## INDY BITS

**ABOUT TUESDAY NIGHT** Matt Fraizer recorded a career-high five RBI and hit one of three home runs for the Indianapolis Indians en route to an 8-2 victory over the Louisville Bats on Tuesday night at Louisville Slugger Field. Seth Beer and Conner Capel traded home runs in the second and third innings, respectively, to plate the first runs of the contest. Fraizer launched a tiebreaking three-run home run in the fourth inning off Christian Roa to give Indianapolis a lead it did not surrender. Louisville took one run back in the bottom of the sixth inning, but the threat stopped there. Indy tacked on four additional runs in the eighth inning, with a solo homer by Liover Peguero, two-run double by Fraizer and RBI single by Grant Koch single capping the game's scoring.

**SERIES DUBBING:** With their win on Tuesday night at Louisville and last night's postponement, the Indians swept the rain-shortened two-game series at Louisville Slugger Field. It is their first road series win of the season and the first time they have won back-to-back road games since winning three consecutive from June 13-15 at Jacksonville.

**QUINNING:** Quinn Priester earned his third win of the season with Indianapolis on Tuesday night, tossing 5.0 three-hit, one-run innings with six strikeouts at Louisville Slugger Field. The outing was his second of a rehab assignment with Indianapolis, and in that time he has a 3.00 ERA in 9.0 innings. In seven total starts with Indianapolis this season, he is 3-1 with a 3.21 ERA (12er/33.2ip) and 36 strikeouts.

**FRAIZER FOR FIVE:** Matt Fraizer went 2-for-3 with a career-high tying five RBI on Tuesday night. His performance began with a three-run, tiebreaking homer in the fourth inning. He then drove in two more with a two-bagger in the eighth inning, giving him his third career five-RBI performance and his first since June 1, 2023, with Double-A Altoona vs. Binghamton. It was the second by an Indians batter this season, following Liover Peguero on April 5 vs. Memphis. His double and home run gave him his third game with two extra-base hits this season, following May 22 at Iowa and June 18 vs. Iowa.

**THE BEER KEEPS FLOWING:** Seth Beer continued his hot streak on Tuesday, launching a solo home run in the second inning to put the Indians on the board. The long ball extended his hitting streak to six games since June 27 (2) at Rochester. He has now hit safely in seven of his last eight games with a .310 batting average (8-for-29) with six runs, four extra-base hits and nine RBI.

**PEGUERO POPS:** Liover Peguero launched his second home run of the nine-game road trip on Tuesday, tacking on an insurance run for the Indians in the eighth inning. He went 2-for-5 in the contest for his fourth two-hit performance in his past five games since June 27 (2) at Rochester. He has hit safely in five of his last six games with a .375 batting average (9-for-24) with seven runs, three extra-base hits, and six RBI.

**BAE'S BACK:** Ji Hwan Bae logged his fifth multi-hit performance in his last nine games since June 22 last night, leading the Indians by going 3-for-5. Twelve of his 14 hits in that stretch have been singles, with his two doubles on Saturday and Tuesday driving in three total runs. Bae continues to own International League pitching not only this year, but in his career. In 37 games with the Indians this season, he is hitting .355 (50-for-141) with 22 runs, six doubles, one triple, four home runs and 18 RBI. In 151 games of his Triple-A career, he is hitting .307 (182-for-592) with 32 doubles, seven triples and 13 home runs.

**TONIGHT:** After taking the first two games of the rain-shortened five-game home-and-home series against Louisville, the Indians return to Victory Field tonight for their annual July Fourth Celebration. Kicking off the home stretch tonight is RHP Jake Woodford (1-4, 4.43), looking to extend a dominant stretch in the IL with the Indians (see below). It will be his second career start vs. the Bats after tossing 5.0 one-run innings on July 7, 2021, with Triple-A Memphis at Slugger Field. Countering for Louisville will be RHP Lyon Richardson (1-5, 4.42), who has allowed three earned runs in 9.2 innings vs. Indy this season.

**CHOPPIN' WOOD(FORD):** Jake Woodford continued his dominant stretch with the Indians, tossing 5.1 one-run innings with no walks and a season-high tying eight strikeouts in Game 2 of a doubleheader last Thursday at Rochester. He has struck out six-plus batters in each of his three starts with Indianapolis, going 0-1 with a 2.08 ERA (4er/17.1ip), no walks, 21 strikeouts, a 0.81 WHIP and .215 batting average against. He has thrown at least 5.0 innings in each of his last nine outings dating back to April 24 with Triple-A Charlotte at Lehigh Valley.

**FOURTH OF JULY:** Tonight marks the 26th consecutive season that the Indians have played at Victory Field on the Fourth of July. In that time, they are 13-12 with a two-game winning streak dating back to Kevin Newman's walk-off single in the 10th inning on July 4, 2023. Louisville is Indy's most common opponent on the holiday, with the two meeting 15 times since 1997. In those games, the Indians are narrowly edging the Bats, 8-7.

**HENRY'S BACK:** The Pittsburgh Pirates today announced that catcher Henry Davis will have his rehab assignment transferred from Double-A Altoona to the Indianapolis Indians ahead of tonight's July Fourth Celebration. The 24-year-old was placed on the 7-day injured list on June 15 with a concussion. He began his rehab assignment with Altoona on June 26 and went 0-for-6 with a run and two walks in a pair of games. He served as the Pirates' Opening Day catcher and hit .153 (13-for-85) with five extra-base hits in 29 total big-league games across two stints. After being optioned to Indianapolis on May 3, he hit .296 (24-for-81) with seven doubles, seven home runs and 17 RBI in 23 Triple-A games.

**THIS DATE IN 2004:** The Indians hosted their largest holiday crowd in Victory Field history when 16,062 fans packed the stadium to witness a come-from-behind, walk-off victory over the Louisville Bats on the Fourth of July. With two outs in the bottom of the ninth inning, Peter Bergeron singled home the game-winning run to send the city into a Fourth of July fireworks show for the ages. It was the team's second Fourth of July walk-off in Victory Field history.
