**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels beat the SeaWolves, 10-7. For the second time in three games this week, the SeaWolves led off the game with a solo homer, this time by Trei Cruz. Corey Joyce homered in the second to give Erie a 2-0 lead. **Carter Aldrete** got the Flying Squirrels on the board with an RBI double in the second. In the third, Julio Rodriguez hit a three-run homer to extend the Erie lead to 5-1. Diego Rincones brought in a run with a groundout to open a 6-1 SeaWolves lead in the fourth. **Ismael Munguia** kicked off the Richmond rally with an RBI single in the fifth to pull Richmond within four. In the seventh, Munguia hit a two-run homer to pull the Flying Squirrels within two runs. **Brett Auerbach** singled in a run and **Andy Thomas** worked a bases-loaded walk to tie the game, 6-6. Aldrete rolled into an RBI groundout to move the Flying Squirrels ahead. After another run scored on a wild pitch, **Simon Whiteman** and **Hayden Cantrelle** picked up RBI hits to cap the eight-run inning and give the Flying Squirrels a 10-6 lead. Rincones closed the score to 10-7 with a sac fly in the eighth, but **Evan Gates** worked a quiet ninth for his first save of the season.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the fourth of a six-game series against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. Today marks the fourth of 24 games between the Flying Squirrels and the SeaWolves this season, tied for the most Richmond will play against any opponent. Richmond travels to Erie for a six-game series from May 9-14 and again from September 12-17. The SeaWolves return to The Diamond for a six-game series from May 30-June 4. This series marks a rematch of last year's Southwest Division Series, which Erie swept in two games.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have won four-of-the-last-five games and are tied for first in the division with Akron. After starting the season 4-0 for the first time in team history, Richmond dropped four-of-the-next-five games to finish last week's series in Harrisburg. The Flying Squirrels offense leads the league in runs scored (76), hits (103), RBIs (67), OBP (.376), SLG (.401) and OPS (.777) and ranks second in total bases (155) and walks (65). The Richmond pitching staff is second in the league in strikeouts (132), trailing only Erie.

**THE SEAWOLVES** split last week's six-game series in Erie against Altoona. They won the final two games of the week. Two of their three wins against the Curve were walk-offs, including a three-run homer in the 10th inning last Thursday by Colt Keith and a 10th-inning single by Mario Feliciano on Saturday. Erie's pitching staff leads the league in strikeouts (134). Erie's roster includes eight of Baseball America's top-30 Tigers prospects, including Wilmer Flores (No. 3), Ty Madden (No. 4), Colt Keith (No. 5), Dylan Smith (No. 17), Wenceel Perez (No. 19), Josh Crouch (No. 22), Brant Hurter (No. 26) and Gage Workman (No. 27). Flores (No. 3), Keith (No. 4), Madden (No. 5), Perez (No. 8), Smith (No. 15), Hurter (No. 21), Crouch (No. 24), Austin Bergner (No. 27) and Workman (No. 29).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Mason Black** makes third Double-A start. He made his Double-A debut on April 9 against Reading and allowed three runs over four innings. He pitched in Harrisburg last Saturday and allowed one run in four innings. A native of Scranton, Pa., Black was selected in the third round (85th overall) of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Lehigh University, where he was the Patriot League Pitcher of the Year as a junior. He made his professional debut last season with the Low-A San Jose Giants, posting a 1.57 ERA in eight starts. Black led the minors with a 0.35 ERA for the month of May last season and earned a promotion to High-A Eugene on May 24. For the season, he ranked fourth in the Giants organization with 136 strikeouts last year and was named an MLB.com Giants Organization All-Star. Black is rated by Baseball America as the No. 9 Giants prospect and No. 10 by MLB.com. **For more on Black, see page two.**

**FOR ERIE:** Right-hander Ty Madden makes his third start of the season. He made his season debut on April 8 at Akron and struck out 10 batters over four scoreless innings, allowing one hit. Last time out, he pitched one inning against the Curve on Saturday at UPMC Park and allowed one run with three strikeouts. Altoona loaded the bases with no outs before Madden struck out two straight, issued a walk to score a run, and then a strikeout to escape the inning. He was removed after throwing 36 pitches in the first. Madden made his final regular-season start of 2022 against the Flying Squirrels on September 16 at The Diamond and struck out nine but allowed four runs in 4.2 innings. He started Game 2 of the Southwest Division Series in Richmond on September 22 and allowed solo homers to **Ricardo Genoves** and **Carter Aldrete** over two innings. Madden was selected by the Tigers with the 32nd-overall pick in the 2021 MLB Draft out of the University of Texas. He is rated by Baseball America as the No. 4 Tigers prospect and No. 5 by MLB.com.

