Last Time Out: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies fell to the Somerset Patriots 7-4 in the series opener at TD Bank Ballpark on Tuesday night. Luke Ritter and Rowdey Jordan both hit home runs in the second inning to tie the game 3-3. It was tied 4-4 in the middle of the sixth, but Somerset added three runs across the sixth and seventh innings to win the game.

Rudick Rules: Outfielder **Matt Rudick** walked three times in the series opener on Tuesday. Rudick is hitting .315 and leads the team in hits with 17. Rudick ranks first in the Eastern League in OBP (.486), second in OPS (1.005), and is tied for third in walks (17).

Let's Get Rowdey: Outfielder **Rowdey Jordan** has four hits in his last three games, including a two-run triple, two-run double, and solo home run. He has five runs batted in and three runs scored in that span. He now has five extra base hits this season.

Jose, Jose, Jose, Jose: Infielder **Jose Peroza** has a combined six hits and six runs batted in over his last five games. He delivered a game-tying RBI double in the series opener on Tuesday. He went 5-for-16 (.313) with a .375 OBP, .625 SLG, and 1.000 OPS. Peroza totaled a three-hit, three-RBI game against Akron last week.

Somerset Patriots Roster: The current Somerset Patriots roster features six of the New York Yankees top 10 prospects by MLB Pipeline: No. 2 Jasson Domínguez, No. 3 Austin Wells, No. 5 Everson Pereira, No. 6 Trey Sweeney, No. 8 Will Warren, and No. 9 Richard Fitts. Wells was just activated off the IL on Tuesday for this series.

Brett The Met: New York Mets third baseman **Brett Baty**, who was a Double-A All-Star for Binghamton last year, was ranked No. 4 on the Rookie Power Rankings by mlb.com on May 2. Baty is slashing .333/.381/.538 with two homers, two doubles, and four RBIs in 12 games in the major leagues this season.

Last Start: Hamel started the first game of Thursday's doubleheader and allowed two runs over 4.1 innings, with seven strikeouts and two walks against Akron. Hamel exited his outing with the game tied 2-2.

World Baseball Classic: Hamel represented Team Puerto Rico in the 2023 World Baseball Classic. He honored his late mother, who passed away 11 days before the Mets selected him in the 2021 MLB Draft. He was WBC teammates with current New York Mets, Francisco Lindor and Edwin Díaz.

2022: Was named the 2022 New York Mets Minor League Pitcher of the Year. He led all Mets minor leaguers with 10 wins and 145 strikeouts. Began the season with St. Lucie (A) and pitched to a 5-2 record with a 3.84 ERA in 14 appearances and 13 starts. He tossed 63.1 innings and struck out 71 batters, before he was assigned to Brooklyn (A+) on July 4. He went 5-1 on the mound with a 2.59 ERA in 11 starts for the Cyclones. He struck out 74 hitters over 55.2 innings and opponents hit just .180 against him.

BACKGROUND: Begins the 2023 season ranked as the Mets' No. 2 pitching prospect and No. 9 overall prospect by MLB Pipeline. He was drafted out of Dallas Baptist University in the 3rd round (81st overall) by the Mets in 2021. Hamel went 13-2 on the mound and racked up 136 strikeouts in his final year at DBU in 2021. He spent his first two years at Yavapai College in Arizona.



Reid Brignac - Manager - 2nd season with Binghamton - 4th year in the Mets organization.

In 2022, Brignac led a team that saw five players make their major league debut with the Mets after starting the season with the Rumble Ponies (Francisco Álvarez, Brett Baty, Jose Butto, Nate Fisher, and Bryce Montes de Oca), tied for the second-most in franchise history. This past fall, Brignac was one of two Mets staff members selected to be a part of the Arizona Fall League coaching staff, serving as the manager of the Peoria Javelinas. Following his retirement as an active player in 2018, Brignac was the manager of the St. Lucie Mets (Low-A) in 2021 before coming to Binghamton last year. As a player, Brignac appeared in parts of nine seasons in the major leagues with the Tampa Bay Rays, Colorado Rockies, Atlanta Braves, Philadelphia Phillies, New York Yankees, and Miami Marlins. He was drafted by the Rays in the second round of the 2004 MLB Draft.

AJ Sager - Pitching Coach - 1st season with Binghamton - 2nd year in the Mets organization. Sager served in the same role for the Brooklyn Cyclones (High-A) last season. Sager previously spent twenty seasons with the Detroit Tigers organization, including six seasons as the pitching coach with Triple-A Toledo. He pitched for parts of five seasons in the major leagues, playing for the San Diego Padres, Colorado Rockies, and Detroit Tigers as part of a 12-year professional career. In 123 major league appearances, the right-hander was 12-15, with five career saves and a 5.36 ERA.

Darin Everson- Hitting Coach - 1st season with Binghamton - 1st year in the Mets organization. Everson spent the previous five seasons as the Colorado Rockies Hitting Coordinator and 10 years in the Rockies organization. During his tenure, he served as the organization's Triple-A hitting coach in 2017, Double-A hitting coach from 2013-2014 and as the club's Double-A manager from 2015-2016. He previously was part of the Marlins organization for four years and served as an Associate Scout with the Baltimore Orioles from 2003-04. Everson played professionally as a catcher and first basemen for seven seasons with the Montreal Expos, Pittsburgh Pirates, and Boston Red Sox organizations.

Mariano Duncan - Bench Coach - 2nd season with Binghamton - 5th year with Mets organization. Duncan returns to the Southern Tier to begin his second year as Bench Coach with the Rumble Ponies. He previously served as the bench coach for the Brooklyn Cyclones (High-A) in 2021. He is entering his fifth year in the Mets organization. The former infielder played 12 major league seasons with the Los Angeles Dodgers, Cincinnati Reds, Philadelphia Phillies, New York Yankees, and Toronto Blue Jays. He was a member of two World Series championship teams (1990 Cincinnati Reds, 1996 New York Yankees) and was inducted into the Dominican Republic Baseball Hall of Fame in 2008.

Jeremy Cologna - Development Coach - 1st season with Binghamton - 1st year with Mets organization. Cologna comes to the Mets organization from Missouri State University, where he spent the previous two seasons on the Bears coaching staff. He most recently served as the program's Director of Player Development. Cologna was a catcher and pitcher at Avila University from 2017-18 and began his collegiate baseball career at St. Charles Community College.

Austin Dayton - Athletic Trainer - 1st season with Binghamton - 6th year with the Mets organization.
