**Today:** In their 27th season in the Midwest League, the Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the second tilt of a six-game series at the Dayton Dragons, High-A affiliate of the Cincinnati Reds. The Dragons are 5-2 against the Lugnuts this season, winning four of six games in Lansing in May before rallying to take the series opener last night. This is the penultimate road trip of the Lugnuts' 27th season in the Midwest League.

Last Night: Dragons 5, Lugnuts 4. Trailing 4-0 entering the bottom of the eighth inning, Dayton rallied for three runs and the eighth and two in the ninth – all unearned due to three Lugnuts errors – to win the Tuesday night series opener in front of 7,653. With the bases loaded and two outs in the bottom of the ninth, center fielder Junior Pérez muffed a fly ball from Carlos Jorge to allow the game-tying and game-winning runs to score, the fifth time this year that Lansing has been walked off.

On the Air: Tom Nichols and Patrick Geshan call the action on Bally Live and MiLB.TV, with an audio-only call with Jesse Goldberg-Strassler available via StreamGuys.

On Deck: The Lugnuts play Dayton through Sunday, return to Jackson Field to host the West Michigan Whitecaps from August 29 through September 3, and then conclude the 2023 season with a six-game series at Lake County from September 4-10.

#### Lug•Notes

Roll Call: The Lugnuts have used 25 position players and 23 different pitchers (including 12 different starting pitchers) this season.

**Heating Up:** INF **Euribiel Ángeles** has hit safely in his last eight games, improving steadily all of the way: four straight games with one hit followed by two straight games with two hits followed by two straight games with three hits, including last night's series opener. He has 10 hits in his last 15 at-bats. He has also notched one RBI in his last four straight games and had his four-game stolen base streak come to an end yesterday.

Heating Up, Part II: INF Jacob Wilson went 2-for-4 yesterday with a single and a double, giving him 13 hits in his last 30 at-bats (.433).

Pitcher's Best Friend: After turning another double play last night, the Nuts lead the league with 109 double plays turned, 15 more than any other team.

Saving the Day: The Lugnuts have been playing closer and closer games as the season has gone on. By month: seven saves in 20 games in April (35%), nine in 27 games in May (33%), 15 in 24 in June (63%), 20 in 24 games in July (83%), and 15 in 19 games played in August (79%).

Turnaround: CF Junior Pérez opened the year batting .082 (5-for-60) in his first 20 games, including a streak of 32 consecutive hitless at-bats. Since then, he is hitting .281 (85-for-302). His slash line by month: April - .089/.192/.089, .281 OPS; May - .238/.295/.438, .733 OPS; June - .256/.326/.372, .698 OPS; July - .262/.361/.393, .754 OPS; August - .333/.425/.600, 1.025 OPS. Junior has reached base 48 times in the last 23 games, thanks to 32 hits and 16 walks.

Historic on the 4th: A crowd of 11,521 packed in to Jackson Field on July 4, the largest home attendance in Lansing since July 4, 2013. It was also the largest single game crowd in all of High-A, let alone the Midwest League, and an attendance larger than any crowd drawn by every Minor League Baseball team save for six Triple-A teams (Buffalo, Albuquerque, Salt Lake, Indianapolis, Norfolk and Round Rock) and one Double-A team (Frisco).

The Cycle: On June 21 at Wisconsin, Jack Winkler went 4-for-4 with a single, double, triple, home run and four RBIs, becoming the eighth player in team history to hit for the cycle. The other cycles: Corey Patterson (7/5/99 at South Bend); Donnie Hood (4/21/03 vs. Dayton); Chip Cannon (6/2/05 vs. Clinton); Travis Snider (7/7/07 at Fort Wayne); Brad Glenn (7/26/10 vs. Clinton); Edward Olivares (4/24/17 vs. South Bend); and Ryan Gold (4/18/19 vs. Dayton).

They Know Their Trade: Lansing has four players acquired via trade by the Oakland Athletics on its roster: Christian Fernandez (Tampa Bay Rays, 7/9/22, for Christian Bethancourt); Euribiel Ángeles (San Diego Padres, 4/3/22, for Sean Manaea, and a 2021 member of the Fort Wayne TinCaps); Gunnar Hoglund (Toronto Blue Jays, 3/16/22, for Matt Chapman); and Junior Pérez (San Diego Padres, 6/30/20, for Jorge Mateo).

First-Round Pedigrees: The Lugnuts' roster has three current first-rounders: the A's last two first-round selections in catcher Daniel Susac, taken 19th overall out of Arizona last year, and shortstop Jacob Wilson, the sixth overall pick this year from Grand Canyon University, plus the Blue Jays' 2021 first-round selection, Gunnar Hoglund, acquired via trade for Matt Chapman. The A's 2021 first-round selection, shortstop Max Muncy, opened the year on the Lugnuts' roster and is now with Double-A Midland.

Those eight: Ryan Noda on March 30; Hogan Harris on April 14; Mason Miller on April 19; Garrett Acton on May 14; Samad Taylor on June 18; Tyler Soderstrom on July 14; and Lawrence Butler and Hagen Danner on August 11. Davis Schneider, who debuted with Toronto on August 4, played for the Nuts in the 2017 Crosstown Showdown but did not play in any regular season Lansing games.

#### History vs. Dayton

The Lugnuts are 209-170 all-time vs. the Dayton Dragons, their best winning percentage against any team in the Midwest League. They are 109-87 all-time at home against Dayton and 100-83 in the Gem City.

Last year, the Nuts went 5-6 vs. Dayton in Michigan's state capital, but took five of six games at Day Air Ballpark for a 10-7 record.

## TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

**2009:** Blake Tekotte (TEE-kuh-tee) led off the bottom of the 13th inning with a walk-off home run, and the Fort Wayne TinCaps beat the Lugnuts, 3-2. Lansing manager Clayton McCullough was ejected for arguing a play at the plate in the 11th where the Lugnuts' Welinton Ramirez was called out attempting to tag and scare on a Justin McClanahan fly-out.

**2016:** Left-handed starter Angel Perdomo was voted to the Midwest League Post-Season All-Star Team, tied with Beloit's Evan Manarino. Perdomo finished the season with a 5-7 record with a 3.19 ERA in 27 games, 25 starts, 127 IP, 101 hits, 4 HR, 54 BB, 156 K.

**2019:** Right fielder Griffin Conine and closer Cre Finfrock were named to the 2019 Midwest League Post-Season All-Star Team, Conine as one of the three OF and Finfrock as the league's right-handed reliever. Conine ended up leading the league with 22 homers while Finfrock led the league with 17 saves in 17 opportunities. In the game at South Bend, Otto Lopez's fourth hit of the game was a two-out, two-run triple in the tenth, giving the Lugnuts a 5-4 win at South Bend.

**Retrospective:** Watters made his Midwest League debut at Four Winds Field on August 31, 2022, pitching against rehabber Wade Miley in Lansing debut... had made just one prior appearance in the minors before joining the Lugnuts: August 23 for the Arizona Complex League Athletics vs. the Ariz. Complex League Cubs.

Entering Draft Day: Rated Keith Law's No. 68 draft prospect for The Athletic, with Law writing, "Watters started the year in the Mountaineers' bullpen, where he hit 99 mph a few times, so the team moved him to the rotation around midseason, where he struggled more with control (37 walks in 50.2 innings) but also showed enough that some scouts think he can start in pro ball. Watters sits 94-97 mph with a power slider in the mid-80s that can miss bats ... when he locates it. It's not a bad delivery, with a reasonably short arm stroke and strong finish, so that's not the reason he doesn't throw strikes, but it's true across all of his pitches. It's much more likely he ends up a power reliever with two plus pitches. But with enough of a changeup to start and a delivery that looks like it should work, I wouldn't be surprised to see a pro team keep him in the rotation."... Fangraphs' No. 96 draft prospect.

**Inked:** Selected 124th overall by the A's in the 4th round and signed for \$491,750... highest pitcher taken by the Athletics in 2022 (following first-round catcher Daniel Susac and three straight outfielders in high schooler Henry Bolte in the second round, Michigan Wolverine Clark Elliott in the compensatory round B, and Mercer slugger Colby Thomas in the third round).

WVU to the Pros: First of three Mountaineers selected in the 2022 draft... the 2021 Fort Wayne TinCaps featured two WVU teammates in 2021 draftees Jackson Wolf (4th round) and Ryan Bergert (6th round); pitched against Bergert on May 26 and tossed 5 2/3 scoreless innings, allowing only one hit... the last WVU player taken in the first round was Alek Manoah by Toronto in 2019, who in 2022 joined John Means as the only Mountaineers to be named MLB All-Stars... the last West Virginia player to suit up for the Lugnuts was Ryan McBroom, who won the 2015 Midwest League Most Valuable Player award.

**Glory Days:** Starred for the Bland County HS Rockets as an all-state baseball player as well as in basketball (where he regularly posted double-doubles and topped out at 45 points in one game) and football.

**Off to College:** Did not receive much notice before his high velocity was discovered at a tryout in Morgantown... named to the Academic All-Big 12 Rookie Team as a freshman (5 G, 4.70 ERA, 7 2/3 IP, 4 R, 6 BB, 11 K)... as a sophomore, made 19 appearances: 3.33 ERA, 27 IP, 15 H, 11 R, 32 BB, bullpen-leading 53 K, .165 avg. allowed, tied for team lead with four saves; named Academic All-Big 12 Second Team; NCBWA Stopper of the Year Midseason Watch List... made first college start in the 2021 Big 12 Championship vs. Texas: 3 IP, 0 H, 1 R, 4 BB, 8 K... as a junior in 2022, named preseason All-American; dominated early as team closer and was moved into role as Friday starter; struck out 15 Texas Longhorns in 6 1/3 IP on May 7; overall: 18 G, 11 GS, 3-7, 6.22 ERA, 59 1/3 IP, 64 H, 44 R, 41 BB, 75 K; named All-Big 12 Honorable Mention.

Hometown Hero: Home city of Rocky Gap, Virginia, is in the Ridge-and-Valley Appalachians, located near the West Virginia border... neighboring city: Bluefield, home of the Bluefield Ridge Runners, previously known as the Bluefield Orioles and Bluefield Blue Jays, which fed such stars as Alejandro Kirk and Vladimir Guerrero, Jr. to the Lugnuts when both were part of the Jays' system... cousin is Jason Michaels, who played 11 years (2001-2011) in MLB.

Prospecting: MLB Pipeline had ranked Watters the No. 26 prospect in the A's organization and the No. 12 pitching prospect before the recent ranking reorganization, in which he fell off the Top 30 entirely... his grades: Fastball 60, Curve 60, Changeup 45, Control 45, Overall 40... his scouting report: "Watters is a strong presence on the mound at 6-foot-4. His fastball was up to 99 mph during his junior year and touched triple digits in his time as a reliever. He also possesses a plus pitch in his power curve, missing plenty of bats as a true 12-to-6 that sits in the mid-80s. There's also a mid-80s changeup in there, though it's less polished compared to his other two offerings. Command will need to improve for Watters to have a chance to start at the next level. While the stuff was high-octane in college, he usually had little idea of how to locate it. Given his track record as a reliever, there's a strong chance he ends up back in the bullpen, where he can rear back and overpower hitters with two plus pitches."
