FLASH GORDON: Left-hander Colton Gordon tossed his fifth quality start of the season on Wednesday night against Memphis. It was his second in four starts with Nashville after tossing three earlier this season with Triple-A Sugar Land. **Gordon has 17 career quality starts since the start of his professional career and 15 since making his Triple-A debut with the Space Cowboys during the 2023 season.** Since 2023, he ranks T-9th in wins (21), 12th in GS (58), and 14th in strikeouts (281) among all Triple-A arms and the 15 Triple-A quality starts are tied for 10th among all Triple-A pitchers. He is still in search of his first win since a trade from Houston to Milwaukee on July 15 after a no-decision on Wednesday night despite the QS (6.0 IP, 8 H, 3 R, 2 ER, 4 K, BB). His two QS through his first four games with the Sounds are already tied for the third-most on the team this season along with Garrett Stallings and Thomas Pannone. Gordon has posted a 21-11 record with a 3.93 ERA in 63 appearances (58 starts) at the Triple-A level since 2023.

QUERO SPECIAL: Brewers no. 11-rated prospect Jeferson Quero tallied a 1-for-3 night with an RBI in Wednesday night's game against the Redbirds. It marked his 53rd RBI of the season for the Sounds, which is the most RBI he has recorded on a single team during his professional career. He's hitting .264 (89-for-337), added 26 XBH and 44 runs for the Sounds this season. **Quero ranks tied for eighth with Brady Ebel in hits (89) and tied for 13th in RBI (53) among minor league players in the Brewers' farm system this season.** Since making his Sounds' debut in 2024, Quero ranks second in RBI (97), third in hits (144) and XBH (47), second in total bases (228), fourth in doubles (27) and runs (76), fifth in HR (17), and seventh in walks (60).

BROCK CAN ROCK: Brock Wilken extended his on-base streak to 14 consecutive games with a walk in the top of the first inning Wednesday night against the Redbirds. His 14-game streak is tied with Darrien Miller for the longest active on-base streak by a Nashville player and tied for the 10th-longest overall on-base streak for Nashville this year. The Brewers no. 30-rated prospect put together a team-best 30-game on-base streak earlier this season (4/10-5/14). Over his last 14 games, Wilken is hitting .208 (10-for-48) with five doubles, three home runs, eight RBI, with 11 walks and five runs. He has posted multiple walks in two straight games and three times overall during his current streak dating back to July 18.

DO THE DREW: Drew Rom extended his streak without an earned run allowed to 14.2 IP and eight straight games in Tuesday's series opener against the Redbirds. Rom worked two scoreless innings with a hit and four strikeouts. **Tuesday night was his third in his last five appearances with 4+ strikeouts in 2.0 IP or less,** striking out 14 of the last 29 batters he has faced. The 14.2 IP tied Garrett Stallings for the third-longest streak without an earned run this season behind Craig Yoho (20.2 IP) and Brian Fitzpatrick (15.2 IP). The eight straight games are tied for the sixth-most between earned runs for any Nashville pitcher this season. Since beginning his streak on June 3, the left-hander has surrendered just nine hits and an unearned run with 24 total strikeouts.

THE OCHO: Luis Matos extended his hitting streak to eight straight games, finishing Wednesday night 1-for-4 with a RBI and walk. **The eight-game hitting streak is tied for the sixth-longest active hitting streak in the International League and his second hitting streak of 8+ games this season for Nashville in 56 games played.** Over his last eight games, Matos is hitting .406 (13-for-32) with four doubles, a triple, three RBI, and two walks. He has a hit in 15 of his last 24 games dating since the start of July, hitting .250 (24-for-96) with 10 XBH and 12 RBI.

RUNNING BEES: Jacob Hurtubise has 1+ stolen base in each of his last four games played which is tied for the longest active streak in Triple-A and tied for second among all minor leaguers. **Hurtubise has swiped five total bases over his last four games after having just four total through his first 36 games with the Sounds and none over a 20 game stretch from April 30-July 29.**

20 IS A LOT: The Sounds allowed a season-high 20 hits in Tuesday's loss to Memphis. It was the first time the Sounds had allowed 20+ hits in a game since also allowing Memphis to record 23 hits on July 14, 2022. Tuesday night was the 16th time Nashville has allowed 20+ hits in a game since 2005 and **the Redbirds are responsible for four of the last six 20+ hit games allowed by the Sounds since 2019** having also allowed 24 hits (May 3, 2019), 20 hits (May 11, 2021).

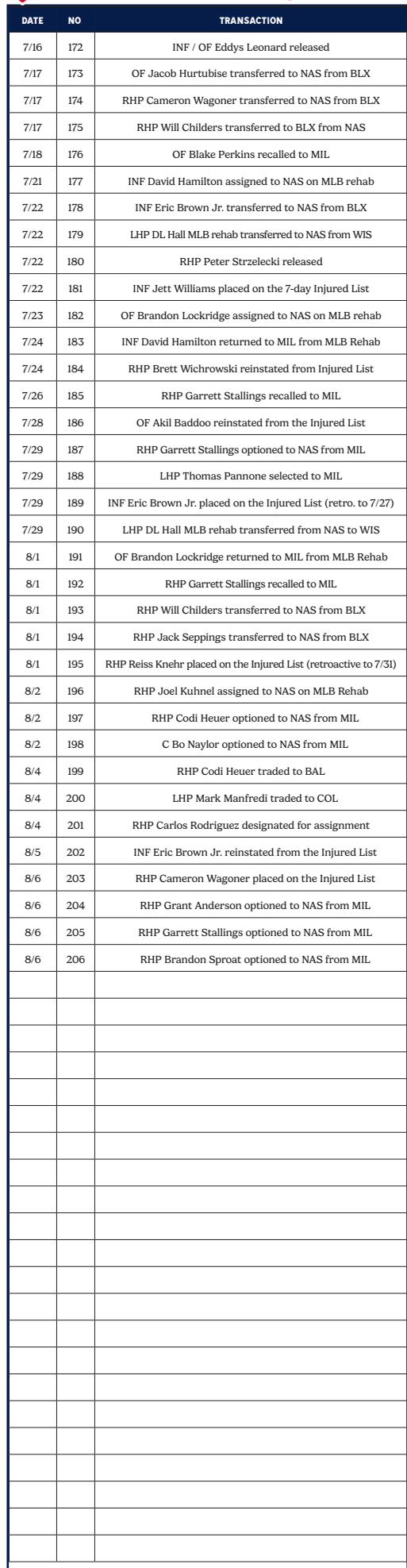
