SERNA HOMERS NOT ENOUGH IN 8-5 LOSS

Jared Serna blasted two home runs, but the Shrimp fell 8-5. Nashville jumped out to a 3-0 lead with two runs in the second and one in the third. A **Jonathon Long** RBI ground out in the bottom of the third put Jacksonville on the board. Nashville got the run back on **Bo Naylor's** fourth-inning RBI double. Serna hit a two-run shot in the bottom of the fourth to draw the Shrimp back within one. In the fifth, **Brock Wilken** went deep for Nashville. A Long sacrifice fly made it 5-4 in the seventh, but the Sounds scored three in the eighth before Serna's solo shot in the ninth to get it to 8-5.

CAM YOU FEEL THE LOVE TONIGHT?

In his first three Triple-A games following his July 17 promotion from Double-A Pensacola, **Cam Cannarella** went 2-for-13 at the plate. The Hartsville, S.C., native reached base in 26 consecutive games - the longest on-base streak for a Jumbo Shrimp since **Dane Myers'** 26-game run during the 2024 season and tied for the sixth-longest in recorded club history (since 2005) - prior to an 0-for-4 day on Friday. Over the last 27 games, Cannarella is 30-for-98 (.306/.438/.449/.887) with 11 doubles, one home run, six RBIs, 20 walks, 20 runs scored and nine steals.

NEED FOR SPEED

Heading into play on July 1, the Jumbo Shrimp ranked second in Triple-A in stolen bases with 141, but the club's 79.7 percent success rate placed only 14th at the level. Since that point, Jacksonville has swiped 86 bases (second-most in Triple-A) in 47 games (1.83 per game) on an 86.0 percent success rate. On the season, the Jumbo Shrimp have piled up 227 stolen bases, good enough for second in Triple-A. The Jumbo Shrimp are averaging 1.77 steals per game, just shy of their team-record pace of 2.03 last season, when they swiped 305 bags in 150 games.

RISP-Y BUSINESS

The Jumbo Shrimp have dropped 29 of their last 45 contests. Of those 29 defeats, a whopping 21 have come by three runs or fewer, including 15 by just one run. A big culprit in these losses has been Jacksonville's lack of success hitting with runners in scoring position. Over the last 45 games, Jacksonville is just 88-for-411 (.214) at the plate with runners in scoring position.

A SOFT TOUCH

Jacksonville has done a terrific job this season with their pitching; the club's 1,210 strikeouts are the third-most in Triple-A. The other factor contributing to the club's 618 runs allowed - the sixth-fewest at the level - has been its defense's propensity to turn batted balls into outs. Opponents' average exit velocity of 87.3 miles per hour is the third-lowest in Triple-A, helping Jacksonville turn 70.4 percent of the batted balls put in play against it into outs - the fifth-best defensive efficiency at the level.

ERROR 503: SERVICE UNAVAILABLE

Jacksonville had made an error in 13 consecutive games heading into play on Friday, by far their worst-such streak since returning to Triple-A in 2021, but the Jumbo Shrimp played a miscue-free game on Friday. Nonetheless, over this now-14-game stretch, which dates back to August 13, the Jumbo Shrimp's 17 total miscues are tied for the second-most in Triple-A with Las Vegas and Omaha, just one behind Nashville's 18. In comparison, Jacksonville committed only 15 errors in their 24 prior games from July 12-August 12.

DE LOS SANTOS CLAUS

In 24 games from May 10-June 10, **Deyvison De Los Santos** went just 21-for-94, batting .223/.247/.330/.577 with two doubles, one triple, two home runs, 11 RBIs, three walks and eight runs scored. In the 50 Triple-A games since, the Santo Domingo, D.R., native is 56-for-177 at the plate, slashing .316/.390/.588/.978 (9 2B, 13 HR, 38 RBIs, 19 BB, 26 R). In 2026, De Los Santos has cut his strikeout rate down to 20.0 percent from a peak of 26.3 percent in both the 2022 and 2023 seasons (24.7 percent in 2024, 22.4 percent in 2025).

SHRIMP BITES

Over his first 12 starts between both Double-A Pensacola and Jacksonville, **Karson Milbrant** went 4-1 with a 1.31 ERA (62.0 IP, 38 H, 4 HR, 28 BB, 85 K, .179 BAA). However, over his last nine outings (eight starts), the Liberty, Mo., native is 0-6 with a 12.33 ERA (30.2 IP, 44 H, 9 HR, 30 BB, 26 K, .355 BAA)... Jacksonville has won all three of its second-half series' against Memphis, but the Shrimp are 0-5-1 in their sets against everyone else. Their second-half record against non-Memphis opponents is just 10-26 (13-5 vs. MEM).

ABOUT KARSON

-A third-round pick by Miami in the 2022 draft, Milbrandt passed up a commitment to pitch at Vanderbilt University to sign with the Marlins.

-At the high school level, Milbrandt was named the Gatorade Missouri Baseball Player of the Year in 2022. He led Liberty High School (Mo.) to a 2021 Class 6 state title and to the 2022 Class 6 District 8 finals, where they fell to eventual state champion Liberty North.

-Milbrandt was also an excellent basketball in high school, receiving all-district honors.

-Grew up a fan of the Royals during Kansas City's 2015 World Series run. Lorenzo Cain was his favorite player as a kid.

-Milbrandt is currently rated as the No. 9 prospect in the Marlins' organization according to *MLB Pipeline*.

-Milbrandt earned a nod to the 2026 MLB All-Star Futures Game in Philadelphia, Pa. where he recorded two outs on just four pitches. Milbrandt joins former Jumbo Shrimp and currently active Marlins Max Meyer (2021) and Joe Mack (2025) as active Jumbo Shrimp players since 2021 to earn a selection.

-While pitching for Double-A Pensacola, Milbrandt became the first Blue Wahoo to earn back-to-back Southern League Pitcher of the Week honors. He received his first award after his start on May 16, when he pitched 6.0 shutout innings and struck out 12 against Chattanooga...his second award came after his start on May 23, when he pitched 6.0 more shutout innings and struck out a career high 12 batters against Columbus.

-Milbrandt put together a 27.0-inning scoreless streak from May 2 through the fourth inning of his start on May 30. The streak ended as the second-longest in team history behind reliever Lee Hyde's 31.0-inning streak in 2013 and the longest ever for a Pensacola starting pitcher.

-Milbrandt was promoted to Jacksonville on June 2 from Double-A Pensacola.

2025 SEASON

-After beginning the season on the injured list with right elbow tendinitis, Milbrandt recorded a 3.26 ERA and a career-high 11.8 K/9 rate in 19 starts for Beloit en route to the organization's High-A MVP award.
