TODAY marks games #80 & 81 of the 2024 regular season, the 2nd & 3rd games of a nine-game roadtrip, and the 5th & 6th games of a six-game series against the Great Lakes Loons. These two teams played 24 times during the 2023 regular season, with the Whitecaps losing the season series 11-13. The Whitecaps are a Detroit Tigers affiliate in their 31st season in professional baseball, while the Loons are in their 18th season of professional baseball affiliation with the Los Angeles Dodgers.

UP NEXT: The 'Caps finish their six-game stretch against the Great Lakes Loons before heading to Wisconsin for a six-game series against the Timber Rattlers from July 9-July 14.

STORYLINES AND HEADLINES

LAST TIME OUT: The West Michigan Whitecaps began the Fourth of July with fireworks, but it was the opponent who stole the grand finale as part of a 4-2 loss to the Great Lakes Loons in front of 6,212 fans at Dow Diamond on Thursday night. The Holiday festivities began with a rain delay spanning 78 minutes before a pitcher's duel ensued, and a solo home run by MLB Futures Game-bound Thayron Liranzo in the seventh inning ended up being the difference as the Loons cruised to their third win in the first four games of this series. The Whitecaps scored as soon as the contest began as Jim Jarvis blasted a solo home run, his third homer of the season, to help West Michigan take a 1-0 lead. The advantage was short-lived as Dylan Campbell launched a solo shot of his own, his fourth of the year, to even the score at one in the bottom of the frame. After Campbell gave Great Lakes the lead in the fifth with a sacrifice fly, Seth Stephenson tied the game at two with a run-scoring double, but the Loons got back on top when Liranzo blasted his solo homer and seventh of the season to give Great Lakes the lead and ultimately the game-deciding run. In the eighth, the Loons pushed across an insurance run to take a 4-2 lead and pick up back-to-back wins in the series. The Loons record jumps to 6-6 in the second half and 40-38 overall, while the Whitecaps drop to 8-5 in the second half and 39-40 overall. Loons starter Payton Martin (1-2) tossed a Loons season-high six innings while giving up two runs and struck out five in earning his first Great Lakes victory, while 'Caps reliever Cleiverth Perez (5-1) allowed the home run to Liranzo in taking his first career Whitecaps defeat. Kelvin Ramirez tossed a scoreless ninth to pick up his second save in as many nights and his sixth of the season. Danny Serretti and Roberto Campos had two hits for West Michigan in a losing cause. In addition, the Whitecaps were picked off the basepaths twice in critical situations, including once to remove the potential go-ahead run from being at the plate in the ninth inning.

THAT'S MY TIME: The Whitecaps have already played a pair of nine inning games this season which have been completed in under two hours, with the first coming on June 14 vs. Wisconsin, and the most recent occurring June 27 at Lansing, which set a Lugnuts franchise record in one four, and 44 minutes. The Whitecaps all-time record for the fastest nine-inning game is 1:36 set on June 24, 2004 while visiting the Burlington Bees.

TAKING IT TO THE MAX: Whitecaps infielder Max Anderson tied the franchise record with 12 total bases and four extra-base hits as part of the Whitecaps 15-9 victory over the Lansing Lugnuts on June 25 at Jackson Field. The previous times those records were established were four XBH's by Raph Rhymes on 7/1/14 vs. Lansing, and 12 TBs by Michael Hollimon (3 HR Game on 7/17/06 @ Beloit).

PITCH PERFECT: Entering play for the series beginning July 1, the Whitecaps sit 3rd in the Midwest League with a 3.77 ERA. They're 2nd in WHIP (1.26), 4th in Earned Runs (275), and 2nd in BAA at .222.

LEE-VING THE YARD: By Whitecaps outfielder Patrick Lee homering for his first West Michigan base hit on June 25, he joins catcher Bennett Lee to become the second West Michigan player this season to record a home run for his first base hit with the team in 2024.

PROSPECTS APLENTY: The Whitecaps hold seven of the Top 30 Detroit Tigers prospects, and are mentioned near the top right corner of this page.

Miller first joined West Michigan in May of 2024 as his seasons in Lakeland got significantly better with each passing season, as evidenced by the numbers listed on the left. After a good start in 2024, Miller earned the mid-season promotion, giving the Whitecaps their first left-handed starting pitcher of the season.

LAST APPEARANCE: Miller got back on track after a pair of bumpy starts, tossing four scoreless innings and giving up just one hit while striking out four as part of a 10-3 win over the Lansing Lugnuts at Jackson Field on June 30.

College: Posted a 3.63 ERA with a 6-4 record in 74.1 innings pitched while striking out 91 batters, being named first-team All-Ivy League with the Penn Quakers. 91 Ks were second-most in a single-season in Penn baseball history.

More: Played the 2021 season with the Savannah Bananas, a team that now has gone viral for it's unique version of baseball and its social media following in excess of 7 million viewers, becoming the 2021 Coastal Plain League Pitcher of the Year.

Full Name: Carlos David Marcano

Born: July 8, 2003

Acquired: Signed by the Tigers as an international free agent on January 25, 2021.

Marcano, who was signed by the Tigers as an international free agent in 2021 (the same class that featured Cristian Santana) was the youngest pitcher in the Florida State League to surpass 20 innings pitched in 2023. The teenager held his own in his first full season at the low-A level, tossing 100 innings while going 4-5 with a 4.50 ERA and generating 78 strikeouts and reducing hard contact (holding opposing hitters to a .237 batting average against).

LAST START: Marcano couldn't get out of the first inning, giving up four runs on two hits while walking three and striking out two as part of a 7-2 loss to the Great Lakes Loons on July 1 at LMCU Ballpark.

2023: After being a full-time member of the Flying Tigers bullpen the year prior, Marcano pitched well once again, limiting toe Peoria Chiefs to just two runs (one aired) in five innings in earning the win in the 'Caps 5-3 win over the Peoria Chiefs on May 22 at Dozer Park.

2022: Marcano came out of the bullpen in his first season with the Flying Tigers but struggled with hard contact, posting a 4.68 ERA while giving up 47 hits through 42.1 innings pitched. However, his strikeout-to-walk ratio stood out, generating 41 punchouts to just 18 walks on the season.

2021: Marcano enjoyed his breakout in the Dominican Summer League. Despite a 5.25 ERA, he displayed his ability to rack up his strikeout totals, punching out 41 hitters while allowing just 10 walks through 36 innings of work.

More: His repertoire includes a sinker/fastball, two breaking balls, and a changeup. The fastball/sinker is his primary pitch that sits in the low 90s which he's able to generate a ton of ground balls with. The two breaking balls are a curveball and a slider. The slider posted a 54% whiff rate in 2023, while the curveball posted a 36%.

His size is very projectible - listed at 6'2, 150 pounds, there is still plenty of room to grow into his body.
