LAST TIME OUT

Despite collecting just two hits, the Pelicans beat the Fayetteville Woodpeckers 2-1 on Wednesday night. **CF Alfonsin Rosario** hit a two-run home run in the top of the seventh to put the Pelicans in front. **RHP Yenri Rojas** tossed four shut-out innings out of the bullpen to take the win. **RHP Vince Reilly** retired the side in the ninth to pick up the save.

THE SILVER SEASON

The Pelicans will be celebrating their 25th season in 2024. After the departure of the Myrtle Beach Hurricanes in 1992, the Pelicans were established in 1999 following the relocation of the Durham Bulls to Myrtle Beach. During their 25 seasons, the Pelicans have won four Carolina League titles in 1999, 2000, 2015, and 2016. Myrtle Beach has been affiliated with three teams in their 25 seasons, including the Atlanta Braves (1999-2010), Texas Rangers (2011-2014), and the Chicago Cubs (2015-present).

SECOND-HALF SURGE

After enduring their longest losing streak in five years by dropping eight straight games from June 29th to July 6th, the Pelicans have turned it around to win 16 of 22 games from July 9-August 10th, and eight games in a row from July 23rd-August 1st. During that time, the Pelicans led the league in batting average (.257), runs scored (121), OPS (.784), and are third in home runs with 17 and ERA (2.97). This late-season run has propelled the Birds from 6th to 3rd in the second-half standings in the South Division, as they now trail the Charleston RiverDogs by 7.0 games for the top spot. The eight-game winning streak from July 23rd-August 1st was the longest in two years, when the Pelicans won a franchise-record 12 consecutive games from May 14th to the 27th.

TOP BIRDS

Currently, the Pelicans roster features one of the Cubs' top 30 prospects by MLB Pipeline and three selections in the 2024 MLB Draft. **INF Cam Smith**, the organization's No. 8 prospect, was promoted to High-A South Bend on August 27th. He homered in six consecutive games from August 20-25 to set a new franchise record. **OF Alfonsin Rosario** entered the Cubs' top prospects list at No. 22 in 2024. Rosario was a 6th round pick in 2023 out of high school. Seventh-round pick **OF Ivan Brethow** and 19th-rounder **C Owen Ayers** were also added to the Pelicans roster in mid-August.

BUDDY IS BACK

A familiar face will be leading the Pelicans in 2024 as **Buddy Bailey** returns to manage the club for his seventh year in Myrtle Beach. Bailey previously led the Pelicans from 2016-18 and 2021-23, and will be coaching his 18th season in the Cubs organization. During his Pelicans tenure, Bailey has recorded 488 wins, the most in franchise history. He has also guided the Birds to four half-season Southern Division Championship titles, one Southern Division Championship title, and the Carolina League Championship in 2016. In 2017, Bailey became just the 11th minor league manager to reach the 2,000-win plateau- he currently sits with 2,415. Bailey passed Mike Kelley (managed from 1901-1931) for third-place all time on the MiLB managers wins list on July 14th, 2024 with win number 2,391 over the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers. 2024 will be his 36th season as a minor league manager.

PELICAN POINTS

The Pelicans close out the season with a series in Fayetteville against the Woodpeckers. The season began between these two teams in Myrtle Beach, with the Woodpeckers taking two of three games. This is the Pelicans' first visit to Fayetteville since May 23-28, 2023, where they swept the Woodpeckers in six games.

Through the 124 games, the Pelicans are second in all of full-season Minor League Baseball with 177 wild pitches.

INF Cam Smith became the first Pelican ever to hit a home run in six straight games from August 20-25.

Pelicans' **INF Cristian Hernandez** was fourth in the Carolina League with 93 hits before being promoted to High-A South Bend on August 13.

Pelicans' **OF Andy Garriola** left the Carolina League with the lead in HR (18), RBI (72), and XBH (43) before being promoted to High-A South Bend on August 6.

OF Jacob Wetzel holds the Pelicans' franchise RBI record at 135, the all-time walks record at 155, and has the most runs scored in Pelicans history with 165. He was promoted to High-A South Bend on August 13th.

BIRD DROPPINGS

- Cam Smith's six-game home run streak from August 20-25 was the longest in Pelicans' franchise history and tied for the longest in MiLB this season.
- After leading the league in home runs last year, the Pelicans lead the league with 96 in 2024
- The 23 strikeouts by the Pelicans pitching staff in the 12-inning game against Augusta on May 9th were the most strikeouts by a team in all of MiLB this season, the most by a Carolina League team since 2017, and the most for the Birds since they struck out 32 batters in a 23-inning game against Kinston in 2011

- Through 123 games, the Pelicans pitching staff is second all of full-season MiLB with 177 wild pitches
- Eriandys Ramon set the single-game franchise record with four doubles 8/15 vs. Columbia
- The Pelicans walked 17 batters on 4/17 setting a new single-game franchise high
- The Pelicans 1:50 game against the Columbia Fireflies was the shortest nine-inning game in the Carolina League this season, and the shortest game for the Pelicans since 7/23/11 at Frederick (1:46)
- The Pelicans eight game losing streak from 6/29-7/6 is the longest since 6/2-6/14/2019 (9)
