HAPPY BIRTHDAY AMERICA: After winning a season-best six games in a row, including the first three of this split series with the Delmarva Shorebirds, the FredNats play their 10th game in a row today as the series shifts to Perdue Stadium in Salisbury, MD on America's 248th birthday, the 4th of July 2024. FXBG has relied on dominant starting pitching and clutch hitting in this recent stretch, as Sammy Infante's walk-off single last night propelled the FredNats to their second walk-off win of the season, and improved FXBG's record against Delmarva to 11-1 this year. The FredNats are outscoring the Shorebirds 74-30 this season. RHP Marc Davis looks to continue a strong stretch for FredNat starting pitching tonight facing off against Braxton Bragg for the Shorebirds.

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT**: The FredNats picked up their second walk-off win of the season, 4-3 over the Shorebirds on Sammy Infante's single in the 10th. FXBG improves to 6-1 in extras this year, and got another dominant start from Jarlin Susana prior to his promotion today. He pitched five scoreless innings, allowing just two hits and two walks with eight punchouts. Cristhian Vaquero's homer in the 7th tied the game, and Infante won it in the 10th as FXBG improved to 11-1 this year against the Shorebirds.

**OH SUSANA**: After another fantastic start last night, Jarlin Susana earned himself a promotion to High-A Wilmington today. In his final six FredNat starts, he allowed just two earned runs across 30 innings for an ERA of 0.60, and he struck out 49 hitters against just nine walks. Susana completely turned his season around beginning with the May 31 start at Down East, and the only two earned runs he allowed during that stretch were in the same inning in a start at Carolina. That 0.60 ERA is second in MiLB among qualified pitchers in that time frame as Susana heads to Wilmington as one of the hottest starting pitchers in all of MiLB.

**DOMINANT ARMS**: After heavily relying on the bullpen for the first two months of the season, the FredNat starting rotation has majorly improved over the last three series. Since June 11, FredNat starters have logged 97 2/3 innings and allowed just 18 earned runs for a group ERA of 1.66. In the three weeks prior to that, the starting rotation's ERA was 5.70. In this series alone, FredNat starting pitching has allowed just three hits and one run in 14 innings against Delmarva.

THIRTY FOUR AND OH: The FredNats remain perfect when leading after seven innings this season, with last night's win getting them to 34-0 when leading after seven, and also a perfect 36-0 when leading after eight innings. The winning formula all season has been the offense taking a lead in the middle innings, and the bullpen holding onto that lead each time.

**OH SYKORA**: After making his professional debut on May 1 with Fredericksburg, 2023 Nationals third round pick Travis Sykora has taken the Carolina League by storm in the first two months of his professional career. Including last night, he's pitched five complete innings in each of his last four starts, and has allowed just four runs in that time frame with 33 strikeouts and seven walks, and he set his new careerhigh with nine punchouts in last night's start.

**FORMULA FOR SUCCESS:** The FredNats are 33-5 this season when scoring first, including 29 out of the last 30 wins. FXBG did not score first in any of its losses the last two weeks, but did score first in each of the four wins last week in Salem, plus every game of this series so far.

**RBI KING**: Brandon Pimentel continues to lead the Carolina League in RBI with 54. This year, Pimentel is hitting .326 with runners in scoring position, and is 13-for-36 (.361) with runners in scoring position and two outs. He's also 5-for-11 with three doubles, two home runs and 18 RBI with the bases loaded this season, being at his very best with the stakes high.

THE SKIP IS BACK: The FredNats' leader from the last two seasons returns to the Managerial role for 2024. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg. Lowery, 34, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Iriple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978. Lowery is 185-154 in his two-plus years as Manager in Fredericksburg, including the 2022 Carolina League playoffs.

**THE STAFF:** The majority of the 2023 coaching staff returns for 2024, with the lone exception being Hitting Coach Mike Habas. Pitching Coach Justin Lord, Development Coach Carmelo Jaime, Performance Analyst Josh Freligh, Strength & Conditioning Nathan Sier and Athletic Trainer Jake Meyer are all back from last year's staff. Lord, 44, will begin his fourth season coaching in the Washington organization. The Florida State alum pitched six seasons professionally before transitioning to coaching, spending time in the Baltimore organization prior to joining the Nationals.

Habas, 33, begins his first season in the Washington organization after spending the last four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization. He was the hitting coach for the ACL Brewers the last two seasons, and was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats and Head Coach at Prarie State Junior College prior to his time with Milwaukee. Jaime, 38, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and has served as the first base coach and infield coach with the FredNats the past two seasons, roles he will continue in 2024. Meyer is in his seventh year with the Nationals overall and second with the FredNats, he spent his first five years at the facility

**TONIGHT'S START:** Marc Davis is set to make his 14th start of 2024, in his return to the mound from Tommy John Surgery in 2022.

Davis had a promising start to his professional career, as the right-hander posted a 3.97 ERA out of the bullpen in '22, while earning a Carolina League Pitcher of the Week nod as well.

**JUCO BANDIT:** Davis played three seasons at Florida Southwestern State, a junior college located in Fort Myers, FL. With the Buccaneers, Marc worked primarily as a reliever; 34 of his 44 total appearances came out of the bullpen. He recorded a stellar 3.14 ERA to go along with a 1.41 WHIP for his collegiate career, while striking out a whopping 14.55 batters per nine innings.

**TWO-WAY TALENT:** Davis was recruited as a two-way player out of South Gwinnett High School. He impressed scouts at the plate on the travel circuit, with exit velocities north of 90 MPH as a teenager, and displayed excellent range as a shortstop. Of course, he also possessed a rocket arm, and ultimately chose to focus on the mound.

**LAST TIME OUT:** For the second week in a row, Davis tossed five shutout frames for FXBG. The Red Sox mustered just two base hits against Marc, and managed two walks as well.
