### By the Numbers

After not hitting a home run in his first 115 Minor League games, INF Nate Furman has hit his first 6 professional home runs in his last 23 contests.

Since his Captains debut on 6/29/2023 vs. Fort Wayne, LHP Parker Messick has thrown 117 strikeouts, the 117 most in High-A during this span. The 2022 2<sup>nd</sup>-round pick out of Florida State ranks 8th in the Midwest League with 42 strikeouts so far this season.

> OF Guy Lipscomb (.360, 1st), INF Nate Furman (.349, 2nd). INF Alex Mooney (.326, 5th), and INF/OF C.J. Kayfus (.323, T-6th) all rank top-10 in the Midwest League in AVG. Lake County is 1 of 3 MiLB teams with 4 players in their league's top 10 in AVG. The other 2 teams are Palm Beach (Single-A, STL) and Montgomery (Double-A, TB).

## **CAPTAINS LOG**

West Michigan's 4-run 9th inning handed Lake County a 4-1 loss on Thursday night at Classic Auto Group Park in Eastlake.

Peterson earned his 5th quality start of the year, allowing just 3 hits, no walks, and throwing 8 strikeouts in 87 pitched (60 strikes). The righthander retired the last 15 batters he faced, and 20 of his last 21. Peterson is the only Midwest League pitcher this season to go 7+ innings 3 times this season.

The Captains struck first when DH Jake Fox, MLB Pipeline's No. 18 Cleveland prospect, plated SS Alex Mooney, MLB Pipeline's No. 20 Cleveland prospect, on an RBI forceout.

In the top of the 9th, West Michigan rallied for 4 runs off RHP Magnus Ellerts, who suffered his 2<sup>nd</sup> loss and 1<sup>st</sup> blown save of the year. RF Roberto Campos hit a game-tying RBI single before 3B Izaac Pacheco eventually gave the Whitecaps the lead with a 3-run home run

The Captains put runners on the corners with 2 outs in the bottom of the 9th, but Whitecaps RHP Matt Merrill threw a strikeout to end the game

JAKE RAKES: CF Jake Fox is batting .357 (5-for-14) with a team-high 7 RBI so far this series. Fox's 7 RBI are tied for 2nd most in the MWL

DOMINANT DENHOLM: Trenton Denholm's 8.1 innings pitched on Wednesday night were the most by a Lake County pitcher since RHP Joe Colón also pitched 8.1 frames on 5/14/2012 vs. Great Lakes. Denholm is the first Captain since at least 2005 to throw 8+ innings without recording a strikeout.

2024 VERSUS WEST MICHIGAN: Lake County leads the season series 8-4 through 3 series. The Captains took 2 of 3 games from April 6-7 at home, and won 5 of 6 contests from April 23-28. Lake County is 8-1 in games that follow a West Michigan series-opening win.

2-OUT HITTING: On Thursday night, the Captains hit .357 (5-for-14) with 2 outs. Lake County's .286 AVG with 2 outs this season leads High-A and ranks 3rd in Minor League Baseball.

21st SEASON OF CAPTAINS BASEBALL: 2024 marks the 21st season of Captains Baseball. After the Columbus RedStixx were purchased in 2003, they were moved to Eastlake and became the Lake County Captains. In 2,776 regular-season games, Lake County has an all-time ecord of 1,396-1,380 (.503).

VINNING WAVES: The Captains have had a winning record in 13 of their first 20 seasons, including in each of their last four campaigns. Lake County has made 7 playoff appearances in franchise history (5 Midwest eague, 2 South Atlantic League), with its 2010 Midwest League Championship being its sole title in franchise history.

### **TRENDS & NOTABLES**

AST TIME OUT: RHP Austin Peterson pitched 7.2 shutout innings, but YOU MAY BE RIGHT, GUY'S MAY BE CRAZY: But it just may be a Lipscomb that you're looking for. With his 11th multi-hit game of the year on Tuesday, Captains OF Guy Lipscomb leads all of High-A with a .494 OBP, and ranks 2<sup>nd</sup> with a .418 AVG (only trailing teammate Nate Furman's .422 mark). He has reached base in 16 of 17 games played this

> FURMANATION: Lake County INF Nate Furman extended his hit streak to 10 games in Wednesday night's win versus West Michigan. His streak trails only Beloit INF Josh Zamora for the longest active streak in the Midwest League. Furman is the only player in the MWL with multiple hit streaks of 10+ games this season. He is batting .522 (24-for-46) with 5 nomers and 13 RBI during his hitting streak. Additionally, his 24 hits since May 10 are the most in Minor & Major League Baseball, and his overall .349 AVG ranks 2nd in the Midwest League to teammate Guy inscomb's 360 mark

ALL ABOARD THE TUGBOAT: On Tuesday, Cleveland announced the promotion of Single-A Lynchburg LHP Matt "Tugboat" Wilkinson to Lake County. Wilkinson, a 10th round pick in 2023 out of Central Arizona College (JUCO), leads Minor League Baseball with 71 strikeouts, while ranking 6th with a 1.12 ERA and 8th with a 0.77 WHIP through 8 starts with Single-A Lynchburg. The Vancouver, B.C. native fanned a season-high 15 batters on April 25 versus the Myrtle Beach Pelicans (Single-A, CHC) in 6 scoreless, hitless innings. According to MiLB.com's Jesús Cano, Wilkinson became the 5<sup>th</sup> MiLB itcher since 2005 with 15+ strikeouts without allowing a hit.

