## ARKANSAS TRAVELERS (16-12, 51-46) vs. SPRINGFIELD CARDINALS (18-10, 61-36)

LHP DANNY WIRCHANSKY (1-3, 4.82 ERA) vs. LHP PETE HANSEN (6-3, 3.79 ERA)

**SETTING THE SCENE:** Springfield hosts Arkansas (SEA) in the 2nd game of a 6-game series and 6-game homestand ... is the 14th of 24 games in the season series ... Cards are 5-8 vs. Travs and 2-5 at home ... in last matchup the clubs split a 6-game series in North Little Rock (May 6-11).

**TEXAS PETE:** LHP Pete Hansen makes his 19th start and 3rd vs. ARK ... went 6.1 scoreless IP in a no-decision last start on 7/24 at TUL ... struck out 6 with 1 walk and 4 hits ... was team-leading 7th QS ... has gone at least 5.0 IP in 11 of last 12 starts ... ranks 6th in TXL with 3.79 ERA ... is 0-1 with a 1.69 ERA in 2 GS vs. ARK ... had season's shortest start (0.2 IP) on 5/8 at ARK.

**FACING WIRCHANSKY:** LHP Danny Wirchansky gets his 3rd start vs. SGF this season ... is 0-2 with a 5.40 ERA (10R/6ER/10.0IP) in 1st 2 starts ... IF RJ Yeager has 3-career HR against the lefty.

**GORMAN REHABS:** IF Nolan Gorman went 0x4 in 1st game of his rehab assignment Tuesday ... placed on IL on July 18 with sore lower back ... 4-year big leaguer player for Springfield in 2022, hitting .288 with 11 HR and 27 RBI over 43 games ... is batting .219 with 9 HR and 29 RBI in 66 games for St. Louis this season.

**NOOT, TOO:** OF Lars Nootbar begins a MLB rehab assignment with SGF today ... recovering from a rib strain that placed him on the IL just before the All-Star Break ... batting .227 with 12 HR and 37 RBI in 88 games with St. Louis this season ... former USC Trojan debuted in MLB in 2021 and played 33 games for SGF in 2019.

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** IF Dakota Harris slugged 2 HR to help the Cardinals to a 3-2 win in the series opener vs. ARK ... Harris' 2nd solo shot broke a 1-1 tie in the 7th and gave the Cards the lead for good ... RHP Andrew Marrero (W) and LHP Nathanael Heredia (SV) combined on 3.1-hitless IP of relief for starter RHP Cade Winqwest.

**WIN QUEST:** RHP Cade Winqwest allowed 2R/1ER over 5.2 IP in his Hammons Field debut on Tuesday ... struck out 5, walked 2, and allowed 4 hits ... has given up just 1 ER over 10.0 IP in 1st 2 starts at Double-A.

**TALKING UP ARMS:** Springfield's ERA in the month of July is a TXL-best 2.21 ... have allowed 3-or-fewer runs in 16 of 22 games and are 16-6 overall in the month.

**BYE, BYE, BAEZ:** OF Joshua Baez took the team lead with his 20th stolen base on Sunday ... has only been caught 4 times at Double-A ... has 40 stolen bases total in 46 attempts between his time with Springfield and Peoria (A+) this year.

**DUB STEPS:** SGF holds the Texas League's best overall record (61-36) and best 2nd-half record (18-10) ... picked up its 60th win on Saturday night ... last year's franchise record-setting 79-win club won its 60th on August 10.
