LAST GAME

The Bowie Baysox moved to 2-0 on the young 2023 campaign with a 5-3 victory Friday night against the Hartford Yard Goats. Cesar Prieto led the charge offensively with a three-hit, three-RBI performance, which included a two-run double in the top of the fourth that gave Bowie a 4-0 lead. From there, the Baysox were held to one hit until there were two outs in the top of the ninth, when Coby Mayo launched his first home run of the season to left field, part of a two-RBI effort in his own right, for some insurance. Right-handed starter Connor Gillespie wiggled out of a few jams and escaped with three shutout innings to his name, before the combined relief efforts of southpaw Easton Lucas, along with right-handers Hudson Roth and Nolan Hofffman did enough to see Bowie over the line. Hartford did threaten in the ninth, with an RBI double from Bladimir Restituyo, but Hoffman was able to seal the victory for Bowie, along with his first career Double-A save.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

Last season, the Yard Goats finished with the second-best record overall in the Northeast Division at 77-60. Despite setting a franchise-record in wins, Hartford missed out on the postseason, finishing just a game behind Somerset in the first half, before ending 10.5 games behind second-half champion Portland. Entering 2023, Hartford's roster is led by three top-10 prospects in the Rockies system, per MLB Pipeline – OF Zac Veen (No. 2 COL, No. 27 overall), C Drew Romo (No. 4 COL, No. 84 overall) and INF Warming Bernabel (No. 7 COL). INF Hunter Goodman is also a potent bat, as his 36 HR across three levels were the third-most in MiLB in 2022, while his 106 RBI were tied for ninth-most.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Hartford enters the final game of the series sending left-hander Joe Rock to the mound. Rock has prior Double-A experience, as he started a pair of games for the Yard Goats in the final month of last season. However, Rock struggled in those starts, going just eight combined innings and allowing nine total runs across his Double-A starts. However, Rock has still shown plenty of potential. Honored as a Rockies Organizational All-Star last season, he threw over 107 innings across 20 starts in High-A Spokane and posted a 4.43 ERA while holding opponents to just a .219 average. Rock was fourth in the Rockies organization with 120 total strikeouts in 2022 and was just one of two arms in the system to throw a shutout.

MOUND REBOUND

Baysox pitching has hit its stride early this season. Bowie shutout Hartford for 13 consecutive innings to start the season – a franchise record for longest shutout streak to kick off a campaign. Bowie arms have kept the opposition off the scoreboard 16 of their 18 innings on the mound thus far and have shown the tendency to get out of jams, stranding 15 Yard Goat baserunners so far this series. Bowie pitching has also held the Hartford bats to just a .118 average (2-for-17) with runners in scoring position.

MEET THE CREW

The Baysox 2023 opening roster is a balanced mix of old and new. Bowie welcomes back seven arms with at least 45 innings in a Baysox uniform (RHP Garrett Stallings, Justin Armbruester, Connor Loeprich, Jensen Elliot, Tyler Burch and LHP Antonio Velez, Easton Lucas) in 2022, along with RHP Chayce McDermott and Nolan Hoffman in addition to LHP Cade Povich, who all made significant contributions to Bowie in the second half of last season. The Baysox also roster four position players (INF Coby Mayo, César Prieto and OF Zach Watson, Shayne Fontana) with over 140 plate appearances for the Baysox last season. Highlighting the newcomers is 2020 No. 2 overall pick Heston Kjerstad. The outfielder led the Orioles with four home runs and 34 total bases in Spring Training, along with a 1.219 OPS. In total, six of the Orioles' top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline (OF Heston Kjerstad – No. 6 BAL/No. 80 overall, INF Coby Mayo – No. 10 BAL, LHP Cade Povich – No. 13 BAL, INF César Prieto – No. 18 BAL, RHP Chayce McDermott - No. 19 BAL, OF John Rhodes - No. 21 BAL) will begin 2023 with Bowie.

LOCK UP YOUR VALUABLES

The Baysox have shown an early trend to be much more aggressive on the base paths in 2023. After only 16 games with multiple stolen bases all last season, Bowie has swiped multiple bags in each of its first two games. By comparison, the Baysox only stole multiple bases in consecutive games twice through all of last season. The five total stolen bases are the most for the Baysox in a two-game span since they stole six between April 28 and 29 of last year against Richmond.

WELL-WORN TRAVELERS

Bowie was forced to get used to heartbreak on the road in 2022. The Baysox were dealt 12 walk-off losses in 2022, tied for the most in MiLB (St. Paul)
