Theo Clutched Up.... Theo Gillen, the Tampa Bay Rays' No. 1 prospect, delivered a game-winning three-run double in Friday night's 6-4 victory for the Bowling Green Hot Rods over the Rome Emperors. Gillen leads the Hot Rods with three doubles this season, which ranks third in the South Atlantic League. The 20-year-old also ranks in the SAL's top 10 in runs scored and stolen bases. Gillen has reached in all six games as a Hot Rods player.

Pitching Power.... The Hot Rods' pitching staff struck out 19 batters in their Tuesday night opener against Rome. It tied the second-most single-game strikeouts in Bowling Green franchise history and marked the first time since 2021. Hot Rods pitching has now struck out 48 batters in this series following 11 whiffs on Thursday. The Hot Rods enter Friday night's game with an outstanding 10.68 SO/9 ratio this season.

Bullpen Boost.... Bowling Green's relievers have come up big in their wins over Rome. Left-handed pitcher T.J. Fondtain blanked the Emperors with 3.0 scoreless innings on Wednesday night, logging his first Hot Rods save. Cade Citelli followed up on Thursday night with 2.1 scoreless innings to secure a save. Citelli allowed just one hit and fanned three in the 10-5 win. Andres Galan starred on Friday night with 3.0 scoreless innings to earn the win. The right-hander surrendered just one hit in the Hot Rods' comeback win.

He's Grrrreat!.... Tony Santa Maria became the second Hot Rods player to record three hits in a single-game in 2026. Santa Maria went 3-for-4 with an RBI double on Friday night. The returning Hot Rods player is batting 5-for-his-last-13 with an .847 OPS over his last five games.

Poole Party.... First-year Hot Rods player Tom Poole has posted a .963 OPS over his last five games. The outfielder has scored five runs and drawn six walks during that span, both leading Bowling Green players. Poole leads the SAL with a .563 OBP and six walks this season.

Flew Ball is For Real.... Nathan Flewelling became the first Hot Rods player with multiple round-trippers this season when he hit a solo blast on Thursday night, part of a 10-5 win. Flewelling logged the most total bases (7) of any Hot Rods player in a single-game this season when he added an RBI triple in his next at-bat. The 19-year-old is raking at the plate for a 1.178 OPS and 7 RBI, both bests of any Hot Rods player in his first six games of the 2026 season.

Harrison's Hill.... RHP Trevor Harrison starts for the Hot Rods on Saturday night. The Rays' No. 15 prospect delivered 100 strikeouts and a 2.78 ERA over his 2025 season with the Single-A Charleston RiverDogs and the Hot Rods. Harrison pitched 2.0 scoreless innings in his first start of the season against the Winston-Salem Dash on April 5th.
