Columbus Clippers LHP Will Dion (0-1, 0.00) vs. Worcester Red Sox RHP Lucas Giolito (0-0, 0.00)

Polar Plunge - The Worcester Red Sox open their first extended homestand of the season tonight when they begin a 6-game series against the Columbus Clippers (AAA-Cleveland) at Polar Park at 6:05 pm. Tonight's game can be heard on NASH 98.9 FM, The Pike 100.1 FM, and the rest of the WooSox Radio Network and seen on NESN+ on tape delay later tonight (because the Boston Red Sox are on NESN at 6:45 pm and the Boston Bruins are on NESN+ at 7:00 pm). The WooSox and Clippers will be battling each other and the polar conditions at Polar Park this evening as temperatures at game time are expected to be near 30 degrees with a gusty wind making it feel about 15 degrees. Tonight represents more than a 50 degree temperature drop from the mid 80's that the WooSox enjoyed in Jacksonville, FL last week/weekend. In a bit of good news...Worcester temps are expected to "climb" to the 50's by Thursday.

This Series – The WooSox – who played just two home games at Polar Park during Opening Weekend from March 28-30 (splitting those two vs. the Syracuse Mets with the middle game rained out) – will finally have the chance to settle in and play an entire week/weekend here in Worcester (we hope). This 6-game series vs. Columbus features games tonight – Friday all at 6:05 pm and then normal Polar Park weekend start times of 4:05 pm on Saturday and 1:05 pm on Sunday.

Lost Series – Worcester is coming off a series loss in Jacksonville last week/weekend as they dropped 4 of 6 games to the Jumbo Shrimp including the final two games over the weekend – thus suffering back-to-back defeats for the first time on the young season. The Sox have gone loss, win, loss, win, loss, win, loss, loss thus far.

Last Series – The Jumbo Shrimp won the opener one week ago tonight, 10-5; on Wednesday the WooSox shutout the Shrimp, 2-0; Jacksonville regained the lead with a 5-1 triumph on Thursday; but Worcester knotted things up again with their 7-1 win on Friday night. The Shrimp rolled to a 10-6 victory on Saturday and then rallied for a run in the 8th and the winning run in the bottom of the 9th inning to walk-off the WooSox, 3-2 on Sunday afternoon and capture the series outright, 4 games to 2.

Hello, Columbus – For the third straight year, the Columbus Clippers make a trip to Polar Park to take on the WooSox. Worcester has not yet played in Columbus and at the Clippers' superb Huntington Park and won't until at least next year. Columbus has enjoyed their two visits to Polar Park thus far. About two years ago they took 5 of 6 from the WooSox from April 11-16, 2023 scoring 54 runs total in their 5 victories that series. And last year, the Clippers and WooSox split a 6-game set last June 18-23 to close out the first half of the International League schedule. That too was a high-scoring affair as Columbus won games by scores of 16-4, 7-6, and 9-7 while the WooSox wins came by scores of 10-4, 6-2, and 2-0.

Rehabilitation Central – Tonight, for the fourth time in nine games to begin the season, the Worcester Red Sox starting pitcher will be a rehabbing Boston Red Sox pitcher. RHP Lucas Giolito makes his second rehab start when he faces Columbus at Polar Park this evening. Lucas started this past Wednesday in Jacksonville and went 2.1 scoreless innings in an eventual, 2-0 WooSox win over the Jumbo Shrimp – 2.1 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 2 SO – throwing 51 pitches (28 strikes).

(RHP Braylan Bello made two rehab starts for the WooSox last week in Jacksonville on April 1 & April 6. He is slated to make another rehab start this Friday night at Polar Park while Giolito, if he comes through tonight in good fashion, may make another rehab start this Sunday afternoon at Polar Park).

Giolito, 30, has been on Boston's injured list retroactively since March 24 with a left hamstring strain suffered during his lone official appearance this past spring training. On March 11 vs. Philadelphia, he worked just one inning as the Red Sox starter allowing 2 runs on 1 hit and 2 walks with 1 strikeout. He departed the game after that inning with a left hamstring strain. Giolito was the loser in an 18-8 Red Sox defeat to the Phillies that day.

Lucas was signed by the Red Sox as a free agent on January 3, 2024, but did not pitch during the 2024 regular season. After two spring training starts on February 25 and March 1, 2024, he was shut down and eventually had surgery on March 12, undergoing right elbow ulnar collateral ligament repair with internal brace. It was his second Tommy John surgery, the first coming on September 13, 2012.

