THE BOYS WERE BUZZING

The Express took home a 9-4 win over the Bees on Friday night. Salt Lake scored in the first when SS Jack Lopez tripled to score CF Jordyn Adams and the Bees led 1-0. Round Rock answered in the bottom of the first. After CF Derek Hill singled, 1B Blaine Crim belted a two-run homer to give the E-Train a 2-1 lead. The Bees tied the game at two in the third. DH Jason Martin singled with two outs to score SS Elliot Soto, Express C Sam Huff delivered a two-out single in the third to score two. After CF Derek Hill and 3B Dustin Harris singled earlier in the frame, Huff knocked them both home. In the fifth, LF Cole Tucker singled to score Adams and the Bees cut the Express lead at 4-3. In the sixth, the Bees elected to intentionally walk Harris to face Crim. The righty slammed a double down the left field line which cleared the bases and brought the Express lead to 7-3. Tucker drove in DH Jason Martin with a single in the seventh. It was Tucker's second RBI of the game and it cut the Round Rock lead to 7-4. In the eighth, Crim put the cherry on top with a two-run homer down the left field line that scored CF Derek Hill and the Express led 9-4 where the score stood final.

CRIM IS COOKING

Round Rock 1B Blaine Crim blasted his fourth home run of the season and his first Dell Dinger of 2024 yesterday. Crim finished the night 3-for-5 with a double, two home runs, two runs scored and seven RBI. It was a career-high seven RBI for the righty. He had posted five RBIs on four separate occasions in his career with the last time coming in 2022 for Double-A Frisco.

MR. 200 DEREK HILL

Round Rock OF Derek Hill stole his 200th base of his career yesterday. Hill has swiped 190 bases in the minor leagues with 10 more coming in the Major Leagues. His single-season high came in 2016 and 2018 when he stole 35 bases in each season. Yesterday, he batted leadoff and collected a 3-for-5 night with a double, two runs scored and a strikeout. This year, Hill is lashing .343/.395/.557 with seven doubles, one triple, two home runs, five RBI, 15 runs scored, five walks and 20 strikeouts.

A MULTI-HIT MAN

Round Rock OF Sandro Fabian has two hits in each of his last four games and he is riding a seven-game hitting streak. During this streak, Fabian is 15-for-31 with three doubles, a triple, a home run, 10 RBI and five runs scored. He is second in the PCL in hits (31) and first in batting average (.397).

CUTTING DOWN ON THE K'S

In the four games this series, the Express are averaging only 7.3 strikeouts per game at the plate. Round Rock has struck out the fourth-least in the PCL this year.

SEEKING A SERIES WIN

With a win tonight or tomorrow, the Express will secure their first series victory since opening weekend against the Sugar Land Space Cowboys. It would also be the first series win in a six-game set for the E-Train. Round Rock is 1-2-1 in their four series thus far.

Round Rock was previously a member of the Houston Astros organization from 2019-2020. For the Astros, RHP Bryan Abreu (2019), INF Jose Altuve (2019), INF Yordan Alvarez (2019), RHP Ronel Blanco (2019), RHP Cristian Javier (2019), OF Chas McCormick (2019), OF Kyle Tucker (2019), RHP Jose Urquidy (2019), LHP Framber Valdez (2019) appeared in the series and also played for the E-Train.

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2024 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's second season with the E-Train. In his first season with the Express in 2023, he guided Round Rock to a PCL Second Half title and the club's first playoff appearance since 2019. The team's 89 total wins were the most regular-season wins in franchise history and just the seventh 80-win

campaign in club history. Davis oversaw the longest winning streak in franchise history when the Express won 14 consecutive games last year from August 8-23.

Prior to Round Rock, Davis spent two seasons as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.



In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped

the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.
