Tonight's Game

The Clippers will send LHP Logan Allen to the mound tonight, looking to run the road winning streak to four (have won five straight in Toledo). Toledo will counter with RHP Wily peralta. The Clippers are 6-5 (.545) against right handers handers this year. Peralta has never pitched against Columbus in his career, having appeared in 74 games in the PCL from 2011-12 and 2016-18.

vs. the Mud Hens

Columbus went 14-9 against the Mud Hens in 2019, snapping a two year losing streak (7-13 in 2018, 10-13 in 2017), while posting a margin of 4.6 in wins (seven by 4+) and losing by an average of 5.6 (six by 4+). Of the last six played between the two, four have been decided by at least seven runs. Bobby Bradley has 6HR and 20RBI in 25 games against Toledo in his career (1HR at Fifth Third Field).

Get What You Pay For

Louisville went 11 innings at Memphis last night, leaving Columbus and Toledo as the only teams in the IL that have yet to play extras. However, due to a double header, a pair of Toledo games have gone only seven innings, whereas every game played by Columbus has gone nine. No Clipper games have even seen a tie in the 9th inning (Omaha went from one down to one up on a 2-run HR on 5/12).

Road to the Cup

The Clippers were far and away the best road team in the IL in 2019, posting a record of 49-24 (.671), including the playoffs (18-4-3 in road series, 9-0 in sweeps). They won eight straight road contests over the end of the season and the playoffs, clinching the Governors' Cup in Durham (ran win streak to 10 through 5/5 in Louisville). Columbus was 9-3 in Toledo in 2019 (outscored Mud Hens 83-50).

Top Down

For the fifth straight night, Oscar Mercado will man the leadoff spot with Daniel Johnson backing him up. After a pair of doubles on 5/14 vs. Omaha, Mercado has gone 14 straight at bats without a hit, reaching base safely just once (HBP on 5/16 vs. Omaha). Johnson has a just pair of hits in the previous four (14AB), while scoring only twice (Mercado has scored once in last four).

Miller Time

Before Friday night, Clipper #3 hitters were at .147/.216/.206 (13th, last and last in the IL) with 0HR and 2RBI (tied for last in each), including an 0x4 from Owen Miller on 5/6 at Louisville. Miller has hit in each of four games since getting another shot batting 3rd (.500, 8x16), including his first homer of the season (5/14 vs. Omaha). In 12 games this year, Miller has eight multi-hit efforts.

Bump it Up

Gabriel Arias doubled his season hit total with Thursday's 3x4 performance and has gone 8x18 in this last 5G, raising his average 139 points from .143 to .282 (going into Thursday, Arias was one of five regulars hitting .150 or below, joining Bradley Zimmer, Bobby Bradley, Oscar Mercado and Nolan Jones). Arias has reached base in every game this season, posting a .429OBP.

In the Middle

Through 12 games, the Clippers rank 8th among the 14 recognized IL teams in average, 36 points from the top (Durham) and 37 points from the bottom (Indianapolis). Columbus has just one player (Owen Miller, IL leader) ranking among the top 29 hitters and four among the bottom 16 (Nolan Jones, 97th, Oscar Mercado, 95th, Bobby Bradley, 83rd and Bradley Zimmer, 82nd).

Swinging Hard

Heading into today, the Clippers have two players among the top five in the IL in strikeouts, as Bradley Zimmer sits in a tie for 2nd (22K) and Nolan Jones is 5th (20K). Zimmer has seen 46% of his trips to the plate end with a walk back to the dugout, while Jones is at 43%. Neither player has homered yet, but each has a double (Jones ranks 97th out of 97 with a .128SLG; Zimmer is 96th, .205).

Bullpen Getting Roughed Up

The Clipper bullpen had not allowed a run in the final third of a ballgame through the first six, but has given up 15 runs in the 7th or later in the last six games. Despite the last six games (31.1IP, 17ER), the bullpen still ranks 3rd in the IL with a 2.82ERA (28.1IP, 2ER, through first six games). Relievers started the year with 0HR to 132TBF, but have allowed 5HR to the last 122TBF.

This Date in Clipper History

Columbus pounded out 25 hits, then a franchise record, while scoring 20 runs in a win vs. Pawtucket. **Mike Patterson** led the way with 5RBI while **Mike Pagliarulo** and **Rex Hudler** each knocked in four. Every starter collected at least one hit and one run in the 20-5 victory, Columbus' 10th win their last 11 games. The current record for runs (26) and hits (30) were both set on 5/3/97 at Norfolk.

Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 years since the move downtown, Huntington Park has ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game, totaling 2.25 per contest (1,763HR, 783 games). Last year, HP averaged over three per game for the first time ever (seventh time averaging over a pair), as the Clippers surrendered a record 127HR and just missed out on triple digits themselves (97HR was second highest team total). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (931 to 902).

Record Destruction

The Clippers broke the established mark for homers in a season (182 in 1983) on 8/7/19 and finished with a total of 213 (most in the IL). From 5/14-6/2, they homered in 20 straight games (44HR total) and they had seven straight multi-HR games from 6/14-6/21 (22HR). On the mound, they broke the record for homers allowed (156 in 1998) on 7/31/19, giving up 198 for the year (2nd most in the IL).

