and winning percentage (.679) from its '13 season. Sugar Land was managed by former Major Leaguers Gary Gaetti (2012-17) and Pete Incaviglia (2018-20). As an independent team, Sugar Land went 601-502. Notable people to appear for Sugar Land include: LHP Scott Kazmir, RHP Roger Clemens, IF Rafael Palmeiro, Tracy McGrady, IF James Loney, C Derek Norris, OF Willy Taveras and RHP Felipe Paulino.

REST OF THE CREW: Joining manager Mickey Storey on the Space Cowboys coaching staff are pitching coach Erick Abreu, hitting coach Aaron Westlake and development coach Wladimir Sutil. Abreu returns for his third season in Sugar Land as the pitching coach for the Astros' Triple-A affiliate. He's previously worked as the pitching coach for Astros affiliates at the Single A, Short-Season, Appalachian League, Gulf Coast League and Dominican Summer League levels, joining the organization as a coach in 2014. Westlake spent 2022 as the hitting coach in Double-A Corpus Christi and worked as a development coach for the Florida Gulf Coast League Astros in 2021. Sutil enters his second season on the Space Cowboys staff after serving as the manager for the Astros' Florida Complex League team in 2021. He's worked as a manager for Astros affiliates at the Short-Season and Gulf Coast League levels, joining the organization as a coach in 2014.
