YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Curve, 2-0. The game was played in two hours and 54 minutes, which tied the fastest nine-inning game in franchise history. Mason Black allowed two hits over four scoreless innings and struck out six. Wil Jensen did not allow a baserunner over his three relief innings. José Cruz recorded the final six outs for his first Double-A save. Altoona starter Jared Jones did not allow a hit until Brandon Martorano, playing his first game back off the injured list, hit a solo homer in the bottom of the seventh. Simon Whiteman added an insurance run with an RBI single in the eighth.

DON'T BLINK: Thursday night's game tied the shortest nine-inning game in franchise history for the Flying Squirrels, finishing in one hour and 54 minutes. It was the Flying Squirrels' shortest game in team history at The Diamond. The other game completed in one hour and 54 minutes was a 1-0 loss against the Curve at Peoples Natural Gas Field on July 29, 2015. That game, JaCoby Jones drove in the game's lone run with an RBI single in the seventh inning against Matt Gage. Altoona starter Zack Dodson allowed two hits over seven innings and reliever John Kuchno and Brett McKinney retired the final six batters in order.

TŪDAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the fourth of a six-game series against the Altoona Curve, Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh. Today is the 10th of 18 head-to-head games this year. The Flying Squirrels went 3-3 against the Curve at The Diamond from May 2-7. Along with this week's series, the Flying Squirrels will head to Altoona for six games from August 1-6. The Flying Squirrels are looking for their first three-game winning streak since April 25-27 at Bowie.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have lost 10-of-13 since May 25. The Flying Squirrels were 14-7 through their first 21 games but have lost 22-of-their-last-32. Their 10-22 record since May 3 is the worst in the Eastern League. Richmond starters have thrown 184.2 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 272.1 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.17 ERA, which is the lowest in Double-A and the third-lowest of the 120 teams in the minors, trailing only Low-A Columbia (3.11) and High-A Brooklyn (3.15).

THE CURVE are tied for first place in the Southwest Division, even with Erie. The Curve saw their season-high six-game win streak snapped on Wednesday night and have now lost two straight. The Altoona offense has struck out 419 times this year, the fewest in the Eastern League. Altoona's roster includes five of Baseball America's top-30 Pirates prospects, including INF Liover Peguero (No. 7), RHP Jared Jones (No. 11), RHP Kyle Nicolas (No. 14) OF Matt Gorski (No. 16) and INF Andres Alvarez (No. 30). Nicholas Dombkowski is rated by Baseball America as having the best control in the Pirates organization and Sanchez is rated as having the best strike-zone discipline. MLB.com's top-30 Pirates prospects list includes Peguero (No. 6), Jones (No. 11), Gorski (No. 16), RHP Kyle Nicolas (No. 19) and OF Matt Fraizer (No. 22).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Kai-Wei Teng makes his 11th start of the season and his second against the Curve this year. After posting a 2.93 ERA through his first seven starts, Teng has gone 0-1 with a 13.03 ERA (14 ER/9.2 IP) over his last three starts since May 23. He last faced the Curve on May 5 at The Diamond and threw four hitless innings, allowing one walk. This year, Teng ranks tied for eighth in the Eastern League with 55 strikeouts. He also ranks second in the league (min. 35 IP) in strikeout percentage (33.9) and K/9 (13.26). Teng has climbed to fourth on the Flying Squirrels career strikeouts list with 224 over the last two seasons. All other pitchers in the top-nine have spent at least three seasons with the Flying Squirrels. Those 224 strikeouts are also the most among all Double-A pitchers since the start of the 2022 season. Last year, Teng led the Eastern League and set a Richmond franchise record with 169 strikeouts. For 2022 in his first Double-A season, Teng went 6-12 with a 5.22 ERA. He tied the Flying Squirrels' franchise record for the most starts in a season with 28. A native of Taiwan, Teng was originally signed by the Minnesota Twins before being traded to the Giants at the deadline in 2019 along with RHP Prelander Berroa for RHP Sam Dyson. FOR ALTOUNA: Right-hander Cameron Junker makes his first Double-A start. He pitched out of the bullpen on Tuesday and worked one inning, allowing one run on a two hits and a walk. Junker has allowed two runs over his last three outings, all one-inning appearances, but he did not allow a run in his previous 10 games from May 2-30, spanning 13.1 innings. That stretch also included two scoreless outings at The Diamond on May 2 (1.0 inning) and May 5 (2.1 innings). Junker was selected by the Pirates in the 10th round of the 2019 MLB Draft out of Notre Dame.

