SHELL YEAH The Portland Sea Dogs played as the Maine Lobster Bakes last night walked it off in a 2-1 win over the Somerset Patriots last night. Allan Castro smoked a leadoff homer in the bottom of the fourth inning to right center field. The solo blast put Portland on the board first. In the top of the sixth, Somerset tied the game after scoring a run on a wild pitch with the bases loaded. Tied until the ninth inning, Nathan Hickey laced a leadoff double (5) to ignite the momentum. Elih Marreo came in to pinch run for Hickey before a single from Alex Binelas put two on. A sacrifice fly to center field from Phillip Sikes scored Marrero and sealed the deal as the Lobster Bakes walked it off, 2-1.

ANOTHER WALK-OFF Last night's walk-off in the bottom of the ninth inning was Portland's fifth of the season. The Sea Dogs have walked it off three times in extra innings at Hadlock Field and twice in nine innings. It was the first walk-off sacrifice fly of the season. The other four hits were all singles.

SEA DOGS WIN ANOTHER CLOSE ONE This season the Sea Dogs have played 53 games that have been decided by two or less runs. Portland is 16-15 in one-run decisions and 13-9 in two-run decisions including winning another one last night, 2-1. In this series, the Sea Dogs and Patriots have played two one-run games and one two-run. Portland lost 1-0 on Tuesday night.

WIKELMAN GONZALEZ CONTINUES RECENT DOMINANCE Sea Dogs starter Wikelman Gonzalez had another strong outing last night tossing 5.0 no-hit innings. Gonzalez has been dominant in the last two months for Portland. In July, he owned a 1.93 ERA in four starts allowing three runs in 14.0 innings. This month, he has a 1.38 ERA in four appearances (three starts). In August he has tossed 13.0 innings allowing two earned runs on five hits while walking four and striking out 12. Opponents are hitting just .116 against him and he has a 0.69 WHIP.

OLD FRIEND ALERT Anthony Rizzo rehabbed with the Somerset Patriots last night and drew two walks and hit a flyout. Rizzo was Portland's team MVP in 2010 after hitting .263 in 107 games with 30 doubles, 20 home runs and 80 RBI. He had a .334 OBP and .481 SLG. His last game at Hadlock Field was on September 6th, 2010 in which he hit a three-run homer. It had been 5,100 days since Rizzo had played a game at Hadlock Field.

CHECKING IN ON THE WOOSOX Since the promotions of Roman Anthony, Kyle Teel and Krisitan Campbell, the Worcester Red Sox have gone on a tear in the International League. They have won 12 of their last 14 games including their last seven. Roman Anthony is hitting .341 through 10 games with two home runs. Campbell has appeared in three games so far and is already batting .467 with two homers and a nine RBI. Kyle Teel has scored a pair of runs.

WHERE DO WE STAND The Sea Dogs remain in first place of the Northeast Division of the Eastern League, 5.5 games ahead of the second place Somerset Patriots. The Binghamton Rumble Ponies and Hartford Yard Goats are tied for third place, 8.0 games out of first place. The Reading Fightin Phils are in fourth place, 12.5 games out of first while the New Hampshire Fisher Cats remain in the basement of the division, 14.5 games behind the Sea Dogs. In the Southwest Division, the Akron RubberDucks are in first place while the Erie SeaWolves are in second place, 4.5 games back. The WooSox are now just 2.5 games behind the first place Rochester Red Wings in the second half of the season.

THIS DATE IN SEA DOGS HISTORY August 24, 2003 – Portland swept a doubleheader at New Haven by scores of 3-0 and 4-3. In the opening game, Tim Kester fired a 5-hitter and did not allow a runner past first base in becoming the 11th pitcher in franchise history to win 10 games in a season.

PITCHING PREVIEW RHP David Sandlin will be on the mound for the Sea Dogs tonight. He made his Double-A debut against the Somerset Patriots on July 28th and tossed 4.0 innings allowing one run on two hits while striking out three. He did not issue a walk. Sandlin gave up a solo home run to Tyler Hardman. He last pitched on August 18th in Binghamton and tossed 2.2 innings allowing five runs (two earned) on seven hits while walking one and striking out four.

