TODAY'S GAME: Tacoma holds a 1-0 series lead after claiming a 9-1 victory last night in a six-inning shortened game due to poor air quality ... Jack O'Loughlin is slated to take the hill for the Isotopes while Nick Fraze is expected to start for the Rainiers.

6 INNINGS: Last night's 6 inning contest was the first shortened game for the Isotopes (non-doubleheaders) since July 2, 2024, at El Paso when the contest was called due to rain in the 7th frame It was the shortest game in Albuquerque since June 19, 2022, vs. Salt Lake (called in the top of the 7th due to rain, 11-5 ABQ).

HITS: For the sixth time this season, the Isotopes finished with four or fewer hits in a contest. Last night was the first occurrence of it taking place in a game that did not last nine innings

TOVAR TIME: In his third rehab game with the Isotopes Tuesday, Ezequiel Tovar went 0-for-3 with two strikeouts ... Over three rehab games with Albuquerque this season, is 1-for-10 with a walk and four strikeouts.

MR. FREEMAN: Tyler Freeman, also in his third rehab game with Albuquerque yesterday, went 1-for-3 with a single ... In three rehab games with the Isotopes is 2-for-8 with a double, two walks and a strikeout.

REAL SLIM SCHUNKY: Aaron Schunk went 1-for-3 with a double during his third rehab contest with the Isotopes Tuesday ... Over three rehab games with the Isotopes is 3-for-10 with a homer, a double and two RBI.

BY WAY OF THE K: The Isotopes pitching staff recorded just one strikeout last night for the 16th time in team history, and second in 2025. It also occurred April 20 vs. El Paso in the second game of a doubleheader. Albuquerque has never had a game where they recorded zero strikeouts.

SERIES OPENER: Albuquerque lost a series opener for the first time last night since April 8 at Sugar Land, ending a streak of four consecutive victories (vs. ELP, at RNO, vs. SL, at OKC), their longest since March 31-April 18, 2023.

ISOTOPES RBI RECORD: Sam Hilliard has 231 RBI with Albuquerque, second all-time in Isotopes history ... Jason Wood (2003-06, 08) holds the record with 328 RBI.

BEHIND THE DISH: Albuquerque catchers (Braxton Fulford, Austin Nola and Ronaiker Palma) have combined to slash .368/.420/.596 with 50 hits, 13 doubles, six homers and 23 RBI on the year, leading the PCL in doubles, average, OBP and slugging

SAM I AM: Sam Hilliard drew a walk yesterday and has reached base in 28 of 29 games played on the year ... Last night was his third hitless game in his last five contests.

KESTDADDY: Keston Hiura singled last night and has a hit in seven of eight games played in May ... During the month, is slashing .333/.375/.600 with a triple, two homers and four RBI after hitting .141 over his first 24 games.

VEEN: Zac Veen singled last night, ending a two-game streak without reaching base ... Since being sent back down to Albuquerque April 24 (12 games), Veen is 14-for-52 with four doubles, one triple, one homer and five RBI.

COOLING OFF?: From April 10-30 (15 games), Warming Bernabel slashed .362/.403/.621 with nine doubles, two homers and 17 RBI ... Over his last 10 games, however, is 4-for-33 with one homer and four RBI.

BRAX: Since being sent down to Albuquerque April 29 (eight games) Braxton Fulford is 6-for-27 with three doubles and five RBI ... Eleven of Fulford's 21 hits with Albuquerque this season have gone for extra bases ... Has a hit in 13 of his last 15 contests.

STERLIN: Sterlin Thompson has recorded a hit in three-straight games (5x10 with a double) ... Has just two extra-base hits (double and homer) over his last 10 contests.

BOONIE: Trevor Boone connected on his third clout with the lsotopes in 13 contest this season Sunday to tie the game in the eighth inning.

PCL LEADERBOARD: Ryan Ritter is T-6th in walks (26) Sam Hilliard is T-1st in triples (4), T-5th in XBH (17) and 10th in slugging (.531).

HOMERS ALLOWED: The Rainiers hit three home runs last night, just the third time in 2025 Albuquerque has served up a trio or more in a contest (also: April 17 vs. El Paso, May 7 at Oklahoma City). Through 39 games in 2024, the Isotopes had relented three or more long balls on 10 different occassions.

AVERAGE: Albuquerque's .229 team batting average in May is the second-lowest in the Pacific Coast League this month (Sacramento, .208).

VS. TACOMA: Albuquerque has lost four of their last five seriesopening games played against Tacoma at home.

NUCLEI NOTES

SKIPPER: Pedro Lopez enters his 21st year as a minor league manager and third guiding the Isotopes. He is the eighth manager in club history ... Spent 2021 as Albuquerque's hitting coach and 2022 as its bench coach ... Notched his 1,000th career managerial victory June 4, 2023 at Salt Lake, 7-1 ... Managed in the Texas Rangers (2001-05, 2007) and New York Mets (2011-19) organizations while claiming the 2014 Eastern League Championship with Double-A Binghamton. Lopez was drafted in the 21st round by the San Diego Padres in the 1988 MLB Draft and spent 13 years in the minor leagues, reaching Triple-A on four occasions.

CHRIS MICHALAK: Begins his third season as Isotopes pitching coach ... Pitched for the Albuquerque Dukes in 2000, followed by stints with the Isotopes in 2004 and 2008 ... Started second-to-last game in Dukes history, giving up two runs in 6.0 innings during Game 4 of a PCL First Round playoff series at Memphis Sept. 9, 2000 ... Appeared in 61 Major League games (24 starts) over five seasons with the Arizona Diamondbacks (1998), Toronto Blue Jays (2001) Texas Rangers (2001-02) and Cincinnati Reds (2006) ... 12th round selection by the Athletics in 1993 ... Has been in the coaching ranks since 2009, including stops as the pitching coach for the Hagerstown Suns (2010-11), Potomac Nationals (2012-13) and Harrisburg Senators (2018-20 and coached in the Washington Nationals organization from 2021-22.

MICHAEL RYAN: Enters his second year with the Rockies organization as the Isotopes bench coach ... The former outfielder played in 33 games for the Isotopes and hit nine homers during the 2008 campaign. He and Michalak were teammates on that squad for four days in late July ... Entered the coaching ranks in 2012 as a coach for the Double-A Altoona Curve (Pirates). He then managed in the Pirates organization at three levels for seven seasons with stops at Single-A West Virginia (2013-14), High-A Bradenton (2015-16) and Double-A Altoona (2017-19), while winning the Florida State League in 2016 and Eastern League in 2017. Ryan compiled a 221-197 managerial record with Altoona—the most wins for a manager in Curve history ... He also managed in the Cubs organization (High-A South Bend, 2021 and Double-A Tennessee, 2022-June 2023) ... A 5th round draft pick by the Minnesota Twins in 1996, played in 149 MLB games over parts of five seasons with the Twins (2002-05) and Angels (2010) ... Last Angels player to wear 27 prior to Mike Trout's call-up in 2011.

SPLIT-SEASON PLAYOFF FORMAT: For the third-straight year, the Pacific Coast League will use a split-season format to determine playoff participants. With one 10 team division, the first half winner (concluding June 22) will host the second half winner (beginning June 24) in a three-game set. The winner will then face the International League champion for the Triple-A Championship in Las Vegas, NV, on September 27.

BALLS AND STRIKES: The Challenge System, in it's third full year in the PCL, will be used exclusively for every game this season. Under this system, the home plate umpire will call balls or strikes while each team has the opportunity to challenge the umpire's call with two challenges per game, retaining one for each successful challenge.