The 6'6", 275 lbs. California native was selected by Washington in the 1st round of the 2012 First-Year Player Draft (#16 overall). He made his big league debut with the Nationals in 2016, but was traded to the Chicago White Sox following that season and spent the next seven seasons as a reliable starter for the White Sox. He made the 2019 American League All-Star team (going 14-9 with a 3.41 ERA in 29 starts that season) and he threw a no-hitter for the White Sox on August 25, 2020 vs. Pittsburgh (allowing just 1 walk with 13 strikeouts). During the 2023 season he was traded to the Angels and then later that year was claimed off waivers by Cleveland. In 180 major league games (178 starts), Giolito is 61-62 with a 4.43 ERA along with 1,077 strikeouts in 1,013.2 innings.

On a personal side...Lucas was the runner-up to Blake Snell in the inaugural 2020 *MLB The Show* Players League Championship. And his parents, Rick Giolito and Lindsay Frost are both actors. Rick has appeared in "As the World Turns", "Who's the Boss", "Hunter", and "Twin Peaks" among others while Lindsay has acted in "The Ring", "Without a Trace", "Boston Legal", "Lost", "Frasier", and "CSI" among others.

A Winning Tradition – The 2024 Worcester Red Sox went 79-71 to post a winning season for the fourth time in as many years of existence and for the third year in a row under returning WooSox manager Chad Tracy. Trace is only the second Red Sox Triple-A manager to ever post three consecutive winning seasons. Darrell Johnson did so from 1971-73 (the first two years when the Red Sox Triple-A club was in Louisville before moving to Pawtucket in 1973). Worcester finished 35-40 during the first half last year but then improved to 44-31 in the second half. Overall the 2024 WooSox went 40-34 at home and 39-37 on the road. The 2021 WooSox had a 74-54 record during their abbreviated inaugural season, the 2022 WooSox finished 75-73, and the 2023 club posted a 79-68 mark. Add it all up and the WooSox are 307-266 all-time for a .536 winning pct.

Records Were Made to be Broken – The 2024 WooSox set some team and individual modern Boston Red Sox Triple-A records (since at least 1973 when the Pawtucket Red Sox became the Red Sox AAA affiliate).

The WooSox **used 84 different players** last season to better the all-time Red Sox Triple-A record for players employed in a season (ironically set the year before with 79 by the 2023 WooSox). The 2024 WooSox also set a new all-time Red Sox Triple-A mark for player transactions in a season with **281 player moves** to pass the total of 271 from 2023 that was a record for less than a year.

The 2024 WooSox set new Boston Red Sox Triple-A records for **Most Runs** (they scored 869 runs to pass the previous record of 840 set by the Pawtucket Red Sox in 1996), **Most RBI** (808 RBI eclipsing the mark of 790 set by the PawSox in 1996), **Most Walks** (by batters) with 786 bettering the previous mark of 721 set by the '23 WooSox, **Most Hit by Pitch** (by batters) with 94 to break the previous record of 85 set in 2023, and **Most Left on Base** (WooSox had 1156 LOB to beat the 1121 LOB from the 2005 Pawtucket Red Sox),

The WooSox played 150 game last year to establish a new all-time Boston Red Sox Triple-A record for **Most Games Played** in a season (the 2022 WooSox held the record with 148 games played). WooSox batters set a Red Sox Triple-A record for **Fewest Intentional Walks** as Worcester received just one intentional walk all last season (Nick Sogard on June 23 vs. Columbus).

On the pitching side: Worcester matched the mark for **Fewest Complete Games** (only one last year by Grant Gambrell on April 24 at Toledo in G2 of a doubleheader) as the 2005, 2011, and 2018 PawSox and the 2021 WooSox also all had just one CG during those seasons.

Runs in the Family – Worcester had the 3rd best run differential in the league overall last season at +115 (865 runs scored and 750 runs allowed). Omaha, the 1st half and eventual IL champion, was a +136 while Scranton/Wilkes-Barre was +123.

WooSox Batters Led the Way – Worcester led all 20 International League clubs in a host of team offensive categories last season. The WooSox led the league with 869 runs scored (Scranton/Wilkes-Barre was next with 846 runs scored). The Sox also led the IL with 786 walks (Toledo was a distant 2nd with 676 walks). Worcester paced the league by a wide margin with an impressive .369 on-base pct. as the WooSox were the only team in the IL with an OBP of over .359 (Scranton/WB was 2nd at .358). Furthermore, Worcester had the 2nd best OPS in the league at .795 (Columbus was 1st at .804).