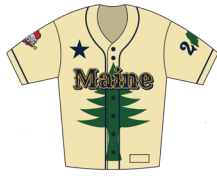

CHAD EPPERSON - MANAGER

Epperson returns for his third season as Portland's manager. In 2023, he led the Sea Dogs to an overall record of 73-63 (.537). In 2022, Epperson led the Sea Dogs to a Double-A best 45-24 (.652) record in the second half, securing Portland's first post-season berth since 2014. Before managing the Sea Dogs, Epperson spent 12 seasons as the Red Sox Catching Coordinator. Prior to that, he spent his first eight seasons with the Red Sox as a manager or coach at the minor league level. A manager from 2004-09, he led his club to the playoffs in four straight campaigns beginning in 2006, including Single-A Salem in 2009. A back-to-back California League Manager of the Year with Lancaster from 2007-08, he also managed Wilmington to the playoffs in 2006. The Kentucky native managed Capital City in 2005 and Augusta in 2004 after spending two seasons (2002-03) as Sarasota's hitting coach. He also managed Cook County of the independent Frontier League in 2001. Epperson played nine years in the minor leagues in the Mets (1992-95), Red Sox (1997-99), and Orioles (2000) systems before his coaching career.

CHRIS HESS - HITTING COACH

Chris returns to Portland after serving as the Greenville Drive's hitting coach in 2023. He was a coach for the Sea Dogs in 2022 and in Fort Myers during the 2021 season. During his time with the Drive, they ranked first in batting average (.259), hits (1,133), doubles (249), second in triples (36) and third in RBI (618) in the South Atlantic League. The Drive were also crowned South Atlantic League champions for the 2023 season. This year will mark Hess' fourth year in the Red Sox organization. Previously, he was an assistant coach at the University of Rhode Island, his alma mater, after three seasons playing in the New York Yankees organization (2017-19). Hess replaces former Hitting Coach Doug Clark who was promoted to be the Hitting Coach for the Triple-A Worcester Red Sox.

SEAN ISAAC - PITCHING COACH

Isaac enters his second season as a coach in the Red Sox organization. He led the Sea Dogs to a 4.10 ERA and 30 saves in 2023. His pitching staff finished the year with 1,308 strikeouts, fifth most in the Eastern League. In 2022 he was the assistant pitching coach for the Nashville Sounds, the Triple-A affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers. Previously Isaac served as the Director of Player Development at UC-Santa Barbara. He spent three seasons (2016-2018) as a minor league pitcher in the Angels organization reaching the Triple-A level in 2017 and 2018. In 78 career games, he notched a 9-4 record with a 4.34 ERA. On May 2, 2018, he pitched the final inning of a combined no-hitter for Inland Empire.

MICKEY JIANG - COACH

The 2024 season will be Jiang's 18th with the Red Sox where he has held several different roles, including work as a consultant with International Scouting (2007-2012). He has been coaching in the Red Sox minor league system since 2009. He previously served as a coach in Portland from 2016-2017 and 2023. He served as a coach with Single-A Greenville in 2022 and with Fort Myers in 2012 and 2018-2021. A native of Taiwan, Jiang received his B.A. in International Trade from Tung-Hai University.

KYLE SASALA- COACH

Kyle joins Portland's staff after previously working as the Associate Head Coach at Grove City College from 2016 – 2023. Sasala helped the 2023 Wolverines to a school-record 30 victories, along with a 16-4 conference record. The Wolverines also won 28 games in both 2021 and 2022. In 2019, Sasala assisted head coach Matt Royer in leading the Wolverines to a then-program record 28 victories. He served as the team's interim head coach during the Eastern College Athletic Conference Division III Championship Tournament, guiding Grove City to a runner-up finish. Portland's former coach in 2023, Pablo Cabrera, was promoted to Complex Defensive Coach based out of Fort Myers with the Red Sox.

JUSTIN FROMETA - DEVELOPMENT COACH

Justin begins his second season as the Sea Dogs Development Coach and fourth in the Red Sox organization. He previously served as a Baseball Operations Associate and Player Development Associate for the Red Sox. He is a 2020 graduate of Tufts University.

BOBBY STACHURA - ATHLETIC TRAINER

Stachura returns to Portland for his second season as the Sea Dogs' Athletic Trainer. Stachura has served as the Athletic Trainer for Single-A Greenville for the past four seasons. He started in the Red Sox organization in 2017 as the Athletic Trainer for the Lowell Spinners. He also spent four years as an athletic trainer at the University of Rhode Island. Stachura graduated with a B.S. in Athletic Training from Lasell College in 2013. He received his M.S. from the University of Rhode Island's Department of Kinesiology in 2015.

