RIDERS ELIMINATED IN FIRST HALF DESPITE CAULEY'S TWO HOME RUNS:

Cam Cauley cranked two home runs but the Frisco RoughRiders were clipped by the San Antonio Missions 3-2 on Saturday night from Nelson W. Wolff Municipal Stadium. With the loss, the RoughRiders are eliminated from first-half postseason contention. Cauley drilled his first home run to lead off the game, kickstarting Frisco (37-30) to a 1-0 lead. San Antonio (39-29) then answered in the bottom of the second when Francisco Acuña roped an RBI double to tie the game 1-1. In the bottom of the seventh, Moises Gomez was hit by a pitch with the bases loaded to give the Missions a 2-1 lead. RoughRiders reliever **Gavin Collyer** then induced an inning-ending groundout to hold the deficit. Cauley then clobbered his second home run of the game in the bottom of the eighth, a solo shot to deadlock the game 2-2. In the bottom of the ninth, San Antonio walked it off when Brandon Valenzuela floated an RBI single to right off of **Skylar Hales** (1-4), giving the Missions a 3-2 victory. Jake Higginbotham (5-2) earned the victory for San Antonio, throwing two scoreless innings.

SECOND HALF, HERE WE COME:

The RoughRiders have officially been eliminated from postseason contention heading into the last game of the first half. Today, San Antonio will clinch a first-half South Division title with a win or a Midland loss. If Midland wins and San Antonio loses, the Rock Hounds would be division champions. After the Riders had a 1.5-game lead in the division on June 1st, they went 6-11 in their last 17 games.

TOUGH START IN THE ALAMO CITY ON OFFENSE:

Frisco has struggled in the five games of this series with while hitting .213 (36-for-169)/.261/.290/.551 with only seven runs scored, the fewest in Minor League Baseball. Their 71 strikeouts are also the most this week in Minor League Baseball. Frisco is just 3-for-31 with runners in scoring position this week. On Wednesday, the Riders struck out 19 times, which is a franchise record for their most strikeouts in a nine-inning game. All three walk-off losses for Frisco have been at the hands of the Missions this season.

POWER OUTAGE:

After homering 15 times in their previous 12 games, the Riders have homered just three times in their 11 games on this road trip. Frisco has hit just four home runs in their last 12 games while averaging 2.5 runs per game (last in Minor League Baseball) and slashing .205/.278/.282/.560. They are 5-7 in those games because of a 3.04 ERA on the pitching side, which is third in the league. Their four home runs allowed in the last 12 games are tied for the fewest in the league.

MISSION ACCOMPLISHED:

The RoughRiders dominated the San Antonio Missions all season and the Riders have had plenty of head-to-head success against the Missions over the years. In 2024, Frisco went 20-4 against San Antonio and have gone 65-36 against them since they rejoined the Texas League in 2021, including 38-16 at the Wolff. In those 53 games in San Antonio, Frisco has a 2.57 ERA, which is the best of any team in the Texas League. At the end of this six-game series in San Antonio, only Corpus Christi (60) will have played more games by a visiting team at The Wolff than Frisco (55).

SAVE TONIGHT:

The RoughRiders have had 11 different pitchers record a save in 2025. Frisco was the first team in Minor League Baseball to accomplish the feat this season. **Gavin Collyer** are leads the team saves (six) for the Riders, a mark that is tied for third in the Texas League. Their 23 saves are tied for the second-most in all of Minor League Baseball, just trailing Triple-A Jacksonville's 25. Their 4.20 bullpen ERA is sixth in the league. In June, their 3.22 reliever ERA is third in the Texas League.

OVER THE WALL-COTT:

Rangers top prospect **Sebastian Walcott** has been displaying the power as of late. In his last 33 games, he has blasted six home runs while slashing .250/.442/.537 with eight doubles, 20 RBIs, 20 runs scored and 18 walks to 26 strikeouts. This season, his walk rate of 12.5 percent is a career high while he is striking out at just 20.8 percent, a career low. His 16 doubles lead the league and his 24 extra-base hits also pace the league. In his last nine games, he is hitting just .182 (6-for-33)/.282/.182/.464 with no extra-base hits, five walks, nine strikeouts.

DOUBLE-A DOUBL-A RON:

Aaron Zavala has been on fire at the plate for the Riders. After a dreadful start, batting just .077 (2-for-26) through 10 games, he is hitting .300 (51-for-170)/.409/.465/.874 over his last 47 games. He leads the Texas League in walks (44) and is third in OBP (.404) while leading the league in walk rate (18.0 percent). In his last 21 games, he is hitting .301 (25-for-83)/.376/.458/.834 with two doubles, three home runs and seven RBIs. In his Frisco career, he has earned 200 walks over four seasons (300 games), which is second in franchise history. He is just six walks away from tying the franchise record for walks, held by **Guider Rodriguez** with 206 from 2009-2015 (527 games).

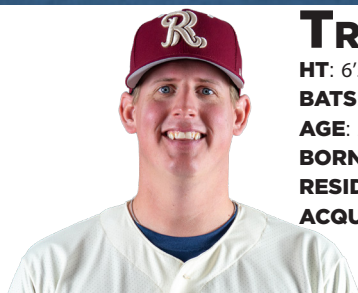

ABOUT TREY

-Pronounced SHOE-pock. Full name is Treyson Thomas Supak. Was named Treyson because he was the third child and "trey" stood for "three".

-Born in Bryan, Texas, but grew up in La Grange, Texas (La Grange didn't have a hospital). At La Grange High School, he starred in football, basketball and baseball and became the first player drafted from LGHS since **Homer Bailey** in 2004.

-Committed to University of Houston before signing with Pittsburgh. His uncle Jody was an All-American at Houston and was drafted by Detroit in 1987.

-Was drafted by the Pirates in the CB-B round of 2014.

2025 SEASON

-Allowed just three run through first three 5.0-inning starts.

-Made spot start with Triple-A Round Rock on May 3rd, allowing just two runs over five innings while striking out four and walking one.

2024 SEASON

-Spent time between Double-A Tennessee and Triple-A Iowa.

2023 SEASON

-Split time between Double-A Midland and Triple-A Las Vegas. Against Frisco in 2023, he made three appearances out of the bullpen (3.1 IP, 5 H, 4 R, 2 ER, 3 BB, 3 K), allowing a home run to Dustin Harris.

2021-2022 SEASON

-After electing free agency in Nov. of 2020, signed with the A's organization 18 days later.

-Missed the entire season and most of 2022 with "Tommy John" Surgery. Returned to make three starts with Midland that season.

2020 SEASON

-Was called up from the Taxi Squad to the MLB roster in 2020 for three days and was sent back down without making an appearance.

2019 SEASON

-Finished the season as the No. 11 prospect in the Brewers organization by MLB.com.

-When he made his Triple-A debut with San Antonio, it was 1.5 hours from hometown, so he had 40-50 friends and family there. "I have never had a feeling like that heading out to the mound."

-With Double-A Biloxi, won Southern League Most Outstanding Pitcher after leading the league in ERA (2.20), opponent batting average (.192) and tying for the lead in wins (11).

2014-2018 SEASON

-In December of 2015, he was traded to Milwaukee from Pittsburgh along with Keon Broxton in exchange for Jason Rogers.
