- SUNDAY FUNDAYS:** Through the first two and a half weeks of the season, Salem is 2-0 during Sunday games. The RidgeYaks have scored 20 runs in two Sunday games good for third most in the Carolina League and fifth best in all of Single-A on Sunday's. The .333 batting average on Sunday is also second best in the Carolina League and fourth in Single-A. On the pitching side, the Salem staff has allowed just five runs in the two Sunday games. If you include the final month of the 2025 season, Salem has won 7 of their last 9 series finales. All but one (Opening Weekend vs. Delmarva on Saturday) have come on Sunday's.
- OPATA HEATING UP:** After going 0-for-7 to start his professional career on opening weekend, outfielder **Andrews Opata** is starting to figure it out at the plate. Opata recorded a pair of triples for his first and second career hits against Wilson before following that up with an encore the following night when he went 2-for-3 with a pair of stolen bases. Since April 6, Opata is hitting .386 (17-for-44) clip with eight RBI, a home run, and eight stolen bases over his last 12 games.
- FERMIN FINDING WAYS:** Outfielder **Anderson Fermin** arrived in Salem last August, and after a rocky start to his Single-A career last season, reaching base via just one hit in 25 at-bats. The Dominican Republic native is finding unconventional ways to reach in 2026. Fermin has reached base in 13 of the 14 games he has hit in this year. Despite hitting .163 at the plate, Fermin holds a .400 on-base percentage and has reached via a team best 14 walks.
- RIDGEYAK SPEEDSTERS:** Through the first 20 games of the season, Salem has swiped 44 bases and been thrown out just eight times (84.6 SB%). For context, after 20 games last season, Salem had just 14 stolen bases. Salem's stolen base total is sixth in Single-A and fifth in the Carolina League, trailing Fayetteville, Fredericksburg, Hill City, Lake Elsinore, and Augusta.
- RUNS PARTY:** After the first 20 games of the 2026 season, Salem has struck for 128 runs scored at the dish. Behind five double-digit scoring performances already this season, the RidgeYaks are second in the Carolina League in total runs scored and rank sixth in Single-A.
- NEED TO HOLD LEADS:** In three of Salem's ten losses this season, the RidgeYaks held a lead of four or more runs. Salem fell to Delmarva on April 3 after holding a four-run lead heading into the seventh inning. And just last week the Yaks led by five in both Friday and Saturday's ballgames but dropped both to the Crawdads.
- BATTLE OF THIRDS:** In the first six innings this season, Salem has outscored opponents by 31 runs, holding a 104-73 advantage. However, in the final three innings (7-9), the Yaks have been outscored by 28 runs, with opponents holding a 52-23 edge. Overall, 64% of Salem's total run production has come in the first five innings of games.
- PLAYING IT CLOSE:** Last season Salem and Fredericksburg met 23 times, of those meetings 18 were decided by three runs or less and all but one were decided by four runs or less.
- HISTORY VS FRED NATS:** Tuesday's 12 runs against Fredericksburg, marked the most runs and the largest margin of victory Salem has seen against Fredericksburg since a 14-2 win at home September 4, 2021.
- STRUGGLES VS LEFT-HANDED BATS:** Salem pitchers have allowed 17 home runs this season on the bump. Five of which to right-handed batters and 12 to the left-handed bats. Against lefties this season, Salem is pitching to a .232 BAA and the 12 home runs against are tied with Fayetteville for most allowed to lefties in Single-A. Meanwhile vs right-handed bats Salem has allowed the five home runs which is tied for third least in all of Single-A.
- CAN'T TOUCH THIS:** This season, Salem has only struck out 175 at the dish which is the lowest in the Carolina League and third lowest in all of Single-A. (Rancho Cucamonga, Lake Elsinore).