**HOME SWEET HOME:** On the year, the Flying Squirrels are 6-0 at The Diamond. This is the second time the team has started 6-0 at home in franchise history. In 2018, the Flying Squirrels started 6-0 before losing their seventh game at home. The Flying Squirrels are the only team in all of Double-A still undefeated at home. The only other team in the minors undefeated at home this year are the High-A Eugene Emeralds (2-0).

**BIG BATS:** The Flying Squirrels have scored 36 runs over the last two games with a 15-6 win on Tuesday, an 11-2 win on Wednesday and a 10-7 win on Thursday. The SeaWolves have led each game early. The Flying Squirrels are one of only two teams in the Eastern League who have scored double-digit runs in back-to-back games this season and the only team to do it three times. The Curve were the other, scoring 27 runs in consecutive games, also against the SeaWolves last week. Last Wednesday, they won 17-6 at UPMC Park and then lost, 13-10, last Thursday.

**ALRIGHT, ALDRETE:** After hitting .111 (1-for-9) in his first three games of the year, **Carter Aldrete** is riding an eight-game hitting streak, during which he is batting .414 (12-for-29) with two homers, two doubles, four walks and 10 RBIs. He is currently ranked seventh in the league in batting average (.342), tied for third in RBIs (10), 10th in SLG (.553) and ninth in OPS (.975). He hit his first two homers of the year last week in Harrisburg. After homering 13 times in his first two professional seasons, Aldrete clubbed 21 homers in 2022, including 15 with High-A Eugene and six with the Flying Squirrels.

**PATTY BARRELS:** **Patrick Bailey** has reached base in each of his first 10 Double-A games. He has picked up at least one hit in eight-of-10 games. On Tuesday, Bailey hit his first Double-A homer and tied a team record with five hits, going 5-for-5 with a walk and three RBIs. It was the 10th five-hit game by a Flying Squirrels batter in team history. He walked twice on Friday. Bailey is ranked fourth in the Eastern League in batting average (.366), sixth in OBP (.447) and tied for second in hits (15).

**TAKE A WALK:** **Andy Thomas** is second in Eastern League with 12 walks and he ranks first with a 29.3-percent walk rate. Last season, Thomas led the Northwest League in on-base percentage (.373) and ranked third in walks (58). He has worked at least one walk in seven-of-his-nine games played so far this season.

**SIMON SAYS:** In his last eight games, **Simon Whiteman** has reached base 16 times, posting a .533 on-base percentage, which is tied for the best in the Eastern League. He has picked up eight hits and eight walks since April 11. He reached base four times last Wednesday, including his first home run of the year and three walks. He homered again in the opener of the series on Tuesday.

**OLD FRIENDS:** Erie's roster includes former Flying Squirrels outfielder Diego Rincones, who signed with the Tigers as a free agent in December. Rincones played 142 games with Richmond over the 2021 and 2022 seasons, batting .269 (140-for-520) with 20 homers and 80 RBIs. Three total former Flying Squirrels are playing with other teams in the Eastern League this year. Pitcher Gray Fenter, who was with Richmond last season and with Bowie in 2021, is now with Somerset. First baseman Frankie Tostado, a member of the Flying Squirrels in 2021 and 2022, is now playing for Harrisburg.

**IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS:** In the Eastern League, **Patrick Bailey** ranks fourth in batting average (.366), sixth in OBP (.447) and tied for second in hits (15). **Carter Aldrete** is seventh in batting average (.342), tied for third in RBIs (10), 10th in SLG (.553) and ninth in OPS (.975). **Simon Whiteman** is 10th in batting average (.310), second in OBP (.459), seventh in OPS (1.011) and tied for fifth in runs scored (9). **Tyler Fitzgerald** is tied for first in triples (2) and tied for seventh in total bases (22). **Andy Thomas** is second in walks (12). **Ismael Munguia** is tied for second in runs scored (11). **Hayden Cantrelle** is tied for fifth in runs scored (9). **Kai-Wei Teng** is tied for sixth in strikeouts (17). **Carson Seymour** is tied for sixth in BAA (.171).

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels have eight players ranked in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects, **Luis Matos** (No. 5), **Mason Black** (No. 9), **Carson Seymour** (No. 12), **Erik Miller** (No. 15), **Ryan Murphy** (No. 20), **Nick Swiney** (No. 24), **Patrick Bailey** (No. 27) and **Randy Rodriguez** (No. 30). MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Matos (No. 7), Black (No. 10), Bailey (No. 11), Seymour (No. 17), Rodriguez (No. 26) and Murphy (No. 27).
