### THIS DATE IN HISTORY

The last game for Nashville on a June 23rd date was in 2019 when they fell to New Orleans, 8-5, on the road. Nashville's all-time wins leader Tim Lillard got the ball and picked up a quality start (6.1 IP, 7 H, 3 R, 3 ER, 0 BB, 3 K) in a no-decision.

**Tonight's Game:** The Nashville Sounds and the Charlotte Knights play game two of a six-game series tonight at First Horizon Park. Nashville won last night's series opener, 6-3, behind a strong performance by Thomas Jankins. Tonight, right-hander Bowden Francis starts for the Sounds against right-hander Alex McRae for the Knights.

**Bowden Francis:** 25-year-old Bowden Francis makes his fifth start for Nashville tonight. In his four starts, he's 2-1 with a 2.45 ERA. Between Nashville and Double-A Biloxi, Francis has logged 43.0 innings in 2021 and has allowed 15 runs on 28 hits and 12 walks to go along with 51 strikeouts. He last worked on June 17 in a start against Gwinnett and went 5.0 innings in a no-decision. Francis was named Milwaukee Brewers organizational Pitcher of the Month for May (along with RHP Taylor Floyd). The right-hander made 5 starts (4 with Double-A Biloxi, 1 with Nashville) and went 4-1 with a 3.81 ERA (11 ER/26 IP). He allowed 22 hits and 8 walks during the month of May to go along with 34 strikeouts, while holding opposing batters to a .220 average. Milwaukee drafted Francis in the 7th round of the 2017 MLB First-Year Player Draft.

**Alex McRae:** 28-year-old Alex McRae starts for the Charlotte Knights tonight. The right-hander is 1-2 with a 6.11 ERA in nine games (two starts) and 0-0 with a 4.50 ERA in two relief appearances with the White Sox. In 17.2 innings with the Knights, McRae has allowed 12 runs on 18 hits and 19 walks to go along with 17 strikeouts. The Wisconsin native last pitched on June 16 against Jacksonville and went 5.0 innings in the start. He allowed 1 run on 4 hits and 3 walks to go with 4 strikeouts. The performance earned him win number one on the season. McRae was drafted in the 10th round of the 2014 MLB First-Year Player Draft by the Pittsburgh Pirates.

**2021 Standings:** The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the Triple-A East Southeast Division standings in 2021: First: 23, Second: 10, Third: 1, Fourth: 13, Fifth: 2, Sixth: 0, Seventh: 0.

**Sounds vs. McRae:** The Sounds have faced Alex McRae twice this season – both times out of the bullpen. He pitched 2.1 innings on June 2 and 1.0 innings on June 5. He got a no-decision in both contests. Current Sounds who have faced McRae include: Zach Green: 0-2, 2 K; Cooper Hummel: 0-1, K; Tim Lopes: 0-2, BB, K; Luke Maile: 0-1, 2 BB; Pablo Reyes: 1-1, BB; Weston Wilson: 1-1, HR, RBI.

**They Walk Alone:** Charlotte is on complete opposite ends of the league when it comes to walks. Despite drawing nine walks in last night's game, the Knights have drawn a Triple-A East League-low 125 walks. On the other side, Charlotte pitchers have issued a league-high 225 walks, 16 more than second-most Triple-A Syracuse at 209.

**Reyes Rolls On:** Nashville infielder Pablo Reyes has hit safely in all six games he has played in with the Sounds, including five multi-hit efforts. In the six games he is hitting .480 (12-for-25) with 11 runs, 2 doubles, 2 home runs, 4 RBI and 5 walks.

**Westbrook Finds A Way:** Infielder/outfielder Jamie Westbrook has reached base safely in 12 consecutive games. During the streak he is hitting a Triple-A East League-best .438 (21-for-48) with 9 runs, 6 doubles, 2 home runs, 13 RBI and 4 walks. His on-base percentage during the 12 games is .481.

**Hiura Gone, Henry In:** Infielder Keston Hiura was recalled by Milwaukee today. Hiura reached base safely in all 20 games he played with the Sounds and was hitting .403 (29-for-72) with 14 runs, 8 doubles, 5 home runs, 14 RBI and 13 walks. Nashville filled the roster spot with catcher Payton Henry, up from Double-A Biloxi. Henry entered the 2021 season as Milwaukee's 19-best prospect according to MLB Pipeline. The catcher turns 24 years old on Thursday and was hitting .315 (35-for-111) with 11 runs, 5 doubles, 1 triple, 1 home run, 10 RBI and 12 walks in 30 games with the Schuckers.

**Another Streak for Pérez:** Pérez has hit safely in 7 straight games for the second time this season. He is batting .406 (13-for-32) with 2 doubles and 5 RBI during the streak. He has also recorded 4 consecutive multi-hit games. Pérez is 1 of 4 Sounds to have 2 hit streaks of at least 5 games (Zach Green, Corey Ray and Dustin Peterson).

**How Sweet It Is:** Manager Rick Sweet is at the helm for the Sounds in 2021, as he was in 2014 when he led the club to a 77-67 record. Sweet has managed for all or parts of 30 seasons in the minor leagues and has compiled a managerial record of 2,054-1,935. The 2,054 wins are 11th-most all-time among all minor league managers. 10th on the list is Lefty O'Doul who won 2,094 games from 1935-57.

**The Milwaukee Era:** A new era of Nashville Sounds baseball began on February 12, 2021 when the club announced its affiliation with the Milwaukee Brewers. The affiliation with Milwaukee came after the Sounds signed a 10-year Professional Development License (PDL) with Major League Baseball as part of the 20-team Triple-A East League. Within the Triple-A East League, the Sounds are a member of the seven-team Southeast Division.

**LAST OUTING:** Francis got a no decision in his last start on June 17 at Gwinnett in Nashville's 3-2 win. He pitched 5.0 innings and gave up 3 runs on 2 hits and struck out 5. He threw 66 pitches (43 strikes) and exited the game with Nashville trailing 2-1.

**AGAINST OPPONENT:** Francis is facing Charlotte for the second time in his career. He made a start at Charlotte on June 5 and took the loss. He worked 5.0 innings and gave up 2 runs on 2 hits and struck out 6.
