WE JUST CAME FROM THE SHORE: The Hudson Valley Renegades return home plate came back on July 5 in Jersey Shore. to Heritage Financial Park to host the Jersey Shore BlueClaws for the first time this season. The Renegades played a pair of series down in Lakewood, NJ where they recorded a 9-3 record against the Philadelphia Phillies High-A affiliate.

LAST TIME OUT: Saturday night's contest versus the Jersey Shore BlueClaws was suspended in the fourth inning. For the second straight game, the 'Gades scored four runs in the first inning with run-scoring hits from Christopher Familia, Rafael Flores, and Jesus Rodriguez. After the Jersey Shore tallied three runs in the third and a 46-minute rain delay, Spencer Jones and Jared Serna each plated runs in 1.2 scoreless frames out of the bullpen before the game was suspended in the bottom of the fourth inning.

DOUBLES MACHINE: Spencer Jones tallied his 25th double of the season on Tuesday night against Jersey Shore. Jones currently leads all New York Yankees Minor Leaguers in doubles and ranks second in the South Atlantic League, only trailing Dylan Beavers (26) from Aberdeen, Jared Serna is a close second in the Valley. Jones is currently tied with Joe Pomierski (1996) for the most doubles in a season by a Renegades batter.

HE GETS ON BASE!: Ben Cowles currently holds the Renegades' longest active on-base streak at 26 games. The former Maryland Terrapin has reached base in every game since July 4 in Jersey Shore. It's currently the longest active streak in Renegades bullpen has allowed just 13 ER in 56.2 innings tossed. Mason Vinyard tossed list update on Friday, and the Yankees claimed seven players on the list. 2023 Renegades Chase Hampton (#58) and Spencer Jones (#86) moved up the list. They were joined by former Renegades Oswald Peraza (#57), Jasson Domínguez (#64), Austin Wells (#85) and Everson Pereira (#79). Roderick Arias (#97) entered the list for the first time
