A Trip to the Capital

Reading continues a six-game series at Harrisburg with game four tonight. Reading holds the edge in the season series 5-4.

Looking Back

Reading won a low-scoring affair over Harrisburg last night 3-2. Zach Haake had a bounce-back outing, pitching five innings and allowing one run with five strikeouts in his first win for the R-Phils. Ethan Wilson hit a solo homer and Jhailyn Ortiz a two-run shot, which accounted for all of Reading's offense. The bullpen combined for four innings of one-run ball, which was capped off by Tommy McCollum's first Double-A save.

Max Do Well

Max McDowell is swinging a red-hot bat as of late, since his return from Triple-A Lehigh Valley on August 16. His three hits last night matched a career high and he's now had a hit in six-straight games, which is a new season high for McDowell. Over his last five games, he's hitting .500 and .438 across his last ten. Against Harrisburg in 2023, McDowell is hitting .320, which included a walkoff homer on May 26.

Abel's Sharp

Phillies No. 2 Prospect Mick Abel turned in an excellent start Wednesday night. He tossed seven innings, which is a new career high. It's the second time a Reading starter went seven innings this season, with the other Griff McGarry on July 21 at Altoona. Abel allowed just one run, two hits and had three strikeouts. He pitched to contact a lot more, tossing eight ground balls to just five fly balls. After last night, Abel now qualifies for the Eastern League lead in batting average against at .201. He also now ranks seventh in WHIP in 1.32. Abel is at 106 strikeouts this season and his previous high was 130, which came between High-A Jersey Shore and Reading last season.

Playoffs?

Reading remains in the playoff hunt, just 2.5 games back of a spot with 21 games to play. Since Somerset won the first half title, if the Patriots remain in first place, then the second place team in the Northeast Division will earn the final playoff spot. The two teams ahead of Reading are still on the schedule. Portland comes to Reading from Sept. 5-10 and Reading ends the season in Binghamton from Sept. 12-17.

Around the Organization

The Phillies had a day off last night and open a three-game series with the Cardinals tonight. Lehigh Valley and Scranton were postponed last night and will make up the game with a doubleheader Saturday. Jersey Shore fell 7-1 at Wilmington as Andrick Nava doubled, but the BlueClaws were held to three hits. Clearwater fell to Lakeland 3-2 as first round pick Aidan Miller made his debut at shortstop for the Threshers. The DSL Phillies took game one of the DSL Quarterfinals 4-2 over the DSL Angels in a best-of-three series.

This Day in Baseballtown History

August 25, 2013: At Reading, Roy Halladay is slated to make a rehab appearance in Baseballtown but is forced to return to Philadelphia early in the morning due to the big Phils' 18-inning loss the night before. 8,916 fans, more than 2,000 of whom bought tickets to see Halladay, get to watch the Fightin Phils lose to New Hampshire, 7-3, while Halladay beats Arizona, 9-5.

Hey Harrisburg

Harrisburg enters tonight with a 23-25 record in the second half and 54-62 record overall. Last week, the Senators took just one-of-five from Richmond, while dropping the last-four games. Next week, Harrisburg will begin a 12-game road trip at Binghamton, then Altoona. Currently, 10 of Washington's top-30 prospects are on Harrisburg's roster: Dylan Crews (1), James Wood (2), Brady House (3), Robert Hassell (8), Trey Lipscomb (14), DJ Herz (16), Cole Henry (19), Israel Pineda (22), Mitchell Parker (26) and Jacob Young (30).

Senators Pitcher

Lefty Mitchell Parker gets the start tonight for Harrisburg. It's his second start against Reading this season, as he started on May 27. In that start, Parker went five innings, allowed four hits, two runs and had four strikeouts in a no decision. In 2023, Parker is 9-4 with a 4.70 ERA over 22 games and 22 starts (95.2 IP, 91 H, 49 BB, 115 SO). Parker spent all of 2022 with High-A Wilmington, where he went 6-4 with a 2.88 ERA and struck out 10.5 hitters per nine innings. Parker made his pro debut in 2021 and split the season between Single-A Fredericksburg and Wilmington. The Nationals selected Parker in the fifth round of the 2020 draft out of San Jacinto Junior College in Texas. Parker ranks as the Nationals No. 26 Prospect according to MLB Pipeline. He went to the same college as fellow National Jackson Rutledge.

Had streak of four-straight winning decisions from June 8 through 28, which included allowing two-runs or less in each outing. That stretch also included back-to-back seven-inning aggrairs on 6/14 and 6/21. Suffered back-to-back losses on July 4 and 9, both against Hudson Valley. Posted back-to-back wins on 7/22 and 7/28 in six and seven inning outings respectively at Winston-Salem and then against Aberddden, the latter of which he allowed just one run in a victory. Had season-high eight strikeouts on June 28 against Brooklyn. Win in final start with Jersey Shore on Aug. 4 against Brooklyn. Won final three starts with Blue Claws, combining to allow four-earned runs over 18.2 innings in that span prior to call up to Reading. Earned win Aug. 13 in first start with Reading, going 5.2 innings. Allowed season-high five runs over five innings last time out on 8/19 vs Somerset.
