EXTRA, EXTRA: READ ALL ABOUT IT: The Omaha Storm Chasers played their first extra-innings game of the season and defeated the St. Paul Saints, 4-3, in 11 innings on a walk-off single by **SS Kevin Merrell**. **INF Gabriel Cancel** began the 11th inning as the placed runner, stole third, and subsequently scored on Merrell's opposite-field single. It was Omaha's first walk-off win since **INF Kelvin Gutierrez** hit a walk-off single on Aug. 11, 2019 vs. Las Vegas. The Chasers were held scoreless until the seventh inning, when **OF Anderson Miller**—celebrating his 27th birthday—hit a solo home run to trim the deficit to 2-1. Then, after **OF Edward Olivares** singled with two outs, **OF Kyle Isbel** drove him in to tie the game with a double down the right-field line. **RHP Scott Blewett** allowed two runs in 5.0 innings on a pair of solo home runs in his first start of the season while striking out eight and walking three. He finished his outing with back-to-back strikeouts to strand the bases loaded in the fifth inning. **RHP Andrés Sotillet** stranded the bases loaded in the top of the 10th inning to maintain a one-run deficit before tossing a scoreless 11th inning to set the stage for the Chasers walk-off win.

FOR OMAHA: **RHP Ronald Bolaños** makes his first start of the season and his Triple-A debut. He was acquired by the Kansas City Royals with OF Franchy Cordero in a trade with the San Diego Padres that sent former Chaser **LHP Tim Hill** to the Padres on July 16, 2020. Bolaños made his Royals debut on July 26 at Cleveland, allowing two unearned runs in 2.0 innings with one strikeout and one walk. He also started on Aug. 1 vs. Chicago (AL), allowing five runs on five hits—including two home runs—in 1.2 innings. The 24-year-old made his Major League debut with San Diego on Sept. 3, 2019 at Arizona, recording a quality start (6.0 IP, 5 H, 2 R/ER, 2 BB, 4 K). In five appearances (three starts) for the Padres in 2019, Bolaños posted a 5.95 ERA in 19.2 innings with 19 strikeouts and 12 walks. Prior to his call-up in 2019, he split the season between High-A Lake Elsinore and Double-A Amarillo.

FOR ST. PAUL: **RHP Griffin Jax** takes the hill for St. Paul and makes his 2021 debut. Jax spent most of the 2019 season with Double-A Pensacola while also making three starts for Triple-A Rochester in August. The right-hander posted a 4.50 ERA in his three starts with the Red Wings, striking out 10 and walking three in 16.0 innings, completing 6.0 innings in two of his three starts. With Double-A Pensacola, Jax recorded a 2.67 ERA across 111.1 innings (20 starts) with 84 strikeouts and 24 walks.

LEADING THE CHARGE: **OF Edward Olivares** has been Omaha's leadoff hitter in each of the first three games, recording three consecutive multi-hit games to begin his Omaha and Triple-A career, going 7-for-11 (.636) with four runs scored, one triple, one home run, four RBIs, two walks, and one stolen base. Olivares scored from first on **OF Kyle Isbel's** double down the right field line on Thursday to tie the game at 2-2 in the 7th inning.

WELCOME TO TRIPLE-A EAST: As a result of the reorganization of Minor League Baseball, the Omaha Storm Chasers are part of a newly-formed league, Triple-A East. The league, which combines teams from the previous Pacific Coast League, International League, Double-A Southern League, and independent American Association, is comprised of 20 teams split between three divisions: Midwest, Southeast, and Northeast. Omaha plays in the Midwest Division along with Columbus (CLE), Indianapolis (PIT), Iowa (CHC), Louisville (CIN), St. Paul (MIN), and Toledo (DET). Omaha will only face teams in the Midwest Division in 2021.

THE NEXT WAVE: Omaha's Opening Day roster includes seven of the Kansas City Royals top 30 prospects, per *Baseball America*, including **RHP Jackson Kowar** (4), **OF Kyle Isbel** (6), **RHP Carlos Hernández** (15), **RHP Ronald Bolaños** (18), **OF Edward Olivares** (19), **INF Lucius Fox** (22), and **RHP Scott Blewett** (25). Each member of the Storm Chasers current starting rotation (Kowar, Hernández, Blewett, Bolaños) is a top-30 prospect.

BACK AT THE HELM: **Brian Poldberg** embarks on his seventh season as the manager for the Omaha Storm Chasers and his 21st season as a manager overall. The Carter Lake, IA, native has a 1,283-1,353 (.486) all-time record as a manager, which includes a 408-439 (.482) record with Omaha. Poldberg is one of two managers in Omaha franchise history to eclipse 400 wins, joining the franchise's all-time wins leader, **Mike Jirschele** (995), who managed the team for 14 seasons ('94-'97, '03-'13). During his playing career, Poldberg spent parts of three seasons as a catcher for the Omaha Royals from 1983-1985.

WERNER PARK: 2021 marks the 10th season of Storm Chasers baseball at Werner Park since the ballpark opened in 2011. Since then, 63 players have gone from playing for the Storm Chasers to making their Major League debut with the Kansas City Royals, including 2021 Storm Chasers **Jake Newberry** (2018), **Kelvin Gutierrez** (2019), **Bubba Starling** (2019), **Nick Dini** (2019), **Gabe Speier** (2019), **Erick Mejia** (2019), and **Scott Blewett** (2019).
