FROM THE DOG HOUSE

MIGUEL TOES THE RUBBER: Right-hander **Miguel Toscano** takes the ball for Charleston in game two of the series versus Augusta. After a tough outing versus Hill City, Toscano delivered four relief innings (3 ER) last week at Columbia. The righty began his Single-A career emphatically, tossing seven perfect innings across two outings against Kannapolis (8/7) and Augusta (8/15). The Columbia native was called up to the RiverDogs on August 6 after appearing in 11 games in the FCL. Across 42.2 innings, he posted a 6.33 ERA and fanned 36 hitters. His pitch mix features a sinker, cutter and changeup.

SETTING THE TONE: Rays No. 14 prospect **Slater de Brun** has been a formidable presence atop the RiverDogs' lineup over the last two weeks. Since Aug. 13, the outfielder is 16-for-45 (.356) with a .567 on-base percentage, drawing 14 walks and getting hit by eight pitches. He has recorded at least one hit in 12 of his 14 games during that stretch, while reaching base multiple times in all but one. Overall, de Brun is 19-for-21 in stolen-base attempts across 25 games since joining Charleston at the end of July, tied for the most steals in the Minors over that span since his promotion to Single-A.

CLASH OF THE TAITN: Rays No. 6 prospect **Taitn Gray** has been sensational overall the last two weeks. In his last 11 games to end August, he went 16-for-40 with seven extra-base hits. In 23 games this overall that month, he has slashed .333/.379/.460 with a team-leading 18 runs batted in. On Aug. 18, he had a dominant day at the plate, notching four hits with four runs batted in. Throughout the night, he doubled three times marking the first such performance by a RiverDogs player since 2023 (Carlos Colmenarez). It marked his third career four-hit performance, and second with nine-or-more total bases. He is one of two players across full-season affiliated Minor League Baseball this year at age 19 years old or younger to achieve the feat.

WALK-OFF WINNERS: The RiverDogs notched walk-off wins in three consecutive games two weekends ago. **Angel Mateo** provided the final swing on Sunday, **Taitn Gray** delivered the heroics on Friday with a pinch-hit walk-off double in the ninth, while **Alberth Palma** set the tone with a walk-off single Thursday to secure an 8-7 victory in 10 innings. The three wins marked Charleston's 12th, 13th and 14th walk-off victories of the season, respectively, the most in a single season by the club since at least 2005. Charleston's 14 walk-off wins account for 42% of its 33 home victories and are the most across any level of professional baseball.

IN OUR EMERSON ERA: The RiverDogs welcome 2026 No. 2 overall pick **Grady Emerson**, who made his professional debut on Wednesday night at Joseph P. Riley, Jr. Park. The 18-year-old shortstop, who signed with Tampa Bay for a \$9.75 million bonus—the largest ever for a high school player—enters the organization as its No. 1 prospect and the No. 10 overall prospect in baseball, according to MLB Pipeline. A Texas native and Gatorade National High School Baseball Player of the Year, Emerson hit .532 with a 1.013 slugging percentage, seven home runs and 21 stolen bases as a senior. He is the first member of Tampa Bay's 2026 draft class assigned to Charleston and joins a RiverDogs roster featuring six other Rays Top 30 prospects, including No. 83 overall prospect **Cooper Flemming**.

PLAYOFF BOUND: The Charleston RiverDogs clinched the Carolina League South Division First Half Title with a victory over Wilson in June, securing a berth in the 2026 Carolina League postseason. The playoff appearance marks Charleston's first since 2024 and its fifth in the last six seasons since rejoining the Tampa Bay Rays organization in 2021. Charleston is seeking its first Carolina League title since 2023, when the club captured its third consecutive championship. The best-of-three Division Series begins on Tuesday, September 8, with the RiverDogs facing the Single-A Hickory Crawdads in Hickory. Thanks to their first-half division title, Charleston will host Game 2, and, if necessary, Game 3, at The Joe on September 10 and 11. The series marks the first postseason meeting between the two clubs, who faced each other 12 times during the regular season, with Hickory winning the season series 7-5. The teams have not met since June.
