Last Night: Lugnuts 7, Captains 6. The Nuts swatted three home runs, delivered by Austin Beck, Cobie Vance and a crucial three-run homer by Michael Guldberg that provided insurance against a last-ditch Captains rally in front of 6,096 on Saturday night.

On Deck: The Lugnuts head out to West Michigan on Tuesday, opening a six-game series against the archrival Whitecaps.

What's New in 2021: Entering this season, the Lugnuts' stadium name changed from Cooley Law School Stadium to Jackson® Field™, Lansing moved up to the High-A Central and the ballclub accepted an invitation to affiliate with the A's, the Nuts' fourth MLB partner, following the Royals (1996-98), Cubs (1999-2004) and Blue Jays (2005-2020).

Lug•Notes: Headlines and Points of Interest

Star of Stars: The 2021 MLB All-Star Game MVP Award was won by to 2017 Lugnut Vladimir Guerrero, Jr., who went 1-for-3 with two RBIs, including a 468-foot home run, in the American League's 5-2 victory. Vladdy Jr. leads the Majors in batting average (.335), RBIs (77), on-base percentage (.434), total bases (216) and OPS (1.111) and is second in home runs (30).

Streak Halted: Outfielder Shane Selman finished yesterday 0-for-4, ending his 18-game on-base streak.

Power Binge: The Lugnuts have crushed six home runs in the past two games, including two in consecutive at-bats by Austin Beck and the first home run for Cobie Vance since April 17, 2019.

Alumni Report: 2019 Lugs outfielder Griffin Conine, playing for Beloit (MIA), leads the minors with 22 homers and tops the High-A Central with 58 RBIs and a .580 slugging percentage.

Bruised: Friday night saw five more players hit by pitches, three Captains and two Lugnuts. This came after a record-setting Wednesday night in which Lugnuts pitchers hit seven Lake County Captains with pitches (including Joe Donovan three times), setting the all-time High-A single-game record and breaking a franchise mark set by Lugnuts batters in 2017 vs. Peoria and Captains batters in 2019 vs. the Lugnuts. Lugnuts pitchers have hit 54 batters this year, second in the league, while Lugnuts hitter have been struck 59 times, first in the High-A Central. In 15 games in July, the Lugnuts have been hit 11 times while Nuts pitchers have hit 16 batters.

Heating Up, Hitters: The Lugs' leading batsmen in July are Jordan Díaz, hitting .347/.448/.531 with 10 runs, 12 RBIs, 5 XBH (2 HR) and a 9/6 BB/K ratio in 14 games, and Shane Selman, hitting .294/.379/.490 with 8 runs, 4 RBIs, 6 XBH (2 HR) and a 6/11 BB/K ratio.

Heating Up, Pitchers: Starter Reid Birlingmair gave up one unearned run in five innings Friday and has now posted a 1.06 ERA in three starts this month (3 R/2 ER, 17 IP) with a .153 opponent batting average. Fellow starter Jack Cushing has a 1.00 ERA in three starts (2 R/18 IP), allowing an OBA of .145.

Patience: Catcher Drew Millas drew two more walks Friday, giving him a team-leading 37 walks this year, fifth best in the High-A Central. It was Millas's tenth game this year with multiple walks drawn.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2011: The first nine Clinton batters reached base and scored against relievers Dayton Marze and Shawn Griffith in a ninerun bottom of the 7th inning, capped by a Mickey Wiswall two-run homer, bringing the LumberKings from a 5-2 deficit to an 11-5 victory.

Root, Root for the Home Team: July 4th's Lugnuts/Dragons series finale drew a season-high attendance of 10,109. That's a larger crowd than any of the Blue Jays' home games this season in Dunedin or Buffalo and it's higher than the average attendance in MLB for the Detroit Tigers (9,717), Baltimore Orioles (8,654), Pittsburgh Pirates (8,237), Tampa Bay Rays (6,783), Oakland Athletics (6,403), Miami Marlins (5,983) and Toronto/Buffalo/Dunedin Blue Jays (3,877). Only eight of the 119 other Minor League teams have drawn a larger crowd to a game this season: Albuquerque, Nashville, Charlotte, Fresno, Indianapolis, Round Rock, Durham and Las Vegas.