PACKING THE HOUSE: Last year, the Flying Squirrels led all of Double-A in total attendance (406,560) and average attendance (6,160) for the first time in franchise history. This year, they are again leading the level in average attendance (6,710) and total attendance (194,579). The Flying Squirrels are ranked 10th of the 120 MiLB teams in average attendance.

MARTY PARTY: After missing 39 games with a hand injury, Brandon Martorano was reinstated from the injured list on Thursday and played his first game for the Flying Squirrels since April 20. In his third at-bat leading off the bottom of the seventh, he broke the shutout and the no-hit bid with a solo home run. Martorano is playing his third season with Richmond. He first joined the team mid-way through the 2021 season and spent all of 2022 in the Eastern League. In his 141 Double-A games, Martorano has homered 17 times and has 69 RBIs.

GLDW SHDW: Infielder Jimmy Glowenke was assigned to Double-A Richmond last week and made his Double-A debut last Wednesday against Erie. He was selected in the second round (68th overall) by the Giants in the 2020 MLB Draft out of Dallas Baptist. Glowenke started the season with High-A Eugene. Among Northwest League hitters (min. 100 PA) this year, Glowenke ranked sixth in OPS (.956), sixth in batting average (.313), sixth in wRC+ (146), seventh in OBP (.413), tied for seventh in doubles (10) and eighth in SLG (.542) at the time of his promotion. He also had the fourth-lowest strikeouts percentage (14.3) in the league. After going 0-for-4 in his Double-A debut last Wednesday, he had hit safely in five straight games before going 0-for-3 on Thursday.

WHERE THERE'S A WILLIAMS THERE'S A WAY: Carter Williams has hit safely in each of his last nine games since May 27. During that stretch, he is batting .353 (12-for-34) with two homers, a double, three RBIs and eight runs scored. His nine-game hit streak is tied for the fourth-longest active streak in the Eastern League. It is also tied for the longest by a Richmond player this year, matching a nine-game streak by Carter Aldrete from May 19-28. Last year in his first full professional season, Williams hit .336 over 80 games between Low-A San Jose and High-A Eugene, which ranked second among Giants minor league hitters (min. 300 PA).

VAUN RETURNS: Outfielder Vaun Brown was reinstated from the injured list with the Flying Squirrels on May 16. After missing the start of the season with an injury, he joined Low-A San Jose on a rehab assignment in late-April and played five games before joining High-A Eugene for five games. Last year, Brown played his first full professional season and led all full-season minor leaguers in batting average (.346) and OPS (1.060). He also ranked third in the minors in SLG (.623) and sixth in OBP (.437). Brown joined the Flying Squirrels last August and made his Double-A debut in Akron, but left that game in the fifth inning with an injury and did not play again for the year. Brown has reached base in each of his nine games with Richmond. Last Wednesday, he set a Double-A high with three hits, including a homer and a double. On Friday, he again picked up three hits and scored the walk-off winning run in the ninth.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, Ismael Munguia is eighth seventh in batting average (.300). Tyler Fitzgerald is tied for second in triples (3). Hayden Cantrelle is ninth in walks (33). Evan Gates is tied for ninth in saves (4). Kai-Wei Teng is tied for eighth in strikeouts (55).

WHERE THE CURVE RANK: Among the Eastern League leaders, Mason Martin is ranked tied for seventh in homers (10), tied for seventh in RBIs (30), tied for eighth in OPS (.891) and tied for fifth in walks (37). Liover Peguero is tied for fourth in doubles (13) and tied for seventh in extra-base hits (19). Connor Scott is first in triples (4). Cameron Junker and Juan Minaya are tied for third in games pitched (19).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have nine players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including Marco Luciano (No. 1), Vaun Brown (No. 6), Carson Whisenhunt (No. 8), Mason Black (No. 9), Carson Seymour (No. 12), Landen Roupp (No. 13), Ryan Murphy (No. 20), Wade Meckler (No. 23) and Randy Rodriguez (No. 30). Luciano is also rated as the No. 63 prospect on Baseball America's Top 100. In Baseball America's "Best Tools" list, Luciano is rated as the best power hitter, Brown is rated as the best thitter for average and best athlete, Meckler is rated as having the best strike-zone discipline, Roupp is rated as having the best curveball and Jose Cruz is rated as having the best changeup. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list includes 10 Richmond players, including Luciano (No. 2, No. 18 overall), Brown (No. 5), Whisenhunt (No. 8), Black (No. 10), Roupp (No. 13), Seymour (No. 17), Rodriguez (No. 25), Murphy (No. 26), Cruz (No. 29) and Meckler (No. 30).