DONNY GRESS- STRENGTH AND CONDITIONING COACH

After spending the last two seasons with the Greenville Drive, Donny Gress joins the Sea Dogs for the first time. Previously, Gress spent four years at the University of Kentucky, first as a graduate assistant (2018-2020), before becoming a coaching assistant with the Wildcats' Olympic Strength and Conditioning staff. Joe Hudson has been promoted to Worcester's Strength and Conditioning Coach after previously working with Portland in the same role in 2023.

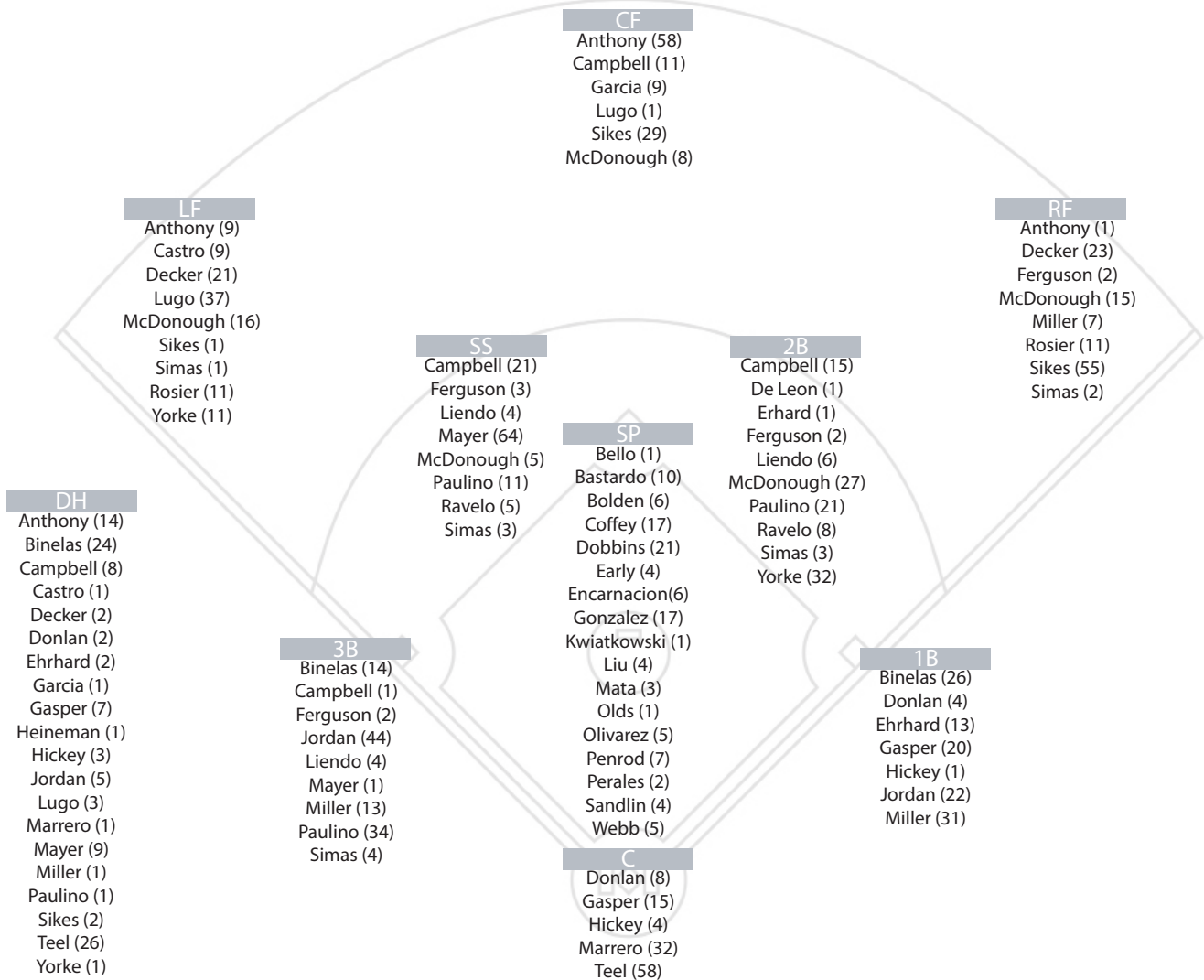