Major League Lugnuts: Three former Nuts have made their Major League debuts this season, bringing the total to 157 all-time - pitcher Ty Tice '18, outfielder Josh Palacios '16-'17, and pitcher Tayler Saucedo '16-'17. Tice and Palacios made their first MLB appearance in the same game for the Toronto Blue Jays on April 9th. It was the seventh time in team history that two Lugnuts made their MLB debut in the same game, with the first occurring on September 14, 1998: Carlos Febles and Carlos Beltrán for the Kansas City Royals. Saucedo most recently debuted, tossing a scoreless inning for the Blue Jays on June 17.

Record-Setting, For Better: On June 15, Max Schuemann broke Samad Taylor's franchise single-game record of four steals in a game (set July 1, 2018) with five stolen bases against the Great Lakes Loons.

Record-Setting, For Worse: On June 20, Stevie Emanuels broke the franchise single game record, tied many times before, of three homers served up in a game, giving up four HRs to the Loons - two apiece by Deacon Liput and Andy Pages.

So Many Starters: The Lugnuts have used 14 different starting pitchers this season, namely Brady Basso, Reid Birlingmair, Jeff Criswell, Jack Cushing, David Leal, Stevie Emanuels, Richard Guasch, Rafael Kelly, Bryce Nightengale, Colin Peluse, Leudeny Pineda, Seth Shuman, Shohei Tomioka and Brock Whittlesey.

Roster Index: José Mora is the 845th Lugnut all-time and the 41st player used this year. The 2021 Lugnuts have already surpassed the total number of players used in the 1999 and 2008 seasons (38 apiece). The franchise record for most players used in a single year is 54, set in 2017. Currently, about 18.6% of all Lugnuts are reaching the Major Leagues (157 of 845). If that percentage continues to hold true, at least seven of the 41 players to see time this year with the Nuts will reach MLB.

Finally: Pitchers Jeff Criswell, Stevie Emanuels and Shohei Tomioka, catchers Jared McDonald, Drew Millas and William Simoneit, first baseman Patrick McColl, and outfielder Michael Guldberg have all made their pro debut this season with the Lugnuts.

Front Office Connections: Lugnuts pitching coach Don Schulze was drafted 11th overall by the Chicago Cubs in 1980, 12 picks before Oakland Executive Vice President of Baseball Operations Billy Beane was drafted by the New York Mets. Lugnuts first baseman Patrick McColl set a new Harvard baseball single season record with 70 hits in 2019, breaking the previous record held by Athletics General Manager David Forst.

Clubhouse of Higher Learning: The Ivy League is well represented on the Lansing roster. First baseman Patrick McColl played for Harvard University, reliever Michael Danielak was drafted from Dartmouth College and catcher William Simoneit spent four years at Cornell University before grad-transferring to Wake Forest. Speaking of outstanding academic institutions, starter Jack Cushing spent four years at Georgetown University.

Power Five Baseball: The Lugnuts also represent the ACC (Michael Guldberg, Georgia Tech); Big 12 (Brady Basso, Oklahoma State); Big Ten (Dalton Sawyer, Minnesota); the SEC (Cobie Vance, Alabama); and the Pac-12 (Stevie Emanuels, Washington).

International Appeal: In addition to 17 different states (Arizona, California, Delaware, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Louisiana, Maryland, Massachusetts, Michigan, Minnesota, Nevada (Connor Hughes), North Carolina, Ohio (Scott Steinmann), Texas, Virginia, Washington) represented by Lugnuts players and coaching staff, seven nations are represented: USA, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Japan, South Africa (Anthony Phillips) and Venezuela (Javier Godard).

Representing His Country: 1B/3B Jordan Díaz played for Colombia in Olympic Baseball Qualifying play, blasting a game-tying home run in the 9th against Venezuela, but Colombia lost all three games in opening pool play and was eliminated. Team USA won the tournament, punching a ticket to Japan.



