Series Record (W-L-): 2-6-2 Sweep (BIN-OPP): 0-1 **WEDNESDAY:** The Ponies used strong starting pitching from RHP Adam Oller and a late comeback to defeat the Curve 4-3 in Altoona Thursday night. The Curve got out to an early 1-0 lead on a solo HR from Jonah Davis in the 1st. The Ponies would tie the game on a Manny Rodriguez RBI double in the top of the 3rd before a Curve 2-run HR later in the inning put the Ponies deficit at 3-1. In the 8th the Ponies would tie the game on a 2-run double from Nick Conti and take a 4-3 lead on a Jake Mangum sacrifice fly.

OLLER'S STRONG START: Last night's Ponies starting pitcher RHP Adam Oller had his longest start of the season going 7 innings while allowing 3 runs and striking out 6. Oller's 7 innings of work are tied with Josh Walker's June 9th outing against the Baysox for the longest start by a Ponies pitcher this season.

CLUTCH CONTI: Nick Conti picked up his first double and RBI in a Ponies uniform at an optimal time driving in 2 runs in the 8th inning to tie the game. Conti's game tying double would help propel the Ponies to their 4th win of the season when trailing after 7 innings.

CARPIO HEATING UP: Rumble Ponies INF Luis Carpio went 2-4 with a run scored last night. Carpio has a hit in 7 straight games and has 2 of his 3 HR's on the season during this stretch.

KING OF THE HILL: Tonight's Rumble Ponies starting pitcher, Josh Walker, has been consistent on the mound this season. Walker has given up 3 earned runs or less in 6 of his 7 starts with the Ponies while going at least 6 innings in 4 of those starts. In his last outing in Pennsylvania, Walker went 6 innings in a combined no-hitter with LHP Andrew Mitchell on June 22nd in Reading.

CURVE STARTER GETS REMATCH: Tonight's Curve starting pitcher RHP Osvaldo Bido made his first career AA road start in Binghamton back on May 15th. Bido pitched 5 scoreless innings allowing only 2 hits and striking out 3 Ponies hitters. Bido picked up a no decision in the start as the Ponies fell 6-5 in extra innings.

STRONG STARTING PITCHING: So far this series the Altoona Curve starting pitching trio of RHP Cam Vieaux, RHP Travis MacGregor, and RHP Trey McGough has limited the Ponies to only 4 runs over 16 innings. The Ponies have scored 6 runs over 11 innings against the Curve bullpen.

COMING UP: Tonight is the second game of a six-game series in Altoona. The Ponies will return home July 20th to open up a series with the Erie Seawolves.
