**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels lost their fifth straight game, falling to the SeaWolves, 3-1. In the fifth, **Andy Thomas** hit a two-out single and **Luis Toribio** brought him in to score with a triple. The SeaWolves answered with an RBI triple by Carlos Mendoza in the bottom of the fifth and gave Erie a 2-1 lead with an RBI single in the seventh. In the eighth, Gage Workman extended the lead to 3-1 with a groundout. **Hayden Birdsong** threw five innings and struck out six batters in a no-decision.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels face the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers, in the fourth of a sixgame series at UPMC Park. Richmond and Erie have met in the Southwest Division Series each of the last two seasons. Erie has won each of those series, including en route to winning the franchise's first Eastern League championship last season. This series is the first this year between the Flying Squirrels and SeaWolves. Erie comes to Richmond for six games from May 28-June 2. The Flying Squirrels return to Erie for six games from August 27-September 1.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have dropped nine-of-10 dating back to April 28, including eight-of-nine in the current road trip to Akron and Erie. The lone win in that stretch came on Friday in a shutout at Akron. In the previous series at home, the Flying Squirrels picked up their first series win of the year, taking four-of-six against the Baysox. The current losing streak is the longest for the Flying Squirrels since they lost seven consecutive games from May 25-June 1, 2023.

**THE SEAWOLVES** are the defending Eastern League champions. This year, they are in second place in the Southwest Division standings. They went 2-3 in last week's series against the Baysox in Bowie, with the series finale being canceled due to rain. After starting the season 9-4, the SeaWolves have gone 7-7 in their last 14 games since April 21. Erie's roster includes two of Baseball America's top-30 Tigers prospects, including RHP Troy Melton (No. 10) and 2B Hao-Yu Lee (No. 12). Three Erie players are on MLB.com's top-30 Tigers prospects, including Melton (No. 11), Lee (No. 14), and OF/INF Trei Cruz (No. 30).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander John Michael Bertrand makes his sixth start of the season and seventh appearance. He last pitched last Friday at Akron, Richmond's most recent win. In that outing, he threw five scoreless innings in a combined shutout, striking out six. He was named Eastern League Pitcher of the Week on April 29 after throwing seven perfect innings in his start on April 27 against the Baysox, retiring all 21 batters he faced with four strikeouts on 68 pitches. Last season, he climbed three levels, working from Low-A San Jose to High-A Eugene before joining Double-A Richmond in July for the remainder of the season. For the year, he led all qualified Giants minor league pitchers in winning percentage (.688) and ranked second in ERA (3.65), second in wins (11), tied for second in WHIP (1.23), third in innings pitched (118.1) and fourth in BAA (.248). Entering 2024, Bertrand was rated by Baseball America as having the best control in the Giants system. Bertrand began his collegiate career at Furman University in South Carolina before playing his final two seasons at the University of Notre Dame. He was selected by the Giants in the 10th round of the 2022 MLB Draft. For more on Bertrand, see page two.

FOR ERIE: Right-hander Troy Melton makes his sixth start of the year. He last pitched on Saturday at Bowie and allowed one run over four innings, setting a season high with six strikeouts. After posting a 6.43 ERA (5 ER/7.0 IP) in his first two starts, Melton has a 2.08 ERA (3 ER/13.0 IP) in his last three starts since April 21. Melton is in his first Double-A season. He split last year between Low-A Lakeland and High-A West Michigan, going 3-1 with a 2.74 ERA in 23 outings (22 starts). Following the season, he was named a Midwest League Post-Season All-Star. Melton was selected by the Tigers in the fourth round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of San Diego State.

**AWESOME APRIL:** The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans last month for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history, pending today's attendance. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and ranked third among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance, trailing only Dayton (7,923) and Worcester (7,453).

RISPY BUSINESS: In their last 13 games since April 25, the Flying Squirrels have hit .110 (8-for-73) with runners in scoring position, averaging 2.0 runs per game (26 total runs). On the current road trip to Akron and Erie, Richmond is batting .076 (4-for-53) with runners in scoring position and averaging 1.9 runs per game (15 total runs). In last week's series, the Flying Squirrels were shut out in the Tuesday opener and then scored their only runs on solo homers last Wednesday. Their only runs last Saturday came on a second-inning grand slam by **Grant McCray**. They did not have an at-bat with a runner in scoring position on Sunday in the finale at Akron. So far in the series in Erie, the Flying Squirrels went 0-for-8 with runners in scoring position on Tuesday night, 0-for-3 on Wednesday, scoring their only run in that game on an error, and 0-for-6 on Thursday. In the last four games since Sunday, Richmond is 0-for-17 with runners in scoring position.

**THE 'PEN IS MIGHTY:** There are three relievers on the active Richmond roster who hold a sub-2.00 ERA so far this season. Among Eastern League relievers (min. 14 IP), three Richmond pitchers rank in the top six in ERA, including **Evan Gates** (6th - 1.20 ERA - 2 ER/15.0 IP), **Tanner Kiest** (7th - 1.26 ERA - 2 ER/14.1 IP) and **Wil Jensen** (5th - 1.27 ERA - 3 ER/21.1 IP). Jensen also leads the league in relief innings pitched (21.1).

WILL POWER: Over his last 14 games since April 17, Will Wilson is batting .308 (16-for-52) with a homer, three doubles, eight walks, six RBIs and five runs scored. He reached base in 11 straight games from April 17-May 1, tied for the longest streak this season by a Richmond batter. Dating back to 2021, Wilson has played 160 games for the Flying Squirrels over parts of four seasons.

**IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS:** In the Eastern League, **John Michael Bertrand** is third in ERA (1.71), sixth in innings pitched (31.2) and tied for seventh in WHIP (1.07). **Hayden Birdsong** is tied for fourth in strikeouts (35), first in BAA (.148) and tied for seventh in WHIP (1.07). **Ryan Murphy** is first in games started (7).

PROSPECT WATCH: Eight of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the roster, including Hayden Birdsong (No. 6), Reggie Crawford (No. 9), Grant McCray (No. 10), Vaun Brown (No. 11), Eric Silva (No. 22), Adrián Sugastey (No. 25), Ryan Murphy (No. 28) and José Cruz (No. 30). In Baseball America's Best Tool in the Giants Organization list, John Michael Bertrand is rated as having the best control, Sugastey is rated as the best defensive catcher and McCray is rated as the best defensive outfielder and best outfield arm. Crawford is rated as having the best fastball and best slider. Seven players landed on MLB. com's top-30 Giants prospects list, including Birdsong (No. 6), Crawford (No. 8), McCray (No. 13), Brown (No. 15), Victor Bericoto (No. 20), Sugastey (No. 24) and OF Jairo Pomares (No. 26).