Rankings – Worcester finished 5th in the IL in team batting with a .259 average. On the pitching side, the Sox were 10th in team ERA (4.84). Sox pitchers allowed the 2nd fewest HR in the league (141 HRA while Nashville had 139 HRA). Defensively, the WooSox were 11th with a .979 field pct. (107 errors in 5126 total chances). And Worcester was 2nd in the IL with 1152 LOB behind only Gwinnett (1178 LOB).

Close Encounters - In games decided by one run or two runs last season, the WooSox were 23-33 (.411). When games were decided by 3 runs or more, the WooSox went 56-38 (.596).

Comebacks and Last AB – Worcester had 40 come-from-behind victories last season including 10 wins in their last at-bat of the game and 3 walk-offs. They suffered 18 losses during the opponent's final at-bat.

Daydream Believers – Worcester had more success last season in day games (34-25) than at night (45-46).

Series Matters – Worcester went 11-8-8 in their 27 series last year (11 wins, 8 losses, and 8 splits) and they did not lose any of their last nine series last season after dropping 4 of 6 at Scranton/Wilkes-Barre from July 23-28. The WooSox finished 5-3-5 in their 13 home series compared to 6-5-3 in their 14 road sets.

Players Aplenty - The 2024 WooSox built on a pair of all-time Red Sox Triple-A records (previously set by the 2023 WooSox) as they made 281 player transactions during the 2024 campaign and set a new all-time Red Sox Triple-A record for players appearing in a single season. The WooSox used 84 different players in 2024 (37 position players and 47 pitchers) to better the mark of 79 players in 2023. Ironically, the 2021 WooSox broke a long-standing Red Sox Triple-A record when they used 72 different players to beat the 1995 Pawtucket Red Sox (during a strike year when replacement players were used for the first month+ of that season) and the 2006 PawSox who each employed 70 different players. When Chad Tracy made his Worcester debut in 2022, the WooSox quickly set a new record using 75 different players (that was immediately topped first in 2023 and again in 2024).

Sea Dog to Woofsters – A total of 22 different players were promoted from Double-A Portland to Triple-A Worcester last season.

PORTLAND SEA DOGS (AA) GAME RECAP – The Portland Sea Dogs (3-0) swept their season-opening 3-game series in Reading, PA against the Fightin Phils this past weekend. The play their home opener tonight at Delta Dental Park at Hadlock Field against the New Hampshire Fisher Cats.

WOOSOX PLAYER MOVES - The Boston Red Sox yesterday selected right-handed pitcher **Robert Stock** to the active Major League roster from the WooSox and optioned right-handed pitcher **Cooper Criswell** to Worcester. Criswell has been added to the WooSox roster today. In addition, the Red Sox have returned RHP Hunter Dobbins to Worcester after Dobbins was added as the Red Sox 27th man for Game 2 of their doubleheader on Sunday night at Fenway Park. Dobbins was the starter and winner in Boston's, 18-7 rout of the St. Louis Cardinals on Sunday night – 5 IP, 8 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 2 BB, 5 SO.

Stock, 35, had pitched in two games (one start) for Worcester this season, tossing 8.1 scoreless innings with three walks and 12 strikeouts. The right-hander was signed by Boston as a minor league free agent on January 15, 2025, and pitched in three Grapefruit League games for the Red Sox. Originally selected by the St. Louis Cardinals in the second round of the 2009 First-Year Player Draft, the California native has recorded a 4.71 ERA (38 ER/72.2 IP) in 55 career Major League games (three starts) with the San Diego Padres (2018-19), Red Sox (2020), Chicago Cubs (2021), and New York Mets (2021).

Criswell, 28, earned his first career save in Game Two of Sunday's doubleheader against the Cardinals, pitching 3.0 innings. The right-hander has appeared in three games for Boston this season, allowing eight runs (four earned) in 4.1 innings. Originally selected by the Los Angeles Angels in the 13th round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft, the Georgia native owns a 4.71 ERA (74 ER/141.1 IP) in 41 career Major League games (20 starts) with the Angels (2021), Tampa Bay Rays (2022-23), and Red Sox (2024-25). He was 2-2 with a 1.40 ERA in 5 starts for the WooSox last season and 6-5 with a 4.08 ERA in 26 games (18 starts) for Boston last season.