Ain't Over 'Til It's Over

Since the start of the 2014 season, no team has had more come from behind victories than the 210 posted by Columbus (35 last season) and no team has produced a better winning percentage when trailing than the .353 of the Clippers (Scranton/WB ranks 2nd in win percentage at .338 and wins, 192).

Walk-Off Magic

Columbus was 5-2 in walk-off games last season, winning four thanks to the courtesy runner in extra innings (Columbus pitching did not allow a run through first 9.0IP in extras last year). On 6/29/19 at Louisville, they suffered their first walk-off loss of the year, snapping an 81 game streak without (previous loss was 5/31/18 at Buffalo). Additionally, the Clippers ranked 1st in the IL with a 16-8 (.667) record in games decided in the last at bat.

Trending Downward

While ranking in the top three of the IL with a 4.71ERA (3rd), the 2019 Clippers registered their worst mark since the 1998 season (4.85ERA). In 2018, they ranked dead last in the IL with a 4.34ERA, marking the third straight (now fourth) season that the team ERA had gotten worse. From 2011-16, the Clipper staff turned in a sub-4.00ERA five times in six seasons (zero such seasons from 1993-2010), including the best two ERAs of the past 30 years (3.33 in 2015 and 3.65 in 2016).

Doing Damage

In 2019, the Clippers ranked tied for 5th in the IL with 112RBI with the bases loaded, while carrying a .252 average (10th, 36x143, 4HR). In both 2017 and 2018, the Clippers led the IL in RBI with the bases loaded (243RBI total) and paced the circuit in grand slams (16 total, no other team had more than eight).

Free Swingers

After two straight seasons leading the IL in strikeouts, the Clipper lineup was atop the IL again in 2019 (1,392K, 60 more than 2nd place). They obliterated the franchise record (1,297, set in 2017; 2018's total of 1,290 was 2nd worst in franchise history), passing it on 8/22/19 (reduced strikeout rate to 8.3 per game after setting record, 10.1 prior). On the season a Clipper was punched out at least four times in a game on 15 occasions (**Eric Haase** led the team with three golden sombreros).

That's More Like It

In 2019, the Clippers were 50-30 (.625) when playing errorless baseball, while turning in a 31-29 (.517) mark with at least one error. Contrary to logic, in 2018 they actually had a worse winning percentage when playing mistake free (.514), than when committing at least one error (.530). The Clipper defense finished 1st in 2019 (.983) after falling to 6th in the IL in 2018, ending a run of three consecutive seasons ranked among the top three (2015-17 resulted in the three best seasons in franchise history).

One On, No Out Success

When the leadoff batter of an inning reached base in 2019, the Clippers plated him nearly 60% of the time (over 51% only once in the last six seasons, 55% in 2016). Getting more than one base was a specialty of Clipper hitters, as they led the IL with 136XBH to lead off the inning, including 54HR (led the IL, had 28 leadoff homers in 2018). From 4/13-4/20/19, the Clippers hit 16 leadoff doubles over 72 innings, including four straight innings in a win at Louisville on 4/15/19.

Good Baseball

Bobby Bradley was named International League Player of the Month for May 2019, reaching base in 24 of 25 games during the month while hitting .302/.374/.740 with 12HR (led IL) and 28RBI. **Brandon Barnes, Eric Haase, Josh Smith** and **Asher Wojciechowski** were named to the 2019 IL All-Star Team and Bradley, Barnes and Haase were selected to the postseason squad.

Manager Profile

Andy Tracy makes his Clippers debut in 2021, following Tony Mansolino's championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; Gene Michael-'79, Joe Altobelli-'80, Frank Verdi-'81, Bucky Dent-'87 and Mike Sarbaugh-'10). This season marks Tracy's second year as a manager (first with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 37-51 (.420), 7-5 with Columbus (.583).

Young Vet:

Allen is the youngest member of the Columbus rotation (will turn 24 in less than a week), but had as many Major League starts last month (5) as the rest of the staff had at Triple-A coming into the season (**Kirk McCarty** and **Jean Carlos Mejia** had never pitched above High-A, while **Scott Moss**, 4GS, and **Eli Morgan**, 1GS, rounded out the rotation).

In the Show:

After a promising start to the season (3ER in 10.0IP), Allen was chased before the end of the 3rd inning in each of his next three starts with Cleveland (13ER in 5.2IP). Through his first 57TBF, Allen was a member of the No Homers Club, giving up a longball to only Whit Merrifield on 4/5 (there's allowed to be one). Following that batter, Allen kept 47 straight in the park until allowing 6HR over 12TBF from 4/23-4/28.


Coming Around as a Clipper:

Starting with his regular season finale at Louisville on 8/29/19 and including both of his IL Playoff starts, Allen won three straight starts in a Clipper uniform, posting a 2.08ERA (17.1IP, 14H, 5R, 4ER, 7BB, 14K). However, he allowed a solo homer in each of those 3GS. In Allen's first four starts after the trade from San Diego, he was 0-1 with a 9.92ERA (16.1IP, 26H, 19R, 18ER, 9BB, 12K), giving up 5HR.