# YAK FACTS



## BY THE NUMBERS

- WELCOME TO THE SHOW:** On Saturday it was announced that Chad Tracy would take over as the interim manager of the Boston Red Sox. Joining Tracy's staff is **Chad Epperson**, the current manager of the Portland Sea Dogs and former 2009 manager of the Salem Red Sox. Epperson went 67-72 under the brand new interim third base coach of the Boston Red Sox.
- NUNEZ IN CENTER:** Infielder **Starlyn Nunez** has been penciled in to play center field six times this season. The Dominican Republic native has appeared in 211 career minor league games across four seasons, however prior to this season, had never played the outfield before. Nunez has seen time at shortstop (80 games), third base (73 games), second base (39 games), and DH (10 games).
- BOSTON TO ST. LOUIS:** This offseason former chief baseball officer of the Boston Red Sox **Chaim Bloom** moved from Boston to the St. Louis Cardinals organization. The new president of baseball operations for the Cards has already traded to acquire 2025 Salem pitchers **Blake Aita** and **Yhoiker Fajardo**. And as of last weekend, Bloom made another move acquiring right hander **Patrick Galle** in the Sonny Gray trade.
- SALEM WINS OPENING WEEKEND:** The Salem RidgeYaks won their inaugural series against the Delmarva Shorebirds two games to one. This marked the second year in a row that Salem won the opening weekend series (Swept Delmarva last season). This made history marking the first time in the modern stats era (Since 2005), Salem has won the Opening Series in consecutive seasons.
- RIDGEYAKS IN FORT MYERS:** 11 members of the RidgeYaks Opening Day roster saw time in Fort Myers participating in Spring Training with the Boston Red Sox. OF **Eddy Azocar** (5 GP), OF **Anderson Fermin** (4 GP), OF **Skylar King** (4 GP), OF **Andrew Opata** (4 GP), IF **D'Angelo Ortiz** (2 G), IF **Avinson Pinto** (2 GP), OF **Stanley Tucker** (2 GP), IF **Ilan Fernandez** (1 GP), IF **Starlyn Nunez** (1 GP), IF **Frederik Jimenez** (1 GP), and RHP **Griffin Kilander** (1 GP).
- RIDGEYAKS IN ARIZONA:** Both OF **Stanley Tucker** and RHP **Brandon Neely** had the chance to represent the Red Sox in the Arizona Fall League with the Salt River Rafters. Tucker finished second on the AFL club with 15 RBIs and led the team with 13 stolen bases; one of only two players in the league to reach both marks. As a result was named a 2025 Arizona Fall League Rising Star. Neely meanwhile made five appearances (one start), posting a 10.80 ERA while recording 11 strikeouts in AFL play.

## WHAT IS A RIDGEYAK

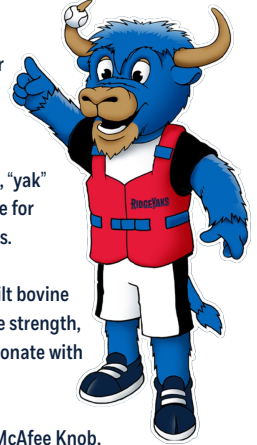
The name "RidgeYaks" is a creative and symbolic reflection of the Southwest Virginia community and carries a double meaning:

**Ridge:** A tribute to the scenic Blue Ridge Mountains that tower beyond the outfield wall at Salem Memorial Ballpark, a nod to the beautiful, rugged landscape that defines the region.

**Yak:** The name carries two layers of local-flavor meaning. First, "yak" plays off the slang for kayak, a subtle salute to the region's love for kayaking and other outdoor recreation on the area's waterways.

A Yak is also a real animal. The Yak is a long-haired, heavily built bovine native to high-altitude mountains. The Yak comes to symbolize strength, resilience, stability, and a hardworking spirit, qualities that resonate with both the team and the broader Salem community.

The new mascot, named **Mac the Yak**, takes inspiration from McAfee Knob, one of the region's most iconic natural landmarks, linking the team's identity not only to athletic grit, but to local heritage, outdoor adventure, and mountain pride.

- Received the highest bonus of any pitcher in the Red Sox 2024 International Free Agent class at \$450,000
- Makes his first career Single-A baseball start here today
- Last start came on July 17, 2025 at home against the FCL-Braves, threw one inning in the losing decision to the FCL-Braves
- Threw longer than two innings in only two starts last season, June 12 at the FCL-Braves (3.1 IP), and May 29 vs FCL-Rays (2.1)
- Only went above 40 pitches on three occasions (two of which were starts, one from bullpen) last season with the Florida Complex Club