- Received first start in series opener at Visalia, May 18: 4 IP, 4 H, 3 R (2 ER), 0 BB, 4 K.
- Worked six innings apiece in final two starts with Stockton, June 1 vs. Lake Elsinore (3 H, 0 R, 1 HBP, 0 BB, 5 K) and June 8 vs. San Jose (8 H, 3 R, 2 HR, 0 BB, 3 K.
- In all, walked just 1 batter of 106 total batters faced in the High-A West, spanning 26 2/3 innings
- Joined the Lugnuts on June 15 with relief ace Jack Weisenburger's promotion to Double-A Midland... made Lugnuts debut that same day, starting the series opener vs. Great Lakes... gave up a second-inning two-run double to Justin Yurchak but that was it: 4 1/3 IP, 7 H, 2 R, 1 BB, 5 K... removed after walking James Outman, yielding to Brady Basso with runners at 1st and 2nd and one out... Basso stranded the runners... Lugnuts went on to win, 9-7, with two runs in the bottom of the 7th.
- Originally slated to start opener on June 22 at Cedar Rapids, but game was postponed due to rain... moved into piggybacking on opener Bryce Nightengale's start in Game 1 of June 23 doubleheader... held the Kernels to only one hit (Trey Cabbage double) and no walks in first four innings of relief... in bottom of the 7th inning with the game tied 0-0, allowed a second double to Cabbage, who moved to third on a Jair Camargo flyout to right... issued a pair of intentional walks to load the bases, then struck out Michael Helman for the second out... got in front of No. 9 batter Gabriel Maciel 1-and-2, but served up walk-off grand slam in 4-0 Lugnuts loss... struck out seven batters in 4 2/3 innings in defeat.
- Started June 29 vs. Dayton and suffered the loss: 4 2/3 IP, 9 H, 6 R, 1 BB, 6 K, allowing two home runs in Lugnuts' 10-8 series-opening defeat... gave up two-run homer to Eric Yang in the 2nd inning and two-run homer to Juan Martinez in the 3rd inning... departed with bases loaded in the 5th and watched reliever Sam Romero allow two of the inherited runners to score.

School Days: Attended MacArthur High School, where he was named 2015 Pitcher of the Year... attended Wharton County Junior College (the Pioneers; Wharton, TX) in 2016-2017... as a freshman: 71 1/3 IP, 60 K, 18 BB, 5.17 ERA... as a sophomore: 76 1/3 IP, 75 K, 5.07 ERA... as a junior, transferred to Louisian Tech and was named 2018 Second Team All-Louisiana honors and ABCA/Rawlings Second Team All-Region, leading Bulldogs in innings (87 1/3) and ranking second in Conference USA in WHIP (0.90), 14th in the nation... scheduled to be Tech's Saturday starter as a senior, but underwent foot surgery a week before the season was scheduled to start... finished as No. 2 in Division 1 among active players in lowest walks per nine innings (1.20)... posted career K/BB ratio of 135 K / 19 BB in 142 2/3 innings.

Draft Day: Taken 1154th overall in the 38th round, 2019, and signed for \$1,000... scout: Kelcey Mucker... after David was drafted by Oakland, Bulldogs head coach Lane Burroughs said, "He is the epitome of what hard work and dedication to one's craft looks like. This young man came into our program and changed his body, overcame a significant foot injury and absolutely attacked the game with a relentless work ethic. He found a way to get better every day, and is one of the best I've ever seen at commanding the baseball. He is what our program is all about. Tremendous character and makeup, great student, selfless and just a wonderful teammate. He is the ultimate competitor and undoubtedly will go down as one of the best to ever step foot on the mound for the Bulldogs."

Pro Debut 2019: Debut in A's system on June 27 in AZL... did not walk his first batter until 10th appearance, 20 innings in... promoted to Stockton for final appearance of the year, August 31 at San Jose... base stealers went just 2-for-4 in attempts against him... left-handed batters hit 3-for-44 (.068) with 0 walks and 19 K's... right-handers batted 22-for-102 (.216) with 4 walks and 32 K.
