#### SHRIMP WALK OFF STRIPERS 3-2

Jacob Berry's walk-off sacrifice fly helped Brian Navarreto for Jacksonville to beat Gwinnett 3-2 on Saturday. Graham Pauley got the scoring started with an RBI double in the first inning. The Stripers tied the score in the fourth on José Azócar's RBI base knock. An error plated a Jumbo Shrimp run in the fifth, but Drake Baldwin's solo shot in the sixth knotted the score again. Berry's walk-off ended the game in the eighth to give Jacksonville a shot at a series split on Sunday. Karson Milbrandt yielded just one run with seven strikeouts in 5.0 innings of work.

#### MEN OF STEAL

The 2025 Jumbo Shrimp swiped 305 bases, blowing past the previous club record of 192 set by the 1979 Jacksonville Suns. The 2026 Jumbo Shrimp got off to a slower start in the steals department, with their 29 stolen bases through the season's first 24 games placing in a tie for 13th place in Triple-A. Since that point, however, has been a completely different story; Jacksonville's 95 steals in the last 44 games are far and away the most in Triple-A since April 24, with Gwinnett's 83 steals ranking second.

#### PINTAR-EST

Over his first 20 games on the season, Andrew Pintar was just 15-for-81 at the plate, slashing a woeful .185/.295/.235/.530 with two doubles, one triple, seven RBIs, 13 walks and nine runs. The BYU product has changed his season around significantly since then; over the last 32 games, Pintar is 37-for-119 (.311/.413/.546/.959) with eight doubles, one triple, six homers, 24 RBIs, 20 walks and 26 runs. Since this hot streak began on April 28, Pintar ranks 13th in the IL in OPS, 15th in OBP and 18th in AVG and SLG.

#### ETZEL DAY? WELL, I LIKE ETZEL DAY

Matthew Etzel got off to a very slow start to the season, hitting just .183/.256/.254/.510 over his first 20 games of the season. Over the last 32 contests, however, the Texas native is a scorching 35-for-121 at the plate, slashing a robust .289/.390/.504/.894 with three doubles, one triple, seven home runs, 25 RBIs, 19 walks and 28 runs scored. Since this stretch began on May 3, Etzel ranks tied for sixth in the IL in runs, tied for 14th in RBIs, tied for 16th in hits, tied for 22nd in homers and 24th in OBP.

#### DEFENSE AGAINST THE DARK ARTS

Jacksonville has yielded the tied for the fifth-fewest runs (314) in Triple-A while posting the level's third-best ERA (4.23). While the club leads all Triple-A staffs in strikeouts (695), the Jumbo Shrimp have also done a phenomenal job at turning batted balls put into play into outs; Jacksonville ranks third in Triple-A by turning 71.9 percent of balls put into play into outs. Only three clubs have recorded a rate of greater than 71 percent this season.

#### THE SCRIPT HAS FLIPPED

In 2025, Jacksonville starting pitchers tossed only 603.1 of the club's 1,304.0 innings (46.3 percent), the seventh-fewest frames from lid-lifters for any Triple-A team. The approach fit the team's mold; the Jumbo Shrimp's 3.83 starting pitcher ERA ranked second in Triple-A, with the club's 3.64 ERA from its bullpen pacing the level's respective relief corps in 700.2 innings - the fifth-most of any bullpen. This season, the Jumbo Shrimp's starting rotation has taken the lion's share of work. Jacksonville starters have worked 314.0 innings, the second-most of any starting staff in Triple-A (52.2 percent of the team's total of 602.0 innings). Thus, the 288.0 innings from the Jumbo Shrimp bullpen is the fourth-fewest of any Triple-A relief corps. The difference in work has not made much of a difference in terms of results; Jacksonville starters have combined for the fourth-best ERA (4.21) at the level, with the bullpen ranking seventh at 4.28.

#### YES, SERNA!

Heading into play on May 27, Jared Serna had struggled significantly over this first 38 games of 2026, batting a .198/.261/.302/.563. The 24-year-old has at least one hit in each of his 10 games since, tied for the third-longest hitting streak for a Jumbo Shrimp this season. Over the last 10 games, Serna is 14-for-32 at the plate, slashing .438/.500/.906/1.406 with three doubles, four home runs, 14 RBIs, one walk and nine runs scored. After posting an ISO of .055 in 2025, Serna has upped that to .179 this season.

#### SHRIMP BITES

The Jumbo Shrimp have gone just 5-6 thus far during this 12-game homestand, dropping from 2.5 to 5.5 games back in the standings... Jacksonville has not lost a series since dropping four of six from April 21-26 at Gwinnett (3-0-3).

### ABOUT BRADLEY

-Blalock was high school teammates with fellow future major leaguer Parker Meadows at Grayson High School (Loganville, Ga.). The Boston Red Sox selected Blalock in the 32nd round of the 2019 MLB draft.

-After not playing in a game in 2020 because of the COVID-19 pandemic. Blalock wound up missing all of the 2022 season due to Tommy John surgery.

-The Red Sox traded Blalock on August 1, 2023 to Milwaukee for infielder Luis Urias.

-On May 20, 2024, Blalock was promoted to the major leagues for the first time. However, he was optioned back to Biloxi on May 24, briefly becoming a phantom ballplayer (a player who spent time on an MLB active roster without ever appearing in a game). That designation changed on June 20, 2024, when Blalock made his major league debut for the Brewers with a scoreless inning against the Padres in San Diego.

-Blalock was traded for the second time in his career on July 27, 2024. He was sent along with right-handed pitcher Yujaner Herrera to the Colorado Rockies for right-hander Nick Mears.

-The Rockies designated Blalock for assignment following the signing of right-hander Michael Lorenzen on January 15, 2026. He was traded to the Miami Marlins five days later for right-hander Jake Brooks.

-Blalock found Kevin Gausman's split change on the internet and used the grip as a model for himself. He liked the pitch's versatility as an option to both righties and lefties and the fact that it is both a "velocity and movement separator."
