TODAY'S GAME

Round Rock kicks off a six-game series against the Reno Aces with game one on Tuesday afternoon at Greater Nevada Field. Express LHP Kolby Allard looks to make his Round Rock debut against Aces RHP Dan Straily. The afternoon's first pitch is slated for 1:05 p.m. CT.

LAST TIME OUT

Round Rock claimed a series split against Salt Lake with a 9-4 victory during Sunday's eight-inning rain-shortened contest. Despite the Bees jumping out to a two-run lead in the third inning, the Express outscored Salt Lake 9-2 over the next four frames. DH Yohel Pozo trimmed the lead to 2-1 in the fourth inning after hitting a double then scoring on a Nick Tanielu double. The fifth saw Round Rock take over for a 4-2 lead when a double from C Meibrys Viloria went down the right field line and sent 2B Ryan Dorow, SS Josh Smith and LF Bubba Thompson all across home plate. The RBI doubles kept on coming as RF Elier Hernandez found two bases and scored Tanielu to start the sixth inning. CF Leody Taveras sent Hernandez in later in the frame, extending the Express advantage to 6-2. The Bees posted another two-run inning in the bottom of the sixth as 1B David MacKinnon scored on a Kean Wong sacrifice fly and C Chad Wallach scored thanks to a single from LF Orlando Martinez. Round Rock put the game away in the seventh when Hernandez knocked a three-run home run. After a 35-minute rain delay, the 9-4 game was made final.

NEW FACE ON THE BUMP

Express LHP Kolby Allard is scheduled to make his first start for Round Rock after beginning the season with Texas. Through four appearances, the lefty went 0-1 with a 6.43 ERA (5 ER/7.0 IP) for the Rangers.

THE MORE THE MERRIER

Round Rock tallied six total doubles on Sunday in Salt Lake, marking the most in a single contest so far this season. DH Yohel Pozo record three of the six while C Meibrys Viloria, 1B Nick Tanielu and RF Elier Hernandez all knocked one. The doubles amassed more than half of the Express hits as Round Rock totaled 11 en route to out-hitting their opponent for the 16th time during 2022.

RECENT TRANSACTIONS

The Texas Rangers announced four roster moves for Round Rock since Sunday's contest in Salt Lake. In addition to Tuesday starter LHP Kolby Allard, RHP Josh Sborz completed his Major League rehab assignment and was optioned to Round Rock. Position players OF Willie Calhoun and C Sam Huff were also optioned and now appear on the team's active roster.

ABOUT THE NEWBIES

Prior to his rehab assignment, Sborz tossed four relief outings and amassed a 11.25 ERA (5 ER/4.0 IP) with Texas. OF Willie Calhoun was hitting .136 (6-44) through 18 games with the Rangers. C Sam Huff was recalled on April 28 and went 1-for-3 with one RBI during his one game in the Show.

FAMILIAR FACES

Round Rock will face former Express INF Yonny Hernandez while playing in Reno this series. Hernandez was part of the E-Train's Opening Day roster and played at Dell Diamond on April 5 against El Paso before being traded to the Arizona Diamondbacks organization. The infielder didn't record a hit during his one game this season with Round Rock, but has since hit .306 (11-36) with one double and five RBI with Reno through 10 games.

AGAINST THE ACES

Reno holds a slim 26-23 overall series lead over Round Rock, including a 12-10 lead when playing at Greater Nevada Field. The 2021 season saw the Express drop the six-game set 4-2 in Reno as the two teams only faced off for one series. Round Rock has amassed a 15-9 record so far this season, while Reno sits right at the .500 mark at 12-12.

RHP Daniel Robert, INF Josh Smith and OF Bubba Thompson all made their Triple-A debuts on Opening Day - April 5, 2022 while RHP Hever Bueno made his on April 6.

STATING THE FACTS

American-born players hail from 12 different states, including Alabama, Arizona, California, Colorado, Florida, Illinois, Louisiana, Michigan, New York, North Carolina, Pennsylvania and Texas. The team's lone Texan, RHP Justin Anderson hailed from Houston before a collegiate career at the University of Texas at San Antonio.

EXPRESS MANAGER MATT HAGEN

The 2022 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Matt Hagen's Triple-A coaching debut. A resident of Austin, Hagen spent the last two seasons as the Texas Rangers' Minor League Field Coordinator. He is entering his seventh season in the Rangers organization after previously managing the Low-A Hickory Crawdads in 2018 and 2019 as well as the Short-Season Spokane Indians in 2017. In his three seasons as a manager, Hagen has compiled a .550 winning percentage, combining to post a 192-157 overall record, including capturing the South Atlantic League Championship with Hickory in 2019. He originally joined the Texas organization in 2016 as a coach for the Crawdads.



Prior to joining the Rangers, Hagen spent three years as the head coach at Four Points Baseball in Austin. Upon the conclusion of his playing career in 2012, Hagen returned to his alma mater, Liberty University, as an assistant coach. He also had a stint on the Liberty staff in 2007 and spent three off-seasons as a strength coach for the Flames' baseball, men's soccer and football programs.

An infielder in his playing days, Hagen was selected by the Seattle Mariners in the 12th round of the 2002 MLB Draft and spent time in both the Seattle and San Diego Padres organizations, reaching Double-A Mobile in 2006. Hagen continued his playing career in the independent Frontier and Atlantic Leagues from 2007-2012, earning Atlantic League All-Star honors three times. Hagen was a first team All-Big South selection at Liberty University, leading the conference in home runs and RBI as a junior, and was a member of Liberty's 2000 Big South Championship team that advanced to the NCAA Tournament. Hagen graduated from Liberty in 2012 with a degree in Sport Management.