MOONEY IN ORBIT: Captains INF Alex Mooney, MLB Pipeline's No. 20 Cleveland prospect, is 1 of 5 players in Minor & Major League Baseball with a .300+ AVG, 15+ extra base hits, 14+ stolen bases and 20+ runs scored, joining the likes of Bobby Witt Jr. (KC – MLB), Drew Avans (OKC -AAA), Luke Keaschall (CR - A+), and Braiden Ward (SPO/HFD, A+/AA) as the

WELCOME TO RAKE COUNTY: Captains hitters have been having a strong season at the plate so far this year. <u>Lake County ranks top-4 in High-A in:</u>

AVG (.267, 1st), hits (376, 1st), OBP (.359, T-1st) total bases (564, 2nd), fewest strikeouts (312, 2<sup>nd</sup>), runs (220, 4th), RBI (205, 4th), and SLG (.400, 4th).

TOP QUALITY: Through 42 games, Lake County starting pitchers have recorded 13 quality starts (6+ IP, 3-or-fewer earned runs), which are tied for most in High-A and tied for 7th in MiLB. RHPs Austin Peterson (5), Trenton Denholm (4), and Carter Spivey (3) have each recorded at least 3, while LHP Parker Messick, MLB Pipeline's No. 21 Cleveland prospect, has also recorded this season (4/25 @ West Michigan, W).

STRONG STARTING PITCHING: Lake County's starting pitching staff has been one of the premier units in the Midwest League so far this season. The group ranks top-4 in the Midwest League in: wins (14, 1st), fewest walks (49, 1st), nnings pitched (204.0, 2nd), WHIP (1.25, 4th), and strikeouts (189, 5th)

**LAST TIME OUT:** Back on May 18 at Lansing, **Parker Messick** (2-4) recorded the loss in the 15-11 defeat, allowing Minor League career-highs of 9 runs and 10 hits while walking 3. Messick allowed 2 home runs and threw 76 pitches (44 strikes) in 2.2 innings of work, the fewest in his High-A career.

**MIDWEST LEAGUE RANKS: Messick** ranks 8<sup>th</sup> in the Midwest League in strikeouts (42), while also ranking tied for 5<sup>th</sup> in swinging strike percentage (13.7%). Since his High-A debut on 6/29/2023 vs. Fort Wayne, **Messick's** 117 strikeouts are the most at the High-A level.

**AGAINST WEST MICHIGAN: Messick** is 1-0 in 2 starts versus the Whitecaps this season, while not surrendering an earned run in 11 innings of work. In 3 career starts against West Michigan, **Messick** has not allowed an earned run in 16 combined innings.

**BEST SINCE BIBEE: Messick**'s 1.77 ERA through 3 starts this season was the lowest by a Captain through 3 starts in a season since RHP and 2023 American League Rookie of the Year runner-up **Tanner Bibee** posted a 0.00 ERA through 3 starts in 2022.

**OPENING DAY STARTER: Messick** was Lake County's 2024 Opening Day starter, getting the ball for Game 1 of a doubleheader against the West Michigan Whitecaps on April 6. This marked his 4<sup>th</sup> consecutive Opening Day start across Minor League and collegiate baseball. The left-hander was the 2023 Opening Day starter for the Single-A Lynchburg Hillcats, and served the same role for the Florida State Seminoles in both 2021 and 2022.

**TOP 30 PROSPECT: Messick** is Cleveland's No. 21 prospect according to MLB Pipeline. Per Baseball America, "He throws from a low release point, which helps him get swings and misses on his fastball. His tumbling changeup is his best pitch and gives him a strong weapon against right-handed hitters."

**2023 IN REVIEW: Messick** started his first career 13 games with Single-A Lynchburg from April 7 to June 10 before starting 11 of 13 games with High-A Lake County from June 29 to September 9. **Messick** finished second in the Cleveland player development system with 136 strikeouts and a 3.77 ERA. In his final seven starts for the Captains, he posted a 2.52 ERA, 48 strikeouts, 12 walks and a .211 opposing average in 35.2 innings of work.

**FLORIDA STATE PHENOM:** Messick had a stellar college career at Florida State. In 2020, as a true freshman, he was named a Collegiate Baseball Newspaper Freshman All-American. Then, in 2021, as a redshirt freshman, Messick became just the second-ever player to be named ACC Pitcher & Freshman of the Year in the same season. He was also named a semifinalist for the John Olerud Two-Way Player of the Year Award, as he finished with a .225 batting average, 9 hits, one home run, and 5 RBI on the season as a hitter. Messick's 2021 performance led to him being named a 3rd Team All-American by four different publications, as well as pitching for the 2021 USA Baseball Collegiate National Team. Finally, in 2022, he led Florida State with 144 strikeouts, as he was the only ACC pitcher named a finalist for both the 2022 Golden Spikes Award and Dick Howser Trophy. Messick was also named a 2022 1st Team NCBWA All-American. When his collegiate career ended, Messick was FSU's all-time leader with a 6.7 strikeout-to-walk ratio.
